COSTELLO commented that the questions and statements made by the committee were all lies and that inasmuch as he was not involved he did not intend to become involved by answering any of their questions. It was PCI's impression, however, that prior to COSTELLO's leaving St. Louis to appear before this committee, he had every intention of pleading the Fifth Amendment. COSTELLO commented that he was not in the least bit interested in the Ace Cab Company which he heads. He was primarily concerned with MOLLY BAKER and her testimony.
