Problems



- No central notification system
- Ad-hoc approach is inefficient



- Users are not notified of key events
- Users are confused by current notices







Solutions

• Provide a unified user experience



Help developers add it to their code



Promote editor engagement

Here are some of the benefits of notifications for end users.


- be aware of what's going on

(combines Contributions and Watchlist)

- Your edit was undone
- A page you edited has been tagged
- A page you started has been reviewed
- A file you uploaded has been featured
- A page on your watchlist has been edited
- A page on your watchlist has been tagged
- A page on your watchlist has been featured

□ Talk

(includes Messages, Help, Feedback)

- · Someone left a message on your talkpage
- · Someone sent you WikiLove
- Someone mentioned your name
- Someone answered your TeaHouse question
- Someone replied to your feedback post

Note: many of these to be included in Flow

General


(include Account, News, Tasks)

- You are now an auto-confirmed editor.
- You are now a reviewer
- An announcement was just posted
- · A new edition of Signpost is published
- Someone requested a page be deleted

Note: many of these could be handled by other applications than Echo.


Story 1: Talk page comment

As a **user**, I can find out if there are **comments** on my **talk page**.




Story 2: Edit was undone

As an editor, I can find out if my edit has been undone, with a link to a diff page.




Story 3: Page was reviewed

As an editor, I can find out if my new page has been reviewed, on the web and via email.

Triggers

Here are some of the key triggers for notifications, which can define our software 'archetypes'.

First Release:


- edit triggered by any edit to a given page
- special edit triggered by tags, templates, categories, reverts
- core software action triggered by a MediaWiki function (e.g. page delete)
- extension action triggered by a MediaWiki extension (e.g. AFT hide)

Future Releases:

- edit series triggered by a series of edit over time
- special edit series triggered by special edits over time
- invitation/announcement triggered manually by publisher
- confirmation triggered by a user action or status change
- help triggered by special rules for random help messages
- pageview tracking triggered by pages exceeding views thresholds
- user watching triggered by a given user taking a given action

User touchpoints

As a user, I can view or manage my notifications through these touchpoints.



- Deploy on MediaWiki throughout 2012
- First release on En-Wiki in Jan. 2013
- Second release around March 2013?
- Third release around June 2013?

First Release

Here is our proposed scope for the first release, due in Jan. 2013.

IN-SCOPE:

- focus on logged-in users
- only en-wiki and mediawiki
- only notifications about:
 - your contributions
 - your talk page
 - your watchlist (partial?)
- build these features:
 - **flyout** (single list)
 - all notifications page
 - notifications preferences
 - email notifications (plain text)

OUT OF SCOPE:

- no support for anonymous users
- no cross-wiki support in 1st release
- **no** notifications for:
 - public announcements
 - your account
 - your tasks
- limited mobile support (mobile web/tablets?)

We may address these tasks in next 2013 releases.

Open questions

Here are some of the questions we'd like to answer in coming weeks.

- which key features are 'must-have' ?
- which events are 'notification-worthy'?
- which watchlist events should be included?
- how do we handle talk until Flow is ready?
- how do we support cross-wiki in next release?
- how do we support mobile in next release?
- should we support subscriptions in next release?


