Your headquarters will supervise the inventory, packing, crating and transportation of the German property listed on inclosed inventories located in Osaka, Kobe and Motoyama to the Custodian, Eighth Army Civil Property Warehouse, Osaka, by the Japanese Government as directed by SCAPIN 5645-A, 25 May 1948.

2. Explanation of any discrepancies between the amount of property listed on inventories and amount seized will be included in this report.

3. The Japanese Government will make out ten (10) copies of the Tally-In Receipt for each seizure. The distribution will be as follows:

- a. One (1) copy to owner of property.
- b. One (1) copy to Japanese Government representative.
- c. One (1) copy to Custodian, Civil Property Warehouse.
- d. One (1) copy for your files.
- e. Six (6) copies to this headquarters.

4. You will notify Custodian of the Civil Property Warehouse, Osaka at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to arrival of the property at the warehouse.
