Community update



FDC Recommendations

- Funds Dissemination Committee: a **volunteer committee** that oversees 6 million USD in grants
- Met in Warsaw to review Annual Plan Grant applications by movement affiliates, and also **reviewed Wikimedia Foundation annual plan.**
- **1,138,000 USD** recommended funds for allocation, 90% of what was requested in this round.

- Works as deputy CEO at Webedia, a global media agency in France.



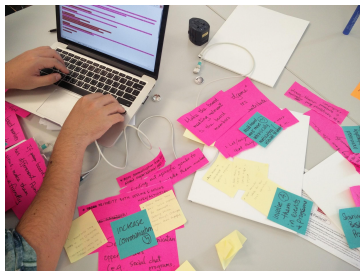
Nataliia Tymkiv

Learning Days at WMCON 2016

- **65 people** from 49 different affiliates and the Foundation participated; including staff from Program Capacity and Learning, Community Resources, Technical Collaborations, and Communications.
- **27 program leaders engaged in co-presenting**, making it the highest engagement rate so far.
- 4 main focus areas: **engaging** and retaining **volunteers**, **best practices exchanges** with other leaders, **designing** Wikimedia **programs** and events, measuring and evaluating **impact**.

Europeana Art History Challenge

- A challenge to **improve the Wikidata item** and **create/translate the Wikipedia article** about the 10 important artworks from each participating country
- **24 nations** joined the challenge
- **850 articles** created or improved and raising, 80% increase from baseline.

MENA Artists Month

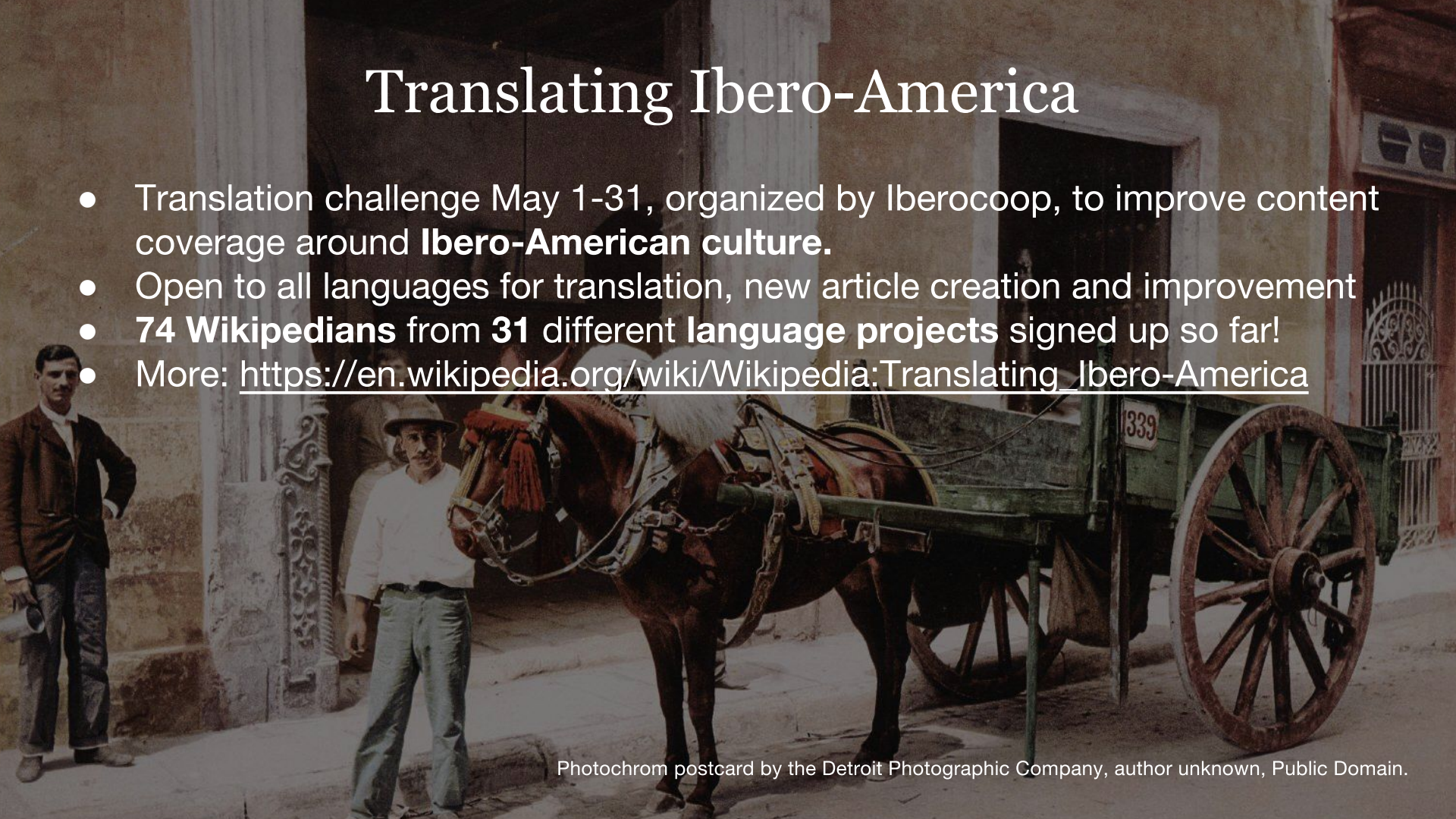
- Month-long **edit-a-thon** during May to promote **contemporary 20th-21st century art and artists** of the **Middle East and North Africa (MENA region)**; major activities will be **creating and enhancing articles**
- Planned in collaboration with **Guggenheim** and along with **Writing Middle Eastern Women into History, Wikipedia: WikiProject Women in Red** and regional **Wikipedia chapters/usergroups** from Africa, Americas, Asia and Europe
- Articles eligible for competition: at least **3500 bytes** and **300 words** (added either as new article or enhanced)

Translating Ibero-America

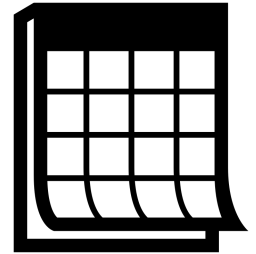
- Translation challenge May 1-31, organized by Iberocoop, to improve content coverage around **Ibero-American culture**.

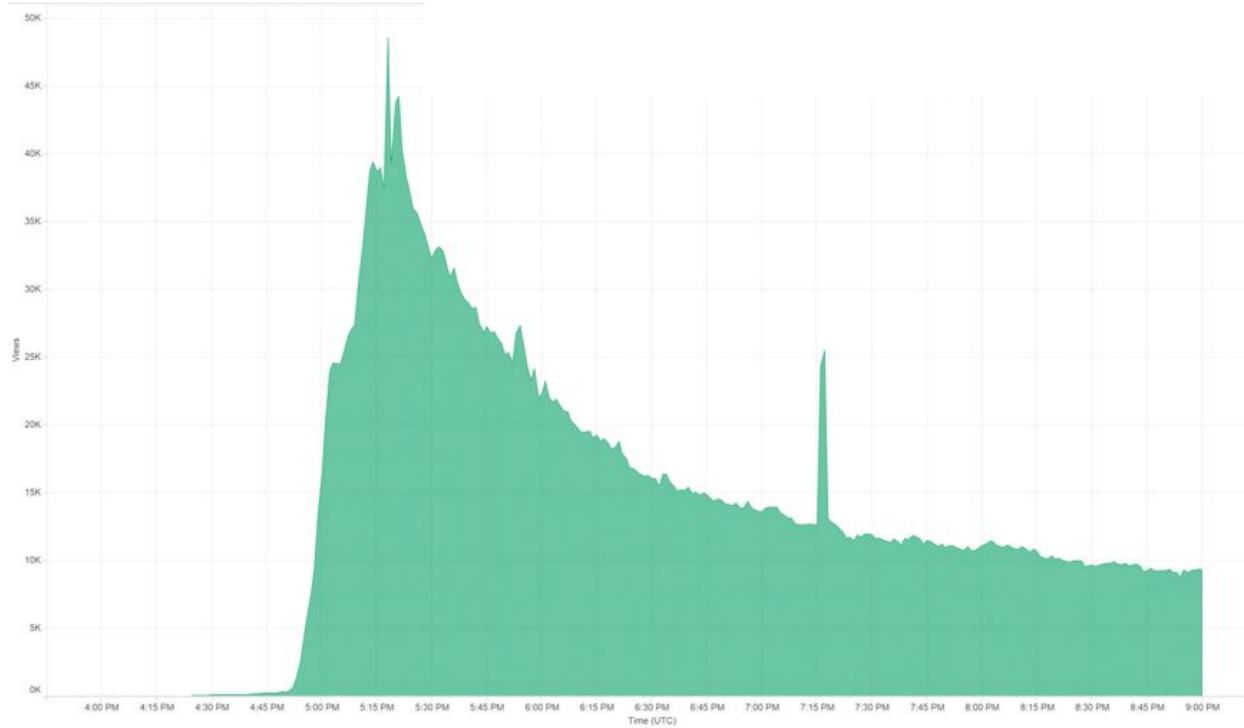

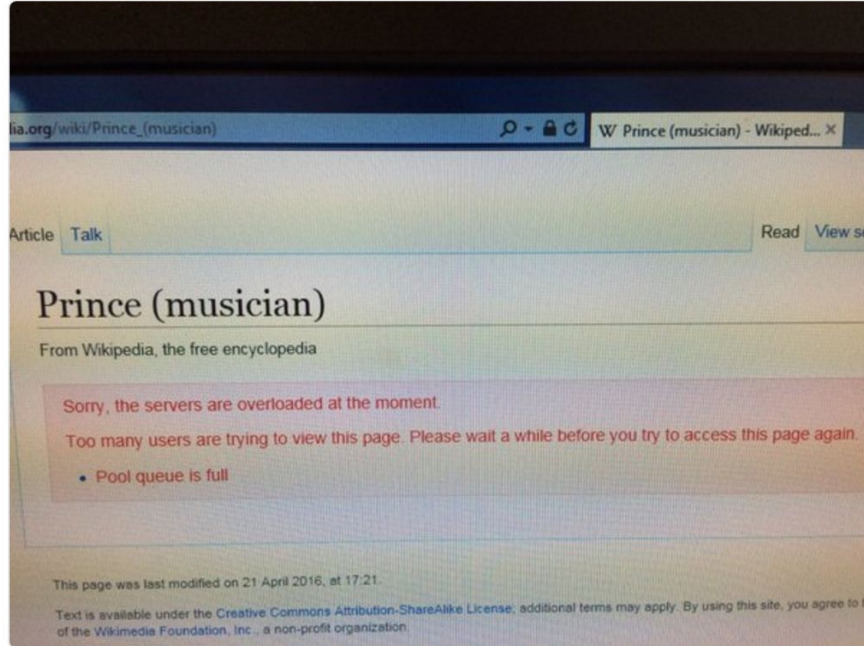

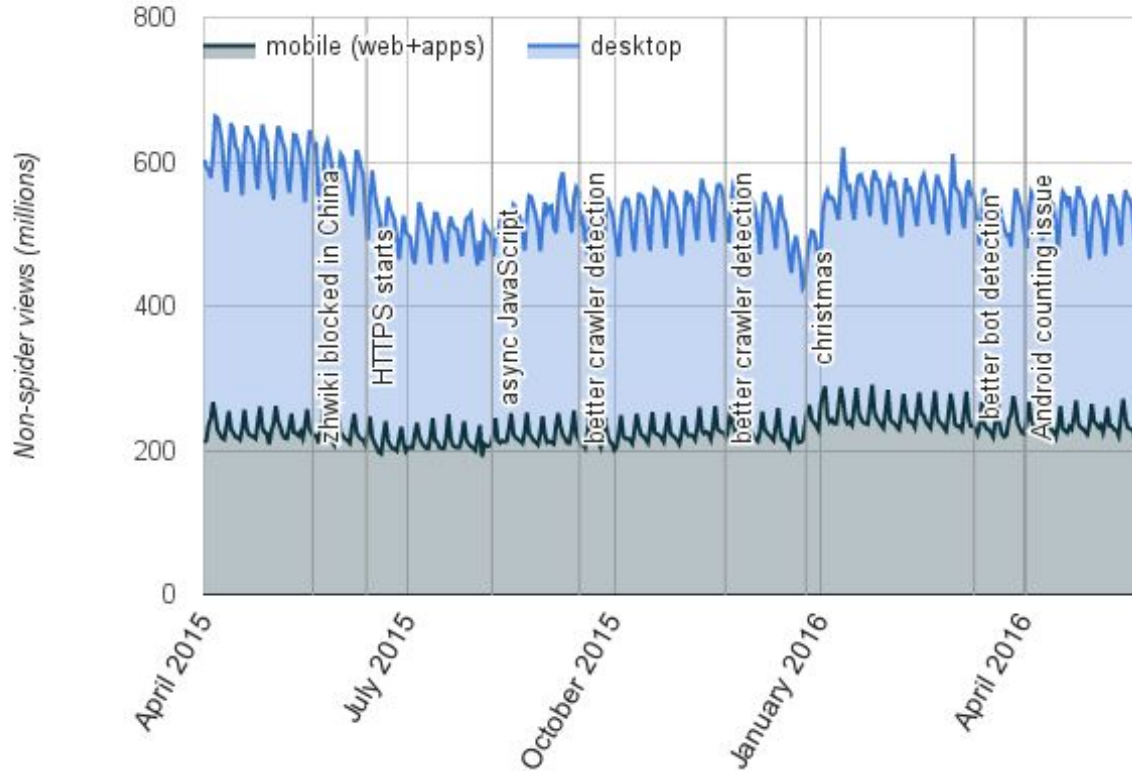

Wikimedia daily pageviews, desktop + mobile

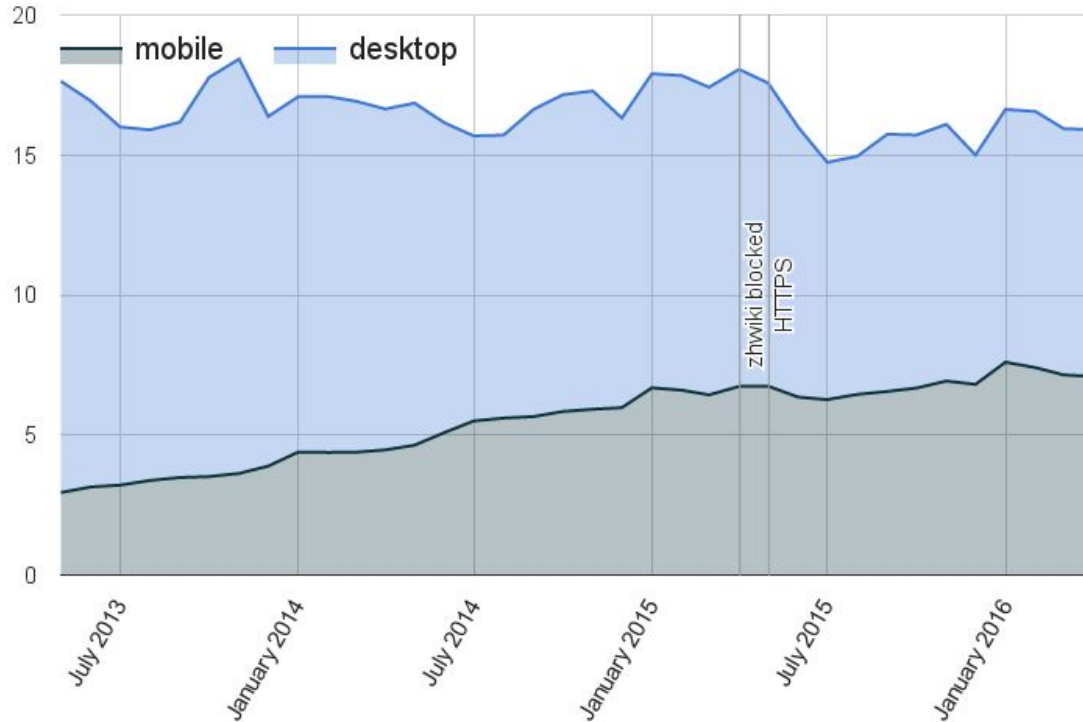

Wikimedia monthly pageviews (desktop+mobile), 2013-2016

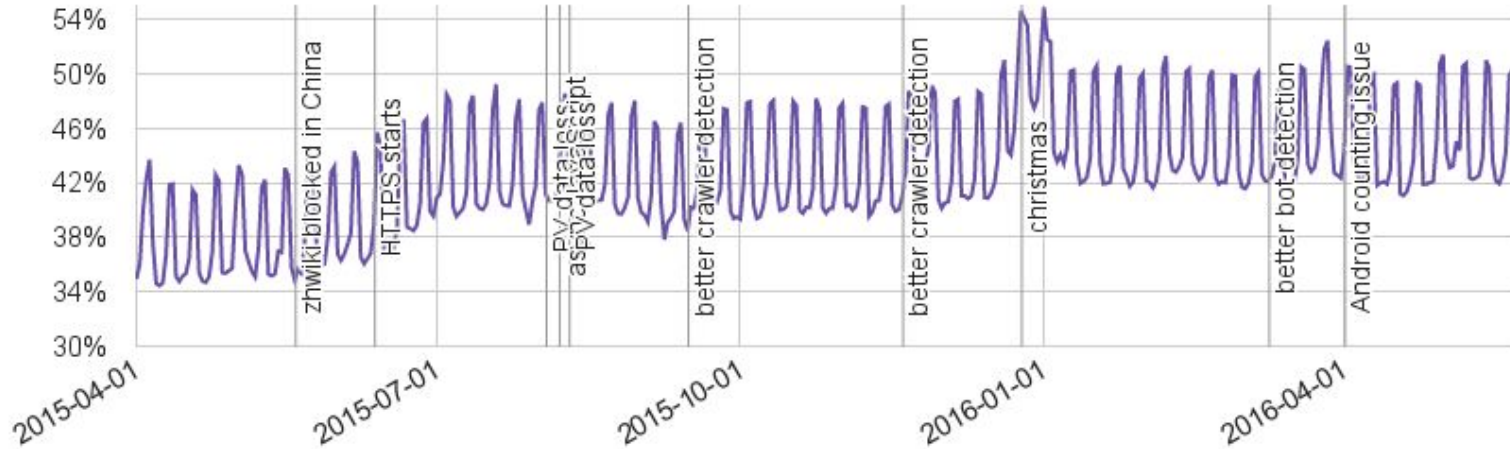


	Annual change (2013-2016, linear)

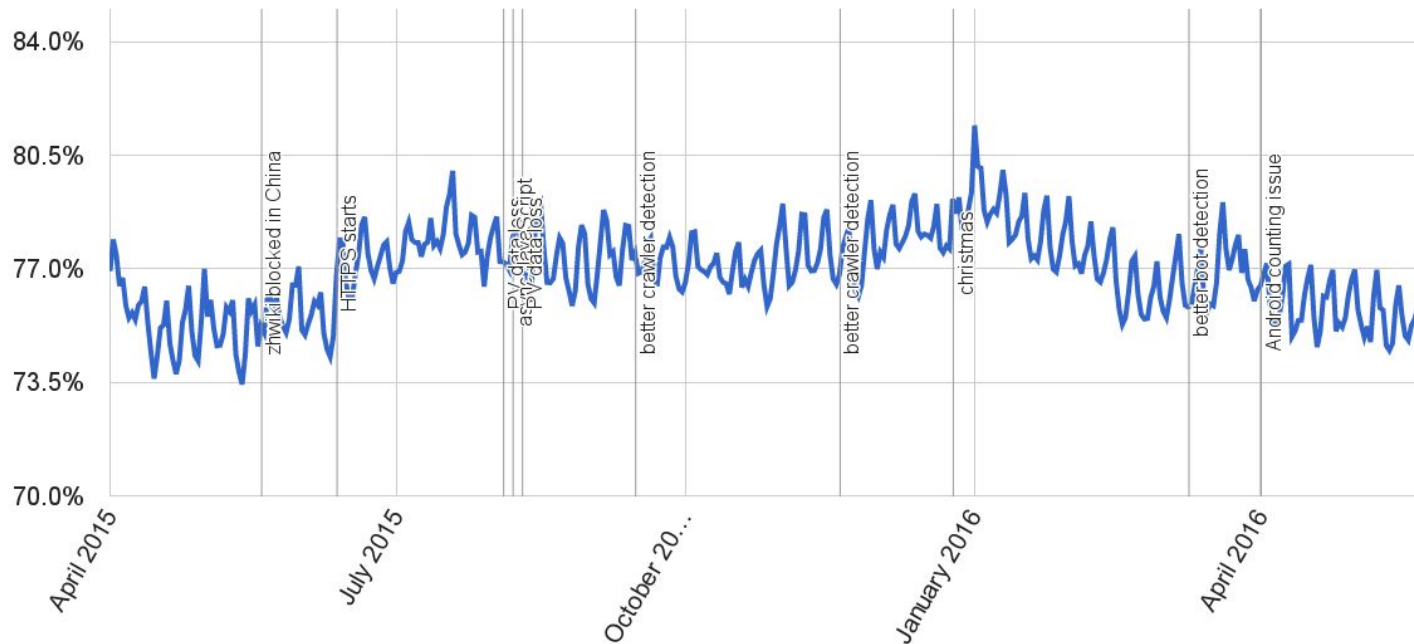

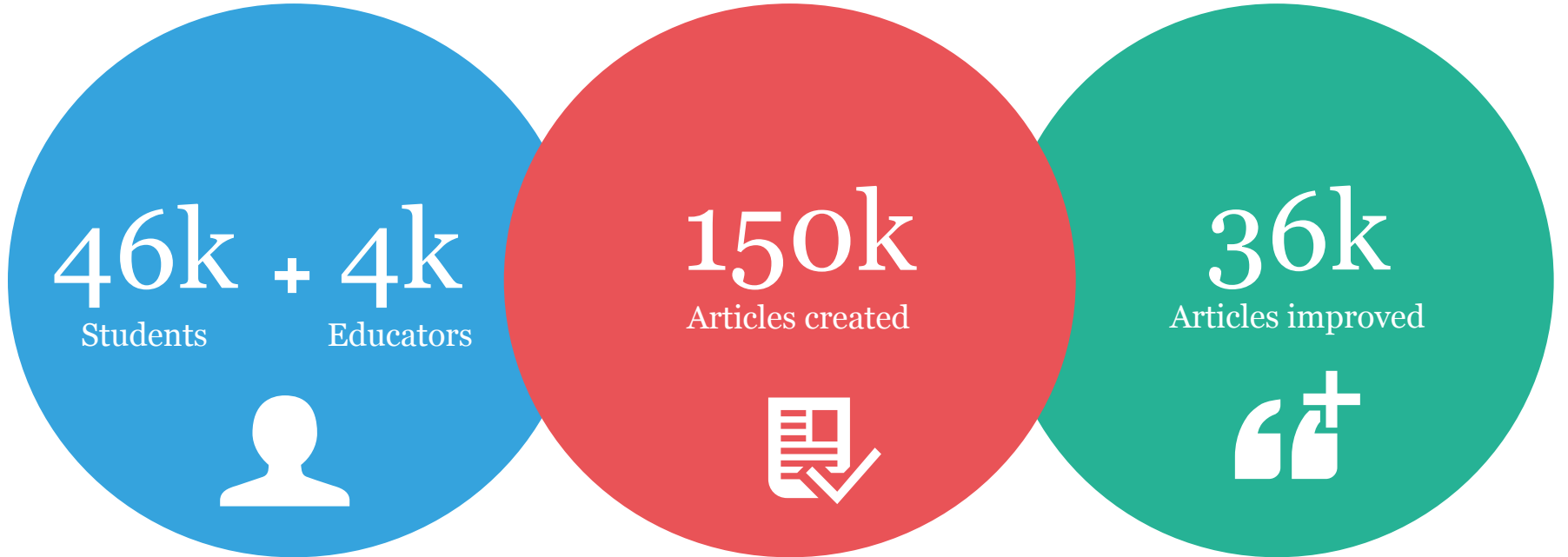

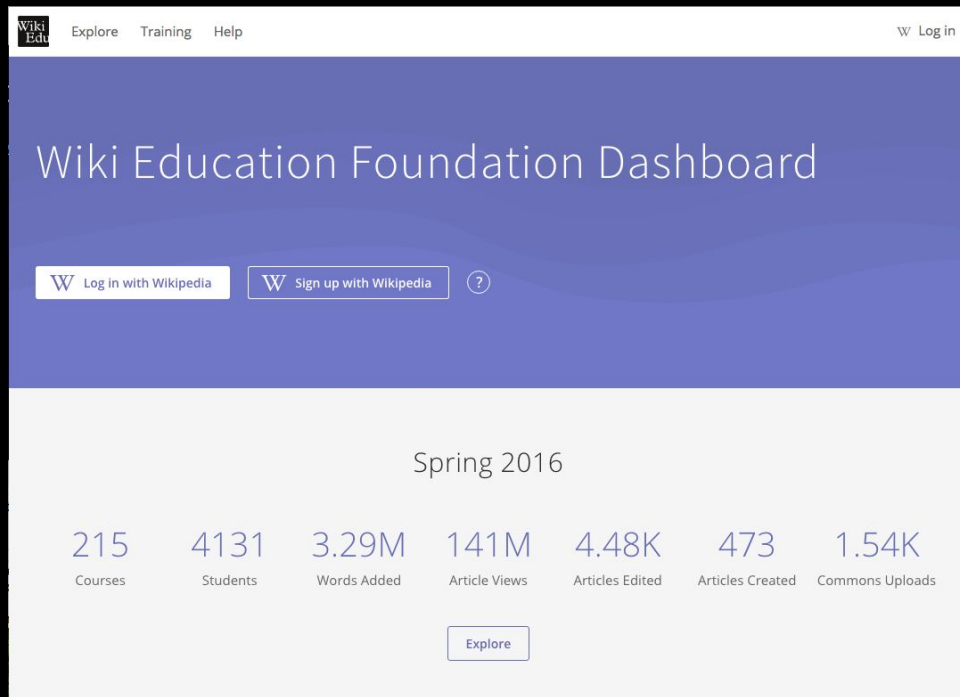
