



We submit you the application from Seta Plant of Mitsui Seiki Kogyo K.K. under our jurisdiction regarding the above subject as enclosed herewith and beg you to manage it properly.

Building "C" to which the equipments were transferred was released on 20 Sept. 1949 by Shiga Civil Affairs Team and they transferred the reparation equipments from Building "A" to "C" in August 1950 without taking any permission according to our Government interpretation as it was the removal in the same plant.

Building "A" was also released by your Region on 21 November 1950 so that Seta Plant of Toyo Rayon K.K. may use it. Mr. J. S. Revan, C.P.C, SCAP. who inspected this plant on 25 November kindly advised us to get permission in writing from your Region of transferring reparation equipments to non-reparation building in the same plant. In accordance with his advice, we apply you for it now.

spindles as before, that is 2.2 times production of fibre
thread.

This factory was transferred from Toyo Rayon Company Ltd., to Mitsui Seiki Kogyo K.K. at 1943, which was used as rayon staple spinning and weaving plant, and diverted to a munitions plant. After the war by the permission of Shiga Civil Affairs Team, we change the factory as peace industry plant. But few years after we stopped the operation and assembled the reparations equipments from original position to a part of main building (annex plan A) and casting shop(annex plan B). Since Sept.1949 Toyo Rayon Company Ltd., got a necessary permission and set as a rayon staple spinning and textiles plant, in the main area of this building.

Recently the rayon staple spinning facilities control was released by G.H.Q., therefor Toyo Rayon Company Ltd., desires to increase the spinning machines in this whole building, this expansion will contribute for recovery of Japanese economy. Here, we got permission No.25-1715 dated Aug. 10th 1950 from Ministry of International Trade and Industry, and we removed the designated equipment as we report to you dated on Sept. 1st, 1950, from the main building to ex-casting shop (annex plan B) and ex-heat treatment shop (annex plan C).

Thereafter at present, there are no designated reparations equipments nor facilities at the main building.

We sure would like to ask permission for release of the land and building of the main building by your generous consideration concerning the above mentioned situation.

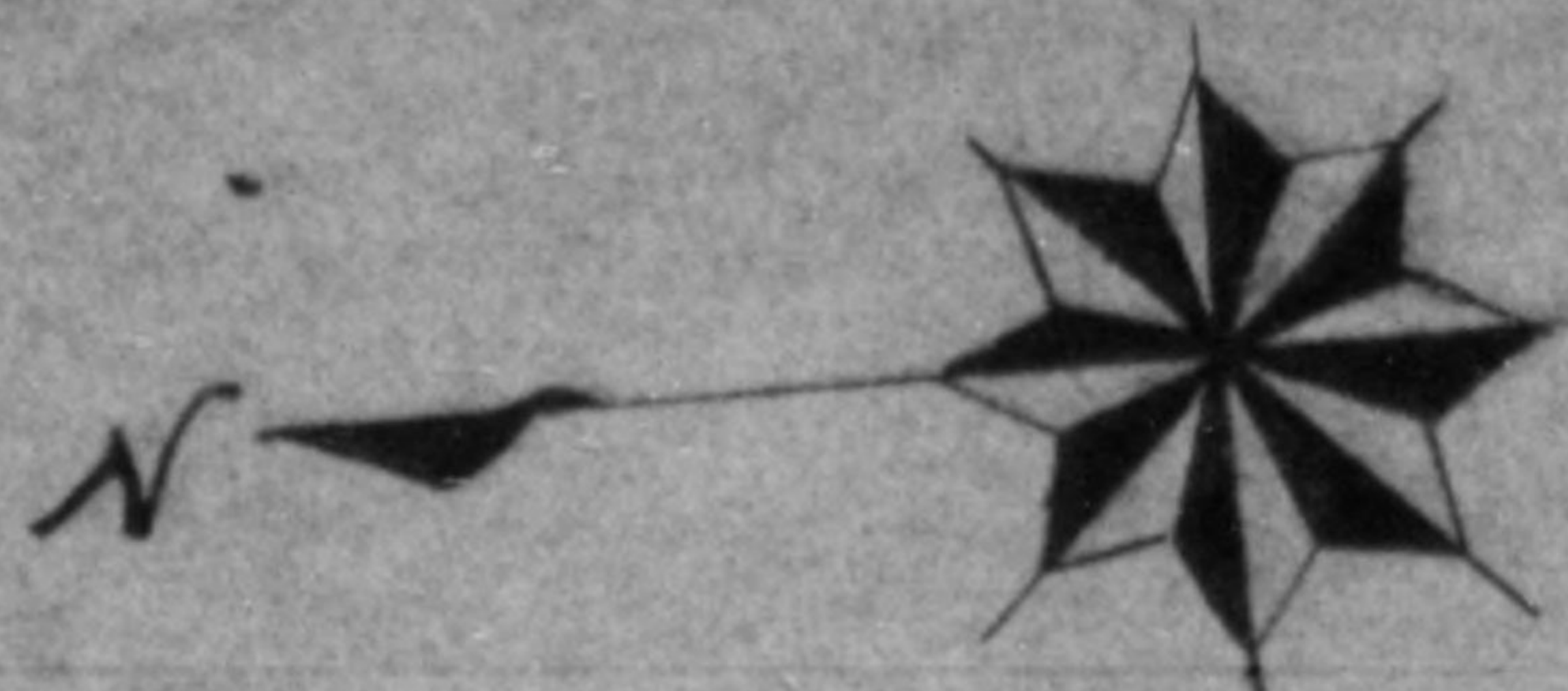

We herewith report to you that we have moved and custodied 343 reparation machines to the casting shop (attached map B), and 337 sets of reparation machines to the heat treatment shop (attached map C). Above movement were previously agreed by the Japanese Government. Because the rehabilitation of staple fibre spinning machines of the Toyo Rayon Co., Ltd., Seta Factory was permitted, and the space of this rehabilitation spinning plant was decided to be rebuilt at the main building (attached map A), where we did kept those reparation machines.

In addition we wish to report to you that the new custody buildings carefully maintained such as roof and floor, to be perfect, to keep those reparation machines in good condition.

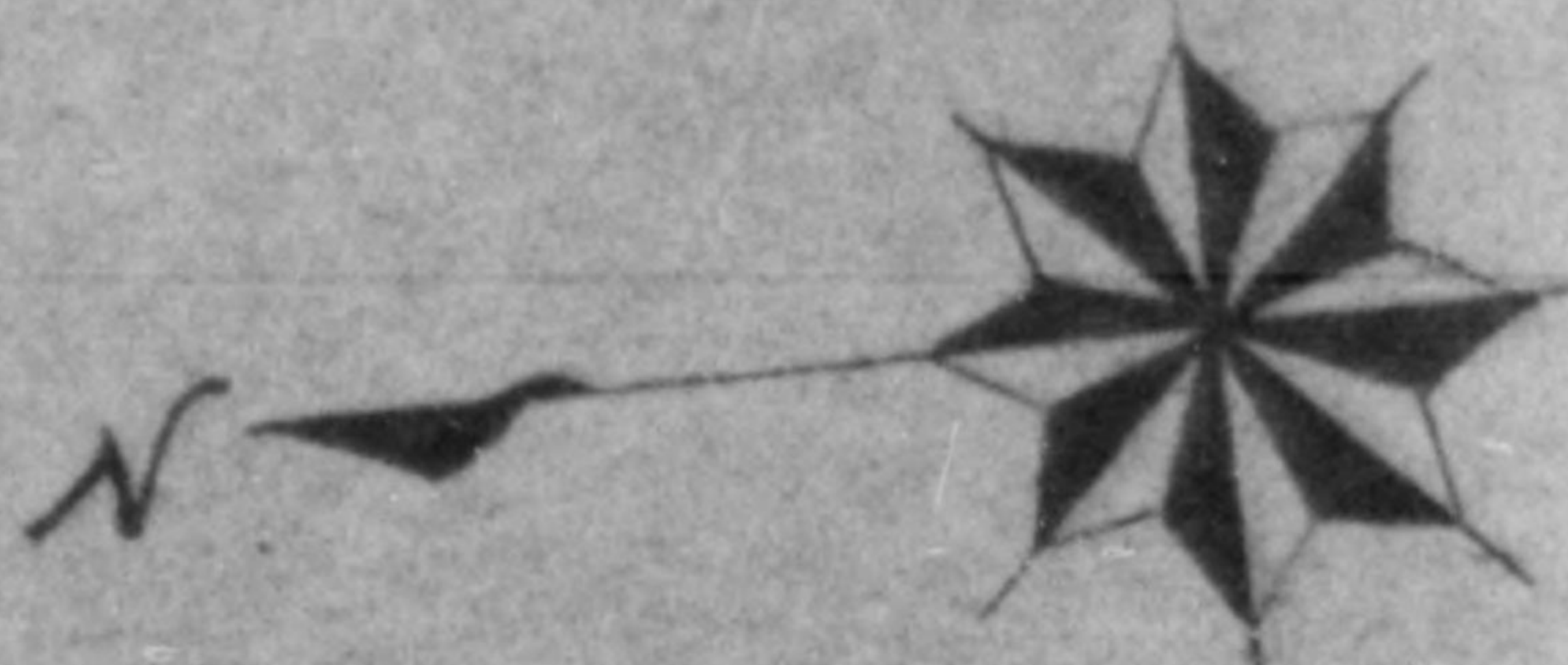

1. Refer to the inclosed applications from subject plant regarding repair of buildings and maintenance of equipment.
2. Inspection of subject plant on 19 August 1950 revealed that Building A does not require repairs. Repair work proposed by Inclosure No. 1 regarding Buildings A is therefore not favorably considered.
3. Repair of Building B as proposed by Inclosure No. 1 is considered necessary for protection of reparations equipment presently stored therein and that which will be transferred thereto from Building A. It is estimated that 250,000 yen will adequately provide for the necessary repair work.
4. Maintenance of 262 items of equipment as proposed by the applicant is considered necessary. It is estimated that 300 yen per item will be adequate to provide the cleaning and/or re-application of preservatives required.

Justification for request:

Seta Works of this company were established as a staple fibre spinning mill in 1937 by Toyo Rayon K.K. and taken over in Sept. 1943 and had been producing aircraft parts, installing various necessary machines.

After the end of this war this company was allowed to change their business by M.G - 167. dt'd 1 Dec. 1945, beginning the manufacturing of civil commodities such as micrometers, gauges, parts for railway vehicles etc. but were designated as reparations installations (Code No. 35 - 01) by O.D - 5 dated 20 Jan. 1946.

Operation continued on, but owing to management difficulties in 1948 they were compelled to close this Seta Works on 31 March, 1949.

After that, Toyo Rayon K.K. determined to utilize this as a spinning mill once again, we are controlling and having the custody of reparations machines (exclusive of T. O. machines) by gathering these in A. Room (machine) & B. Room (casting) after getting the understanding of G.H.Q. thru Shiga Civil Affairs Team.
(See Attached Chart. 1)

In spite of frequent repairs we see rainleaks at roof or gutters many often, because this factory buildings are very old and have several rotten parts. We were driven to the wall by the tremendous damage of Jan. 10th's snow and storm. We could pull through by mending indispensable parts only but in these rainy days we have leaks of overall roof.

Especially B room is quite serious. We dare apply you again to repair at the minimum degree so as to put them under perfect custody. We sincerely advise you to admit our application this time though carried forward owing to budgetary affairs against our Mar. 11th's application.

Repairs to buildings showing separations items.

1. Survey of building condition of plant was conducted on 17 August. Plant custodian claimed that Building "A" leaked badly during rain and emergency measures had to be taken immediately. Repairs on this building has already been completed.

Work on Building "B" has not started. Survey revealed that rain water from upper roofs slash on the lower roofs. Flashings, valley gutters and windows have deteriorated and rain water is leaking into the building. Portions of wooden trusses and roof boards have rotted.

2. In order to make the roof water tight, it is necessary to provide new eave gutters, downspouts, and replace deteriorated portions of wood work, valley gutters and broken window glass.

3. Survey of repairs required revealed that

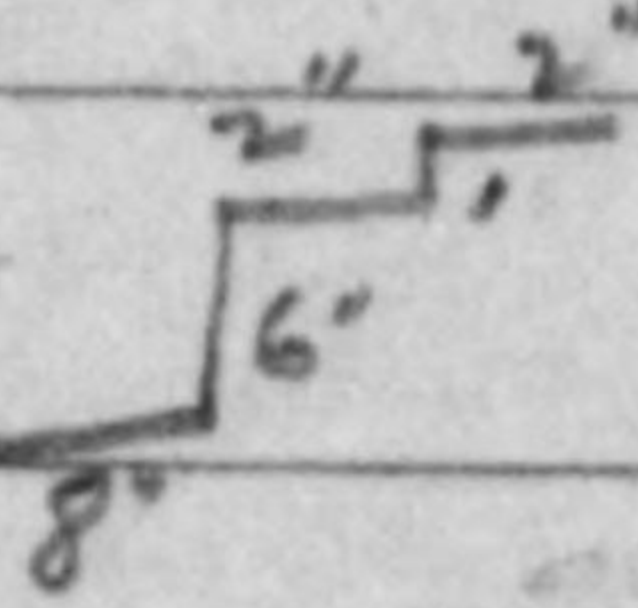

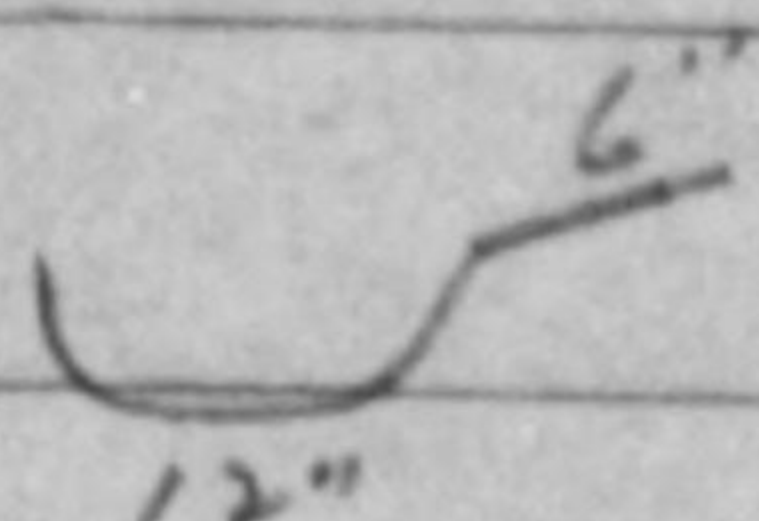

From: Mr Armstrong

1. Inspection of machinery at reparations installation 35-1 due to application for funds to cover maintenance cost.

2. This installation has 719 inventoried items in storage plus a 122 items not inventoried. This equipment is in excellent condition with a few minor exceptions. Last cleaning and greasing was completed during July 1949. This storage is in a low building which was formerly an air-conditioned textile mill with a large number of overhead windows and therefore becomes very hot during the summer season causing the oil and grease to soften. Spot cleaning and greasing will be required to keep this equipment up to the present maintained standard. * This maintenance should be accomplished after the warm season so that most benefit can be derived from labor and fund expended.

3. It is estimated that ¥250 yen per machine for the 719 or a total of ¥189,750 would be sufficient to accomplish this work instead of ¥245,904 requested in attached application.

** However it is recommended that no funds be approved at the present time, present protection will be effective for the next 6 months*
