Cabinet Order concerning Partial amendment
of the Committee for Utilization of
Materials Order

In compliance with the enforcement of the Economic Investigation Board Law (Law No. 206 of 1948), the Cabinet hereby establishes the Cabinet Order for Amending a Part of the Committee for Utilization of Materials Order.

The Committee for Utilization of Materials Order (Cabinet Order No. 194 of 1947) shall partially be amended as follows;

"The Committee for Utilization of Materials Order" shall read "the Material Utilization Council Order."

"The Committee for Utilization of Materials" shall read "the Materials Utilization Council"; "the Central Committee for Utilization of Materials" shall read "the Central Materials Utilization Council"; "the Central Committee" shall read "the Central Council"; "the Local Committee for Utilization of Materials" shall read "the Local Materials Utilization Council"; "the Local Committee" shall read "the Local Council" and "the Committee" shall read "the Council."

In Article 2, Paragraph 2, "the President of the Economic Stabilization Board" shall read "the Director-General of the Central Economic Investigation Board"; and in Paragraph 3, "the competent Minister" shall read "the Heads of the government offices concerned."

In Article 3, Paragraph 1, "the Local Economic Stabilization Office" shall read "the Regional Economic Investigation (Board"; in Paragraphs 1 and 2, "the Director of the Local Economic Stabilization Board" shall read "the Director of the Regional Economic Investigation Board" and in Paragraph 3,

"the Director of the Local Economic Stabilization Office" shall read "the Chiefs of the Local Government Offices concerned."

Article 4 shall be deleted; Article 5 shall be Article 4; Article 6 shall be Article 5 and Article 7 shall be Article 6.

In Article 5, Paragraph 1, "the President of the Economic Stabilization Board" shall read "the Director-General of the Central Economic Investigation Board" and in Paragraph 2, "the Director of the Local Economic Stabilization Office" shall read "the Director of the Regional Economic Investigation Board."

In Article 6, "the Economic Stabilization Board" shall read "the Central Economic Investigation Board" and "the Local Economic Stabilization Office" shall read "the Regional Economic Investigation Board."

Supplementary Provision:

The present Cabinet Order shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

OFFICE AND MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Prime Minister's Office & Minister of Transportation Ordinance No. 12

October 4, 1948

In accordance with the provisions of Par. 2 of Art. 25 of the Sea Casualties Inquiry Law (Law No. 135 of 1947), the Regulations for Registry of Marine Counsellors shall be established as follows:

Regulations for Registry of Marine Counsellors

Article 1. The Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry shall conduct the business relating to the registry of marine counsellors.

Article 2. The Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry shall keep the register book of Marine Counsellors in the said Court and register the following items pertaining to Marine Counsellors:

1111 -- 1960

- (1) Name
- (2) Date of birth
- (3) Permanent domicile
- (4) Address
- (5) Location of office
- (6) Date of registry

Article 3. Any person who intends to be registered as a Marine Counsellor shall submit a written application, in which the name, date of birth, permanent domicile and location of his office are stated, to the Chief Judge, High Marine Court of Inquiry.

The application mentioned in the preceding paragraph shall be accompanied by a document certifying that the applicant has the qualification for a Marine Counsellor in accordance with Arts. 12 and 13 of the Enforcement Regulations for the Sea Casualties Inquiry Law (Ministry of Transportation Ordinance No. 8 of 1948).

Article 4. The Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry shall, when the application mentioned in the preceding Article has been made, effect the registry and give a notice to that effect to the applicant except in the case where the registry has been refused in accordance with the provisions of Art. 14.

Article 5. A Marine Counsellor, shall, when he intends to retire from his duty apply for cancellation of the registry.

Article 6. A Marine Counsellor shall, when he has changed his name, transferred his domicile, changed his address or removed his office, apply for alteration of registry thereof, without delay, to the Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry.

Article 7. When a Marine Counsellor has died, his successor or relation shall, without delay, make a report to that effect to the Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry.

Article 8. The Chief Judge of High Marine Court of Inquiry shall cancel the registry of a Marine Counsellor in the case of falling under any of the following items:

(1) In case the application for cancellation of registry has been made in accordance with Art. 5; (2) In case the Marine Counsellor has died;

(3) In case the Marine Counsellor has been disqualified.

Article 9. The Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry shall, when he has refused or retracted the registry of a Marine Counsellor in accordance with the provisions of Art. 14 of the Enforcement Regulations for the Sea Casua-Ities Inquiry Law or has cancelled the said registry in accordance with the provisions of Item 3 of the preceding Article, give a notice To all Ministries to that effect to the person in question.

The reasons for the refusal, retraction or cancellation shall be attached to the notice mentioned in the preceding paragraph.

Article 10. Any person who intends to be registered as a Marine Counsellor or to have the registry of alteration effected shall pay a registration fee of \\$2,000 or \\$50 per one item respectively.

The registration fee mentioned in the preced. ing paragraph shall be paid with a revenue stamp equivalent to the sum thereof pasted on the written application.

Article 11. The Chief Judge of the High Marine Court of Inquiry shall, when he has effected or cancelled the registry of a Marine Counsellor, announce to that effect in the Official Gazette.

Supplementary Provisions:

This Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The following partial amendment shall be made to the Enforcement Regulations for the Sea Casualties Inquiry Law:

Article 14 shall be deleted and Article 15 shall be Article 14.

Article 15. The registry of Marine Counsellors shall conform to the Regulations for Registry of Marine Counsellors as well as to the provisions of the present Regulations.

In Article 25, "investigation" shall read "inquiry."
