By virtue of a precept to me directed by James St John Esquire His Majesty's Surveyor Genl. dated the 18th day of July An. Dom. 1733 I have a measure & laid out unto the Hon^{ble} William Bull Esq. a piece of Shelly Ground containing eleven Acres or thereabouts situate lying & being on the North Side of Ashley River in Berkeley County & at the South East ~~side~~ part off Charleston being commonly called the white point, butting and bounding Northerly on land belonging to Landgrave Smith Esq. & to the Westward on ground formerly laid out unto Mr Cothran & Southerly on the edge of Ashley River Channel & Easterly on Cooper River, and hath such Shape marks & Form as the above plat delineated Plat hereof specifies Certified this 6th day of June Anno Domini 1735 p. me (Signed) Tho: Witter Dep. Surveyor
