"Mojahid": Mojahidin Khalgh Organization's Daily Vol. 1 No. 77, sat. May 31, 1980 Military Communique No. 3

- 1. At 7:30 a.m. the military car No.2 carrying Air Force General Harold Price, chief U.S. military adviser in Iran, and his entourage, white it was escorted by another car carrying U.S. security agents, came under the Mojahidin attack on Ghaytarrich st. and was totally destroyed. The car caught fire and the flames rolled for a while.
 - The MKO'S operation which was based on guerrilla warfare was successfully carried out and the Mojahidin left the scene and returned to their base without leaving any tracks.
- 2. In the morning of the same day at 6:45 a.m. a strong time bomb which was planted by the Mojahidin went off and inflicted heavy damages on this den of spies and conspiracy, the U.S. intelligence office on Saba St.
- 3. At 8 a.m. right before the arrival of mischievious Nixon in Iran, a Strong time bomb was exploded by the Mojahidin in Reza Shah's tomb which caused heavy damages. Contrary to the regime's claim that the bomb was planted in an alley in the city of Shahre Ray, it was planted within a 7 yards distance from the main building which was strictly guarded by Savak and CIA agents due to Nixon's visit there. Because of this explosion, Nixon's visitwas delayed for 45 minutes and the visit took place in a fearful atmosphere.
- 4. The explosion of the Irano American Society and the British Cultural Centre by Time bombs, inflicted financial damages on these organizations. Due to potential predictions abouts the site and time of the explosion, no one was hurt durign the operations.
