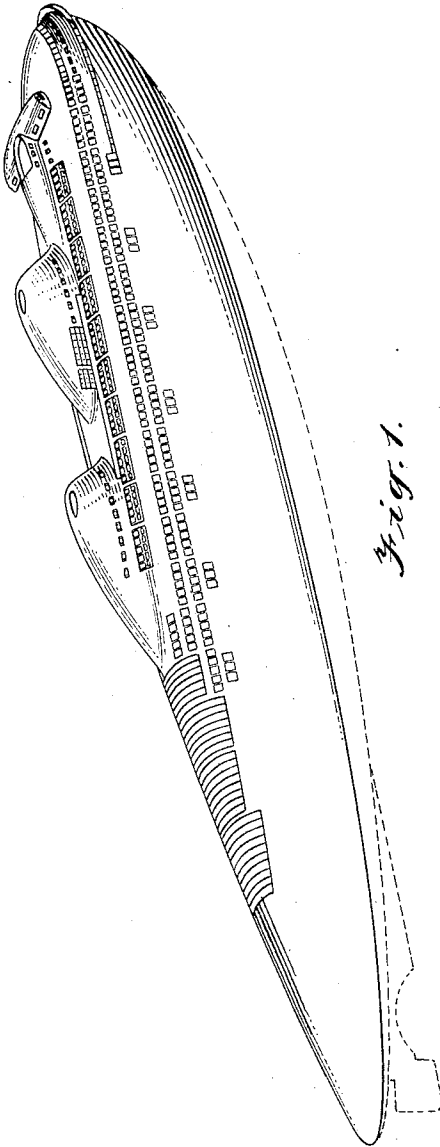

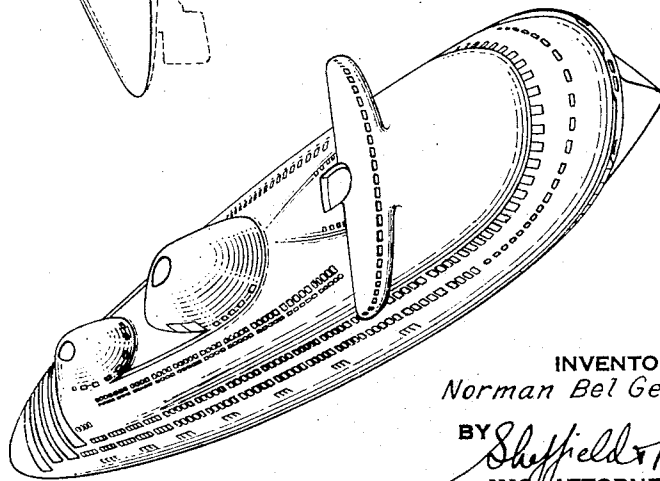

DESIGN FOR A BOAT

Norman Bel Geddes, New York, N. Y.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, NORMAN BEL GEDDES, a citizen of the United States, residing in the Borough of Manhattan, city, county, and State of New York, have invented a certain new, original, and ornamental Design for Boats, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing forming a part thereof, in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a boat embodying my design, the boat being viewed from a point abaft the starboard beam and somewhat from above; and

Fig. 2 is a perspective view thereof taken from a point off the starboard bow and somewhat above the boat.

It will be understood that that portion of the boat which is normally visible, i. e., that part which is normally above the water line thereof, is the dominant feature of my design.

The external form and contour of the boat shown herein are shown, described, and claimed in an application for design Letters Patent of the United States filed simultaneously herewith, Serial No. D—49,617.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a boat substantially as shown and described.
