SUBJECT : Witness - NAKAJIMA, Tetsuzo (ITAGAKI)

1. Above named witness has been summoned on behalf of ITAGAKI and is expected to give testimony to the effect "That as Vice Chief of the Japanese General Staff in 1935 when the Holkingol River (Monohan) Incident occurred, he was sent to Manchuria by the Japanese Government with the directions to end the fighting between the Japanese and Soviets, irrespective of whether strategical advantage or disadvantage resulted; that the Japanese Government did not desire the affair to spread into large scale operations, and that the Kwantung Army in such affair acted in self-defense."

2. Request you furnish us with such data, document or summary of prosecution evidence as you may have which can be utilized to advantage for purposes of cross-examination or re-buttal.
