We have received by the ship Bolivar, arrived last evening from Havre, whence she sailed on the 1st of March. Paris papers to the 27th February and the Havre price-current of the 1st of March. The opening of the Chambers, which was to take place on the 2d, was anxiously expected.

Washington March 23. Although there was but little business transacted in either House of Congress yesterday, we are obliged by want of room to omit a detail of it.

The Senate was occupied the greater part of the day, as it has been for several days past, on Executive business; and the House of Representatives spent near four hours of its sitting in the further discussion of the Buffalo and New Orleans Road bill, without coming to a decision upon it.

A considerable number of nominations, it is understood, have been confirmed by the Senate within a few days, in addition to the list which we published yesterday; amongst them, however, it is believed, are none of those which have been the subject of particular public interest as animadversion, unless we except that of General John P. Boyd, as Surveyor of the port of Boston, who was appointed by the President, in the place of the venerable Major Melville, removed, and whose appointment has been confirmed.

WASHINGTON, March 25. We understand that information has been received, at the Department of State, from Mr. Moore, Minister of the United States at Bogota, that President Bolivar, has approved the Convention of the 25th November last, recognizing certain claims of citizens of the United States, and providing for their payment.

The United States' Telegraph of the 24th ult., contains the following official notice: "The Secretary of the Treasury acknowledges the receipt of two thousand dollars, transmitted to him from New-York, by an unknown person, as due to the United States."

New-York, March 22. FROM CARthagENA.—The brig Athenian, Chapman, arrived at this port this morning in 20 days from Carthagena. She was chartered to go to Chagres, and took thence to Carthagena 312 men, 25 officers, and 15 women.

The real designs of Bolivar seem still obscure. The outline of the new form of government, or constitution, adopted by the Congress of Colombia published on Tuesday—establishes the Executive branch in an irresponsible President.

En la sesion de hoy 13 aprobó la cámara de diputados el siguiente acuerdo de la de señores. "Es opuesto al art. 136 de la constitucion general, y por lo mismo insubstancial el decreto expedido en 18 de agosto de 1829 por la legislatura de Michoacán, en cuanto nombra gobernador al ciudadano José Salgado."

Se dió primera lectura a un dictamen de la comision de hacienda, que propone reformado el acuerdo que uno de la otra cámara el 12 del corriente, en estos términos: "Los estados de Yucatán, Tabasco y Chiapas, podrán imponer a los efectos de su produccion respectiva, comprendidos en el art. 13 de la ley de clasificacion de rentas de 4 de agosto de 1824, los derechos de que habla el mismo artículo."

El Sr. Rodriguez: que esta última razon es la que movió a la comision para proponer reformado el acuerdo de la otra cámara: que en los términos en que vino daba a entender que se podía gravar en Yucatán, no solo todas sus producciones, sino las de los otros estados; cuando la mente de la otra cámara fue que únicamente se gravara el palo de tinte: por lo que tampoco podía admitirse la redaccion que propuso el Sr. Arterra, en la que se decía que Yucatán, Tabasco y Chiapas podian gravar todas sus producciones, por haber tratado de gravar su estado la tinta añil. Que a virtud de esta ley, solo podrian gravar dichos estados aquellas producciones que se estaban antes de la de clasificacion de rentas, por la que se creyeron impedidos para seguir haciéndolo.
