

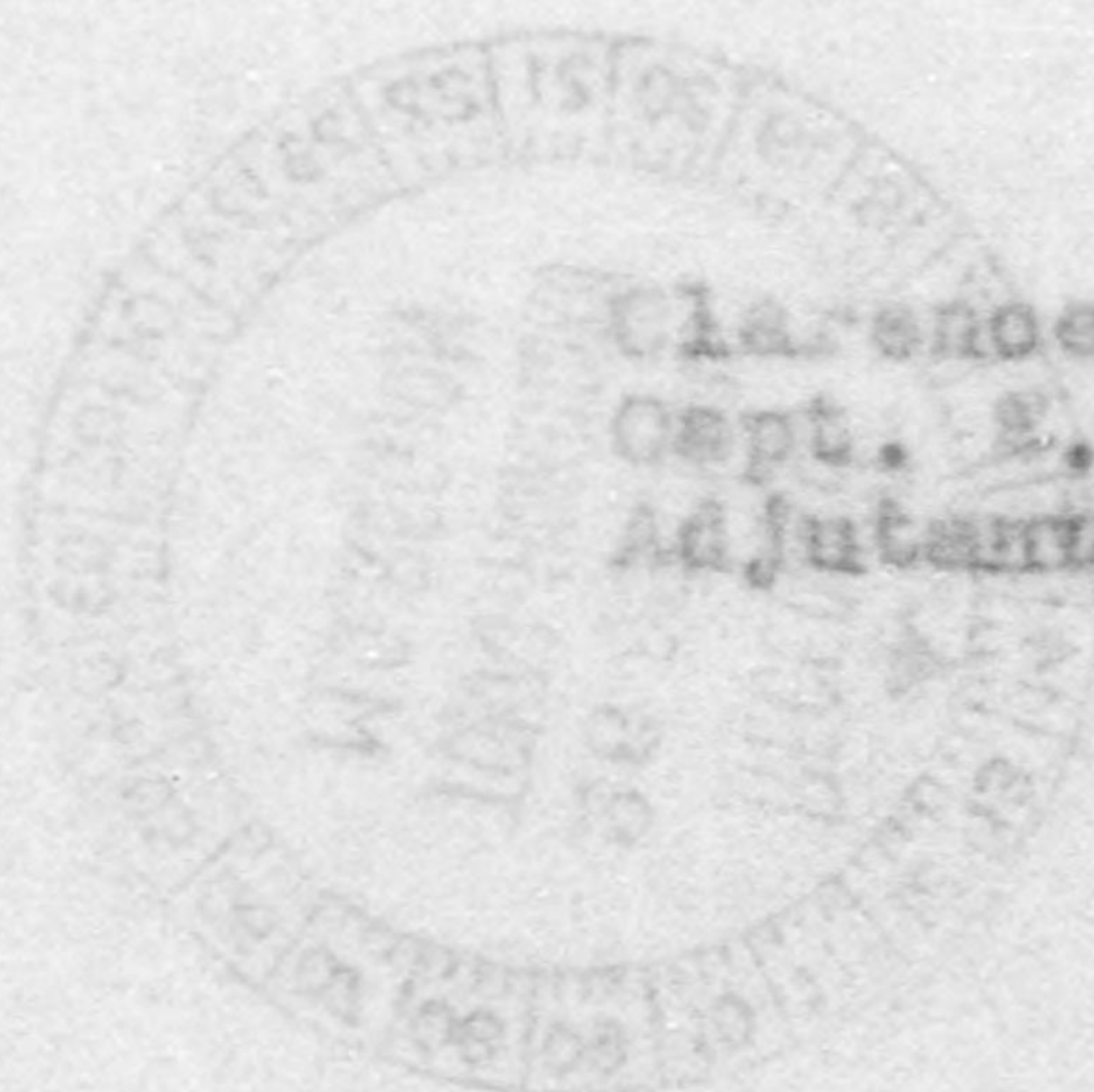



The reason of application

Our Hatori Factory was designated as the pre-  
serving area for the whole zone, and 5 buildings,  
181 machine-tools, 3 industrial machines and 15  
electrical equipments, altogether 199 machines were  
in the custody.

However, on account of imperfect institution, the  
good conservancy of the said machines was quite  
difficult, and according to the instruction of the  
Shizuoka Military Government dated Sept. 4th, the  
whole machines were removed to No. 204 building  
of Takamatsu Factory.

The removal of these machines was perfectly  
completed by the 20th October. At present 17
