- 2 000** People evacuated
- 800** Houses affected

SITUATION

- Heavy rain has been affecting several northern provinces over the past week days causing floods.
- According to local media, as of 22 May at 7.00 UTC, 2 000 people were evacuated in Uttaradit province and 800 houses were damaged in Kamphaeng Phet.
- Over the next 24 h moderate to locally heavy rain is forecast for the northern and northeast areas of the country, including the ones already affected. The National Disaster Warning Center, as of 22 May at 7.00 UTC, has warned population about the risk of flash floods in the eastern and southern provinces of the country.

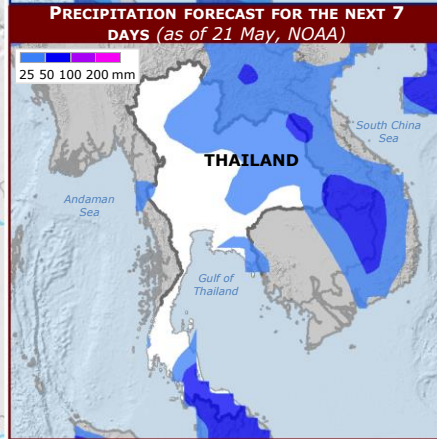
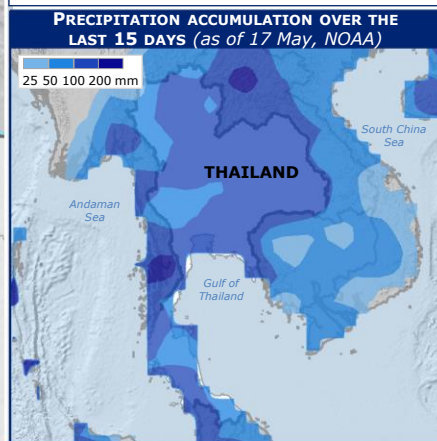
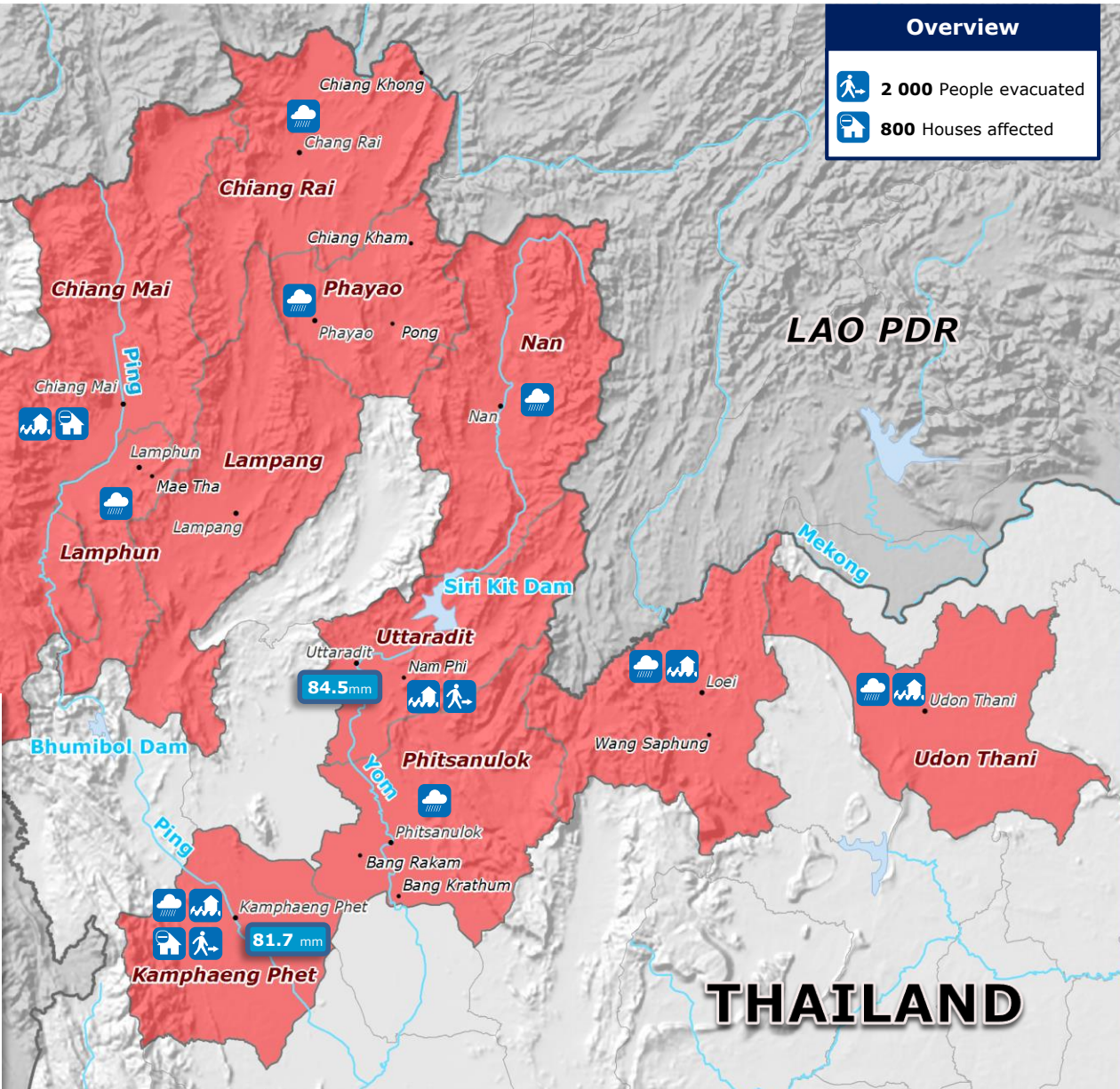
