An Act

To repeal an unnecessary medical device reporting requirement.

Oct. 2, 1996

[H.R. 2366]

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

SECTION 1. REPEAL.

Section 1862 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y) is amended by striking subsection (h).
