SUBJECT: Repatriation of Ryukyans from Japan

1. Reference is made to memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (24 Jul 46)GC (SCAPIN 1081), dated 24 July 1946, subject: Repatriation of Ryukyans Now In Japan, as amended.

2. Paragraph 4 e of reference of paragraph 1 above is amended, effective 4 November 1946, as follows:
