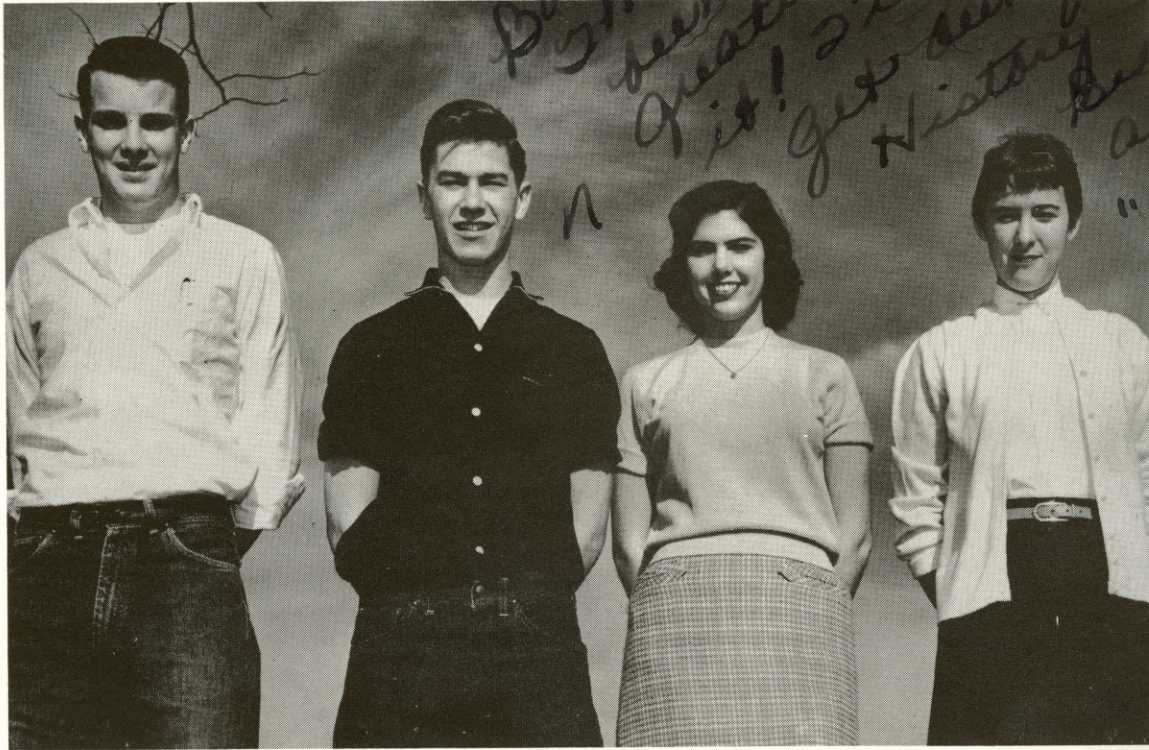
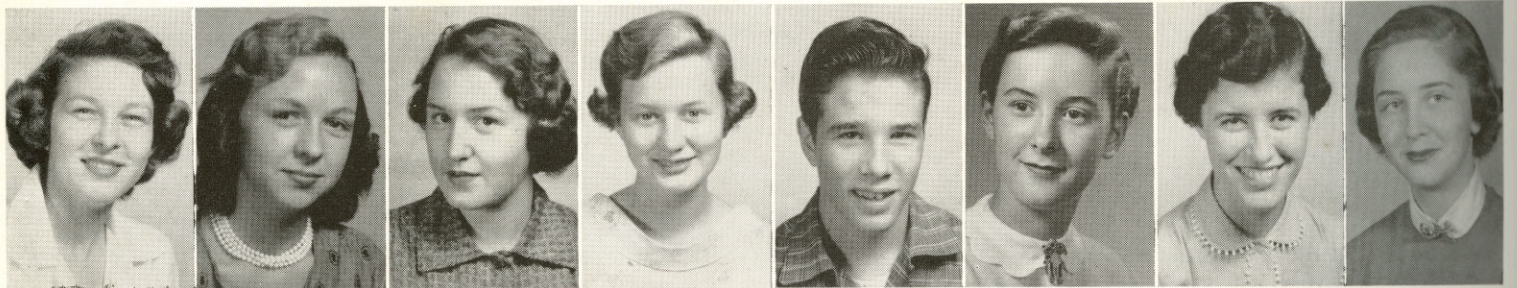


# JUNIORS
