





Reference report required by Letter AGMGL 091, Hqs 8th Army dated 7 July 1949, the following information is submitted herewith:

(a) Since no party affiliation was indicated or required in the filing of candidates for Agricultural Land Commissioners in election held 18 Aug 49, list of names of the 3821 successful candidates is omitted from this report.

(b) The fact that considerable interest was manifested in this election is best indicated by the statistics on participation:

A breakdown of the figures shows that rural (gun) area voting percentage was 78.3 and that of urban (cities) area 67.73. The highest voting percentage, (91%) however, was observed in Ashiya-shi.

The Election Administration Committees of Prefecture Cities, Towns and Villages, owing to inadequacy of fund, resorted to "inexpensive" publicity measures. The Prefectural Committee had NHK broadcast on the election, stimulating interest in voting and asked the Prefectural Board of Education for cooperation in utilizing pupils to urge their parents to vote.

The prefectural Committee also printed about 10,000 publicity posters.

Some of the Election Administration Committees of cities, towns and villages conducted their information and education campaign by addressing to the audiences at various meetings such as CI & E movie showings, or conferences on economic recovery.

No significant campaign strategy by candidates was noted, except the case of one who printed his career and his "aspirations" for distribution among voters, which is considered a rather unusual campaigning in a local election. This candidate was elected.

(c) No violation of election laws has been reported.

1. Candidates:

a. The Prefectural Election Administration Committee reports that all candidates were independent without support of any political party.

2. Summary of Election:

a. An overall average of 78% of total electorate was registered. Only 70 districts, (representing 34.3%), of total 204 voting districts, had a contested class, or classes, as follows:

27 districts	One (1) class contested
27 districts	Two (2) classes contested
16 districts	Three (3) classes contested

Total 70 districts

b. All available media in Ishikawa Prefecture was employed to stimulate interest in the Agricultural Land Commission Election. Prefectural Public Relations truck toured the electoral districts expressing the importance of this election. 96,000 leaflets were distributed to the farmers in June and July; and 2,200 posters were distributed in July to remind them of their duties as citizens, to vote in this election. Seventeen radio broadcasts were made to insure the dissemination of information on this election to remote and outlying districts. On 1 August, the two principal newspapers began printing daily articles, explaining phases of the law and pointing out the individual's responsibility in electing honest and conscientious committeemen.


c. Campaigning for election did not advance beyond the state of placing posters throughout individual voting districts. This policy was adopted by a small number of candidates creating a cool and uneventful campaign period. Political strategy was not evident, as this election was not contested in 65.7% of the voting districts in this Prefecture.



1. General Account of Agricultural Land Commission Election

a. In this prefecture there are 172 electoral districts and 516 classes, out of which, 79 districts and 358 classes elected candidates without a vote. Of three classes the third class had the most candidates and accordingly there was strong competition among them.

Despite the bad weather, the average percentage of voters to those eligible was 76%, which shows the farmers were very much interested in the election. There were some blocks where they did not have enough candidates or qualified candidates, and so another election is scheduled for the end of September to fill 22 vacancies. In two villages there were no 1st class voters and in another village there were no 2d class voters, consequently the total number of the authorized members in this prefecture has been decreased from 1720 to 1714.

b. The Prefectural Election Administration Commission and the Prefectural Farm Land and Information Sections, supported by this headquarters, gave effective publicity to the election. They used a truck equipped with a loudspeaker for two days and distributed leaflets through out the prefecture; distributing them to every household of voters. They posted bulletins in each block, and used the press, radio and slides as publicity media. They also held lectures to educate the officials who were concerned with the election.

c. The campaign issues and political strategy of both candidates and political parties were not very significant, except those of the communists. The slogans used by the Communist Party were "Overthrow the Yoshida Cabinet", "Release all the farmland withheld by landowners", "Give back all the mountains and forests to the tenant", etc.

It is clearly understood that the Communist Party tried to increase their power in the localities by sending more candidates to the committee than before. However, because of the struggle against the dismissal of the public workers, their activity was not so strong as it had been anticipated.

d. There were no serious violations, except a minor case of the door to door visits which involves 18 suspects in Ichinomiya-mura, Kagawa-gun, Kagawa-ken.



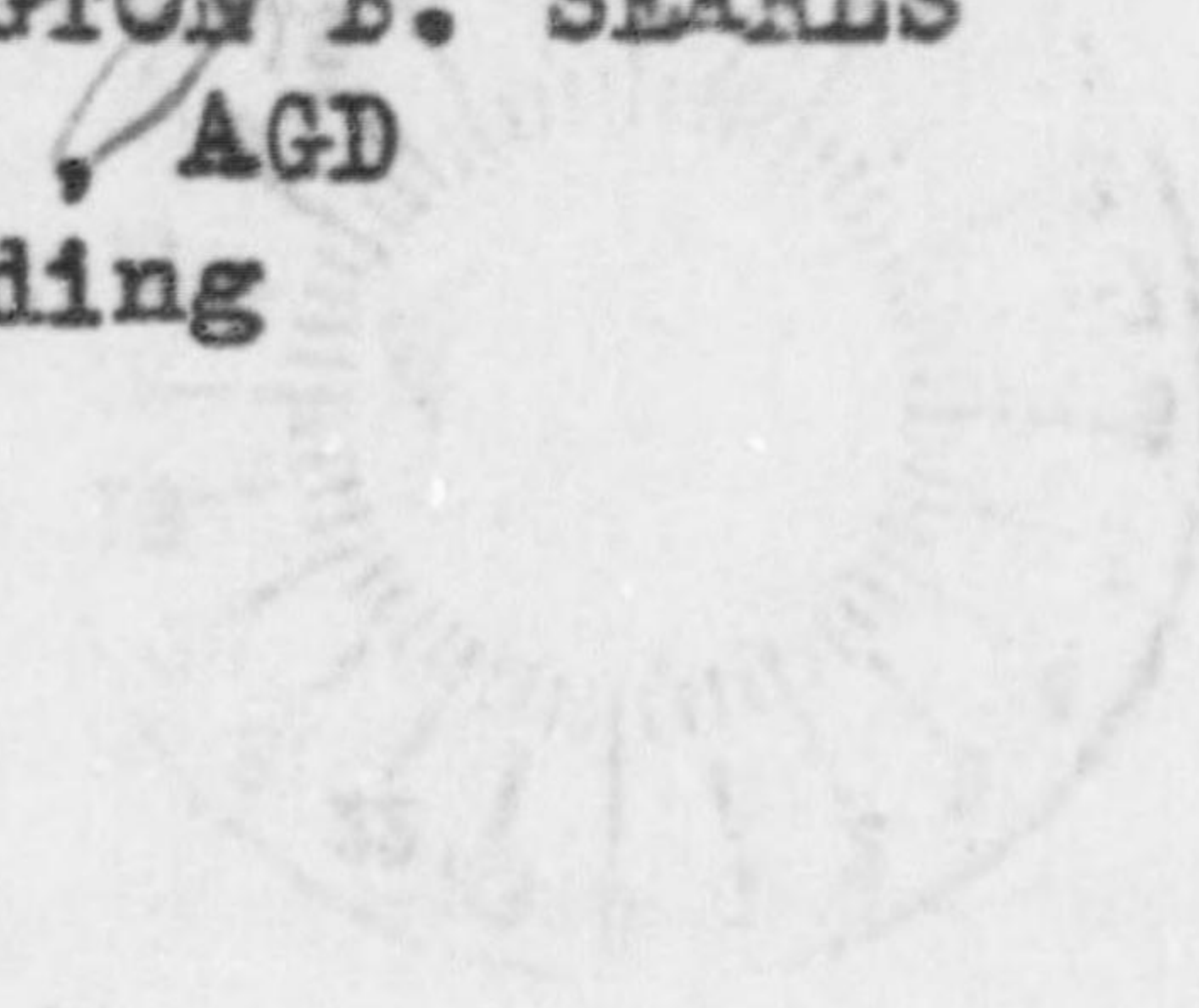



3. a. Of the eligible voters 81.8% voted, this shows an increase over the previous election in which only 70% voted. However the larger number of abstainers were the women with only 74.1% voting compared to 90.1% of the men. The increase interest is credited largely to the publicity campaign of the election and the important programs carried out by the previous land commission.

b. The publicity was under the joint supervision of Gun Chiefs, Mayors, Village Heads and Farm Land Relation Committees. Through these channels the 230,000 leaflets and 2,000 posters printed by the Ministry of Agriculture were distributed to the 210,000 farm families. The Prefecture Farm Land Section published and distributed 40,000 leaflets, held round-table meeting and used the 375 C.P. Halls in the Prefecture to disseminate information of the election. Prefecture Farm Land Section officials were sent to many of the outlining districts to increase the publicity and interest of voting. Field trip to outlining districts were made by members of the C.A. Team before the election to check the publication of the election. It was found the election had been given wide publicity and that all printed information passed down to the villages from the Prefecture had been distributed in proper order. Many individual farmers were contacted and all were found to be well informed of the election and realized the importance of it.

c. The main campaign issues made by the Socialist were to revise the present farmland law, fight against the conservative party and expel the present bosses and elect members of Socialist Party. The communist used slogans such as, "Down with the Yoshida Cabinet", "Opposition of Malicious Seizure of Lands" etc. With these slogans as topics lectures

meetings were held in each district and many street speeches were made throughout the Prefecture. In some districts independent candidates withdrew because of the large number of candidates backed by the Farmers Unions. The Farmers Unions are very closely associated with the Social and Communist Parties.

4. No violations of any election laws were reported.

1. In compliance with letter, Headquarters Eighth Army, AGMGL-091, above subject, dated 7 July 1949, the following report is hereby submitted.

2. There have been no reported cases of serious election law violations at this time.

3. Publicity, in relation to this election has been very good through all media. This is evidenced by the favorable turn out of registered voters. There was a total of 168,484 registered voters for this election. 128,031 voters appeared at the poles and cast their ballot, a total of 75.99% of those registered. This is a very favorable turn out in comparison with 79% in the general election, 23 January 1949. 1,740 committeemen were declared elected without election being held.

4. There was a total of 3,321 positions to be filled. 3,739 candidates filed for election and 3,316 candidates were elected. There are 5 unfilled positions.

2. a. The election for members of the Agricultural Land Commission was widely publicized through mediums of radio, press, posters, leaflets, film and slide showings and meetings held by members of this team. Two posters of 2,000 each prepared by the Prefectural Information Office and leaflets supplied by the Ministry of Agriculture, with sufficient copies for each farm household, were distributed throughout the Prefecture. Radio broadcasts concerning the election were made weekly from 22 July through 17 August and continued press conferences were held by Prefectural and District officials to keep the election before the public. Railway public address systems were utilized and slides were shown in commercial theaters advertising the election.


b. Thirty-four farmers' meetings concerning the election were held by Prefectural officials and district offices held additional local meetings. During these meetings, lectures were illustrated by film slides. CIE films were also made available for this program.

c. A number of communities were visited by Civil Affairs personnel prior to the election. During these meetings, the election and the workings of the Commission were explained. Teams from this organization maintained surveillance of the election, covering all guns.

d. 68% of the registered voters in this Prefecture have voted.

e. Prominent campaign issues of the candidates were arbitration of tenancy disputes and the exchange, division and price control of land.

TO : Commanding General, Eighth Army, APO 343

1. In spite of a heavy rainfall, floods which inundated the land and impassable roads 80% of the men and 60% of the women went to polls in this prefecture on 18 August 1949. This is remarkable when taking into consideration two factors: (1) Little interest was displayed prior to the election and (2) an estimated 400,000,000 Yen damage was inflicted on the prefecture on the same day.

2. Less than 1% of all candidates were of the communist party, 91% being independents, the balance being other parties with the labor-farmers party having no candidates. Thirty-nine (39)% of the towns and villages election ended in a non-voting election. Seven towns were forced to postpone the election due to the flood.

3. This team had six surveillance teams in the field on election day and visited 43 polling stations. One violation was noted wherein a successful candidate was also a member of the public safety commission which necessitated a re-election. Another instance noted wherein the voters were deprived of their voting right. Both of these instances were brought to the attention of the proper Japanese authorities.

4. Many reasons can be given for the unexpected interest in the election, but chief among these are:

- a. Voters in general have come to be election conscious.
- b. Voters have suddenly realized that who they elect has a direct bearing on their livelihood.
- c. The election campaigns were thoughtfully conducted due to the fact that the spheres of electioneering were limited within small districts.
- d. Voters became disgusted with incompetent and unscrupulous land commissioners.

1. In compliance with Headquarter's Eighth Army memorandum AGMGL 091, dated 7 July 1949, Farm Land Commission Committee elections report is hereby submitted.

2. Name, location of committee to which elected, and names of supporting political party of each successful candidate is listed in enclosure.

3. Despite the adverse weather conditions, 74.6% of the eligible voters turned out to vote, this was an improvement over the 69% that turned out for the 1947 elections.

4. The greater interest displayed by the farmers is probably attributable to the wide publicity given to the elections through the media of the press, radio, leaflets and posters. Lectures were also organized by Economic Section of this team, in conjunction with the Farm Land Section of the Prefectural Office.

5. There were one hundred and forty-nine (149) non-voting elections in this prefecture. The majority of these were in groups 1 and 2. Twenty-six (26) committees, did not have sufficient candidates to fill their quota. It is hoped to fill these vacancies at an election to be held in approximately one (1) months time.

6. No violations were observed nor were any reported.

In Akita Prefecture a total of 3,473 candidates filed candidacies, a total of 2,270 seats were to be filled as a result of the election only 2,257 candidates were elected due to delayed action in screening candidates by the Shimohama Village Election Administration Committee and Inaba Village and Fujikoto Village the required number of candidates did not file candidacies, as a result partial re-election will be held in September, at present 13 seats are vacant.

5. Routine publicity was given thru election by each town and village election administration committees through, handbills, posters, and announcements on bulletin boards.

6. There were no prominent campaign issues in Akita Prefecture; as a rule four or five communist candidates would file candidacies, then two or three days before the election, the candidates would cancel candidacies so as to throw all the support behind one candidate, consequently eliminating a split vote.

1. Reference: Letter AGMGL 091, Headquarters Eighth Army, Subject "Reports Required for Agricultural Land Commissions Election", dated 7 July 1949.

2. A list of party-affiliated successful candidates is attached hereto in compliance with paragraph 3 a, above reference.

3. Elections were performed in 204 districts out of a total of 265 districts in the prefecture. In the remaining 61 districts the number of candidates equalled the number of positions to be filled; therefore no elections were necessary.

4. Positions to be filled totalled 2641. The number of candidates competing for these positions totalled 3206; 100 of whom were party-affiliated. Communist party candidates totalled 61, of whom 28 were successful. 32 Socialist party candidates were successful. 2560 of the successful candidates were Independents. Total number of persons elected is 2627; leaving a total of 14 vacancies to be considered by the Prefectural Commission.

8. No violations of election laws have been detected or reported and no unusual incidents occurred during the election.

9. The extent of surveillance by this team was by liaison with the Prefectural Local Affairs Section and discussions with local officials throughout the prefecture.
