

**Turkey - Humanitarian aid to refugees**

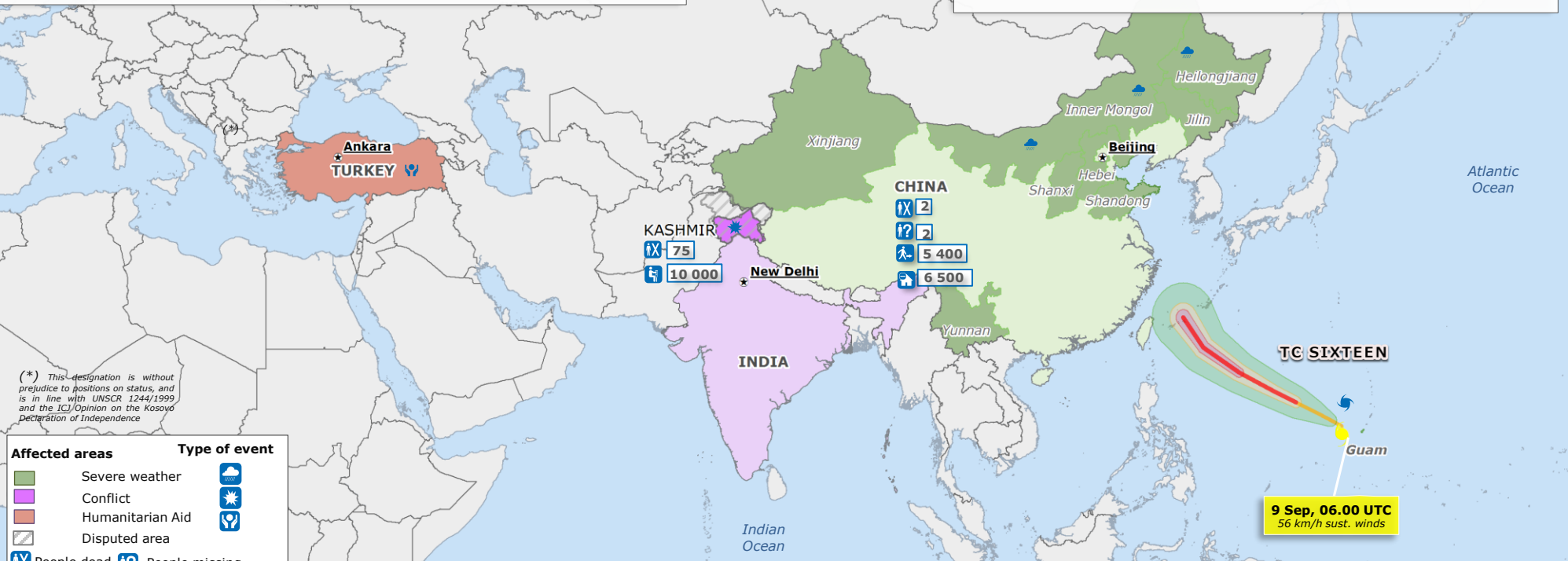
- On 8 September 2016, the EU announced a €348 million contract in humanitarian aid to refugees in Turkey, which constitutes its largest humanitarian aid programme to date.
- The programme will be rolled out in partnership with the Turkish Red Crescent and the Turkish authorities, and is expected to reach as many as one million refugees by the first quarter of 2017.
- The ESSN is part of the €3 billion made available by the EU and its Member States under the "Facility for Refugees in Turkey" in 2016-2017, to provide assistance to refugees and host communities in Turkey. The ESSN contract comes on top of €164 million already contracted for humanitarian aid, and increases the total amount contracted for humanitarian actions under the Facility for Refugees in Turkey to €512 million.

**India - Kashmir Violence**

- After 62 days of violence, the death toll in the on-going crisis in Kashmir has risen to 75, with more than 10 000 people injured.
- According to local media reports, of the 1 732 incidents of violence which took place between 8 August and 7 September 2016, Srinagar district accounted for 24% of the instances, and Anantnag district accounted for 29% of civilian deaths.
- The separatist groups have extended the shut-down strike until 16 September 2016. The strike severely restricts the movement of civilians, with shops forced to close. This situation is likely to continue beyond 16 September 2016.

**Guam (USA) – Tropical Cyclone SIXTEEN**

- A new Tropical Cyclone named "SIXTEEN" formed over the north-western Pacific Ocean, approximately 230 km west of Guam (USA), on 8 September. On 9 September at 6.00 UTC, its centre was located approximately 240 km south-west of Guam (USA), and it had a maximum sustained wind speed of 56 km/h (Tropical Depression)
- Over the next 72 hours, it is forecast to move north-west over open waters, strengthening.

**China - Severe weather**

- Severe weather, including heavy rain, thunderstorms, hail and strong winds has been affecting several parts of the country over the past week, causing damage.
- As of 9 September, national authorities report two people dead, two missing, over 5 400 people evacuated and over 6 500 homes partially or fully damaged in the provinces of Xinjiang, Yunnan, Hebei, Shanxi, Inner Mongolia, Jilin, Heilongjiang and Shandong.
