## FDC Recommendations

- Funds Dissemination Committee: a
   volunteer committee that oversees
   6 million USD in grants
- Met in Warsaw to review Annual Plan
  Grant applications by movement affiliates,
  and also reviewed Wikimedia
  Foundation annual plan.
- 1,138,000 USD recommended funds for allocation, 90% of what was requested in this round.

## Learning Days at WMCON 2016

- **65 people** from 49 different affiliates and the Foundation participated; including staff from Program Capacity and Learning, Community Resources, Technical Collaborations, and Communications.
- 27 program leaders engaged in co-presenting, making it the highest engagement rate so far.
- 4 main focus areas: engaging and retaining volunteers, best practices exchanges with other leaders, designing Wikimedia programs and events, measuring and evaluating impact.

## Europeana Art History Challenge

- A challenge to improve the Wikidata item and create/translate the Wikipedia article about the 10 important artworks from each participating country
- 24 nations joined the challenge
- 850 articles created or improved and raising, 80% increase from baseline.





#### Wikimedia daily pageviews, desktop + mobile



## Long-term traffic trends (reminder/update)






	Annual change (2013-2016, linear)




Historical summary data, since 2005
