








Author's publication history

- paper available online
- paper has DOI

data

- paper has copyright license
 - author has ORCID
 - author has demographic

- paper metadata not available
 - copyright license non-standard
- paper fails to mention funder
- paper / project / PI not associated with grant catalog entry



- credits / showcases underserved communities
- promotes collaboration, humility, transparency

Bad or odd things

- Is gender / ethnicity private?
- cannot come from institutions
- structured data can have weird consequences
