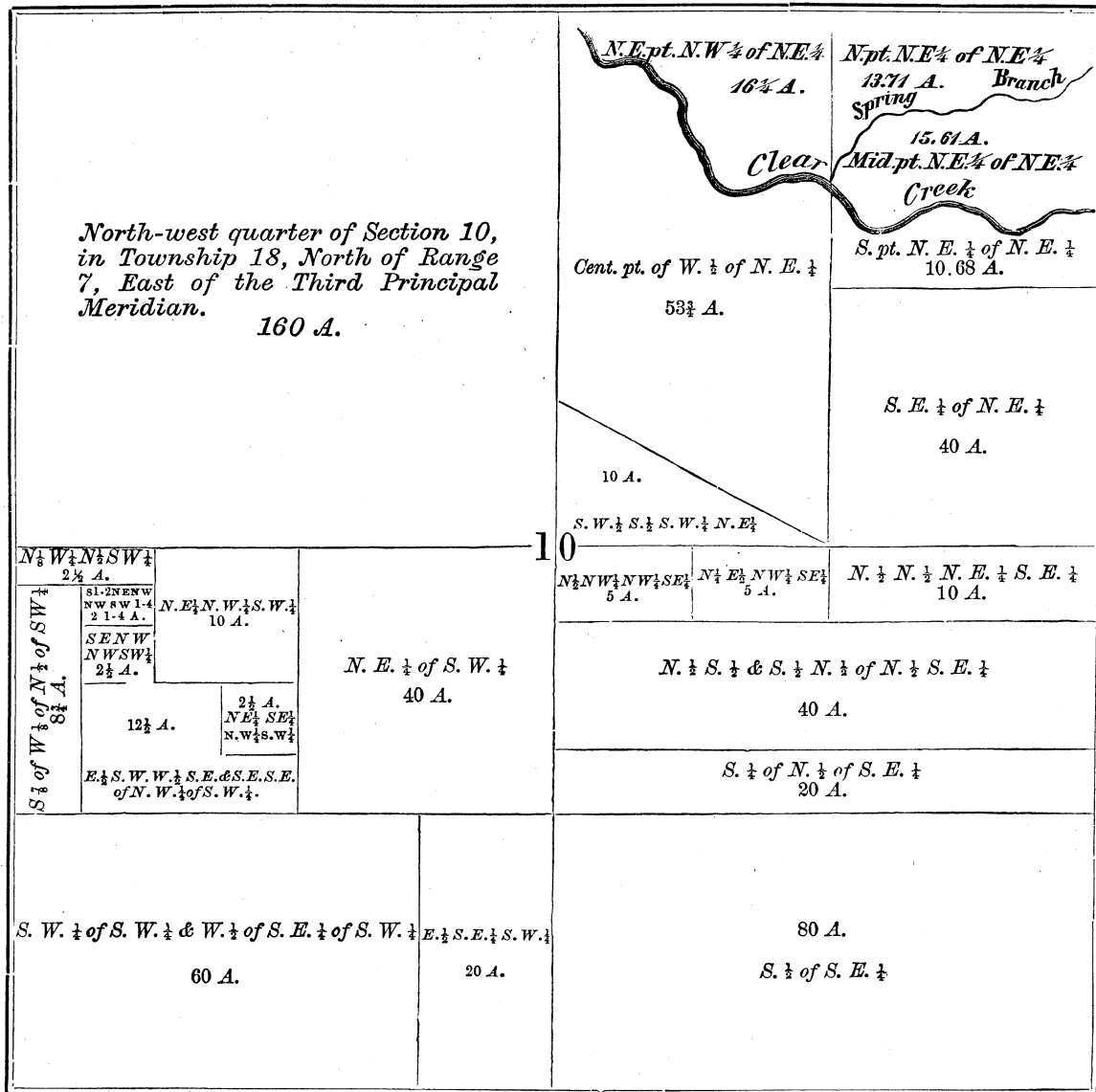

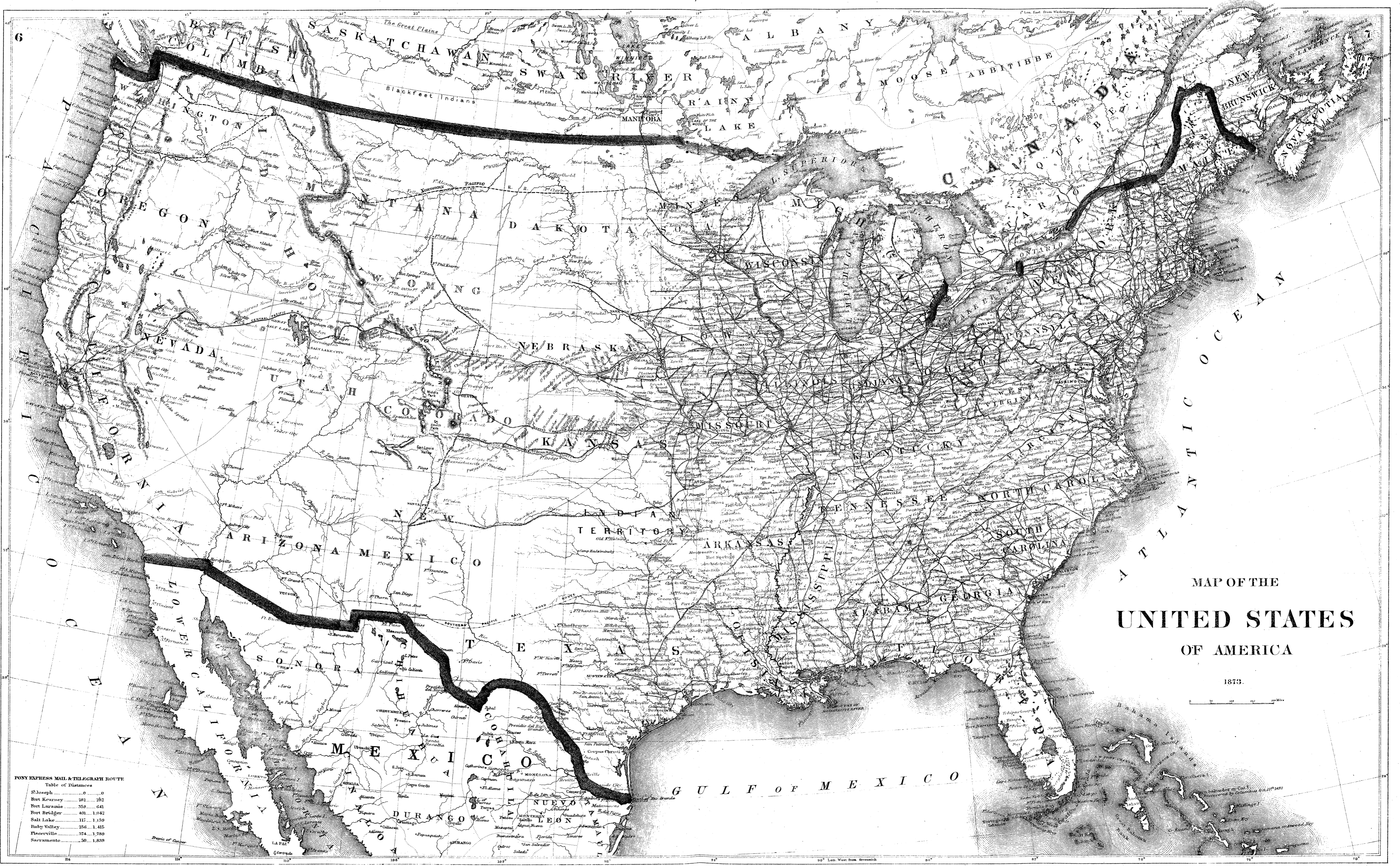

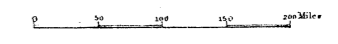
MAP OF THE

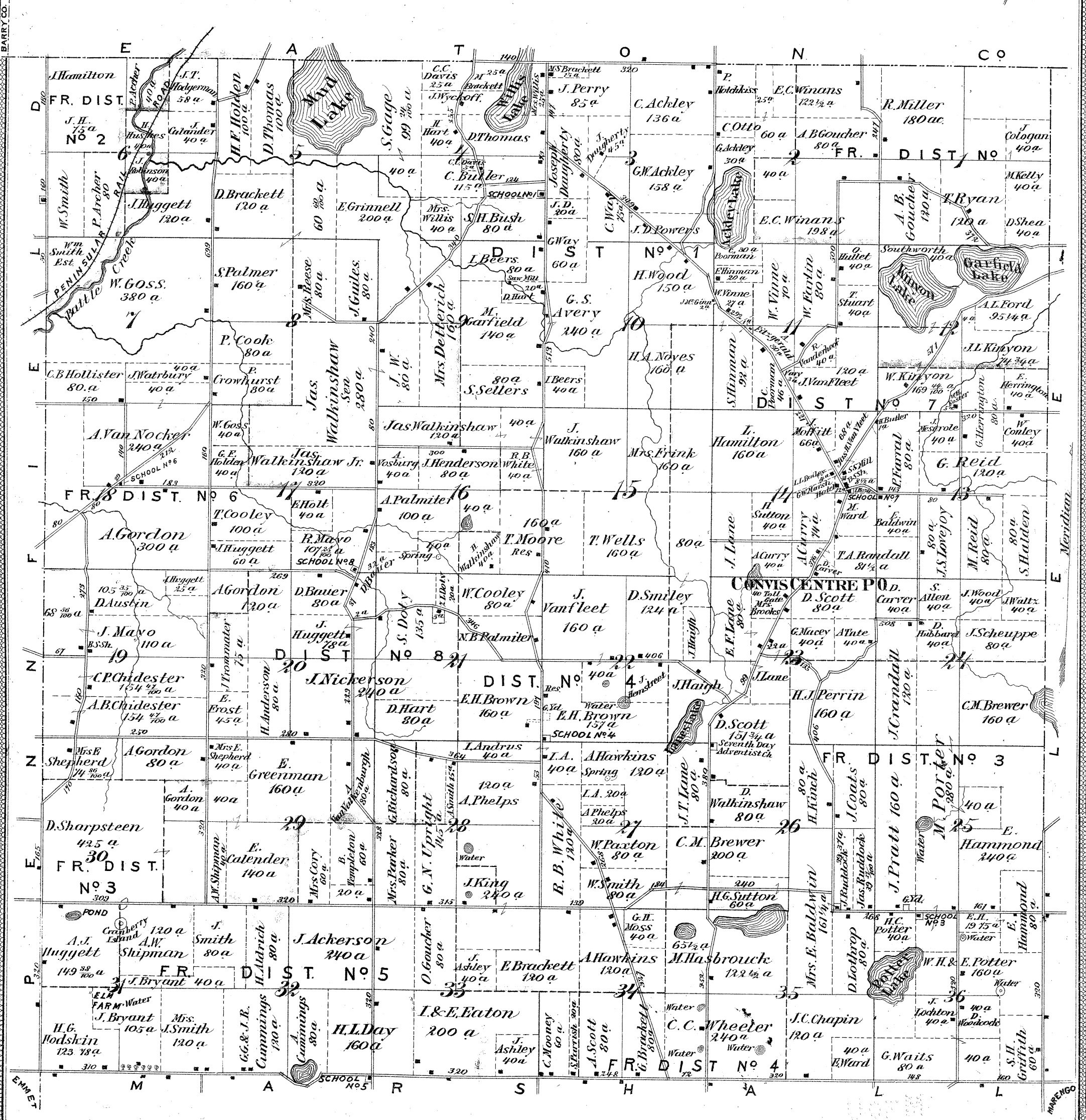

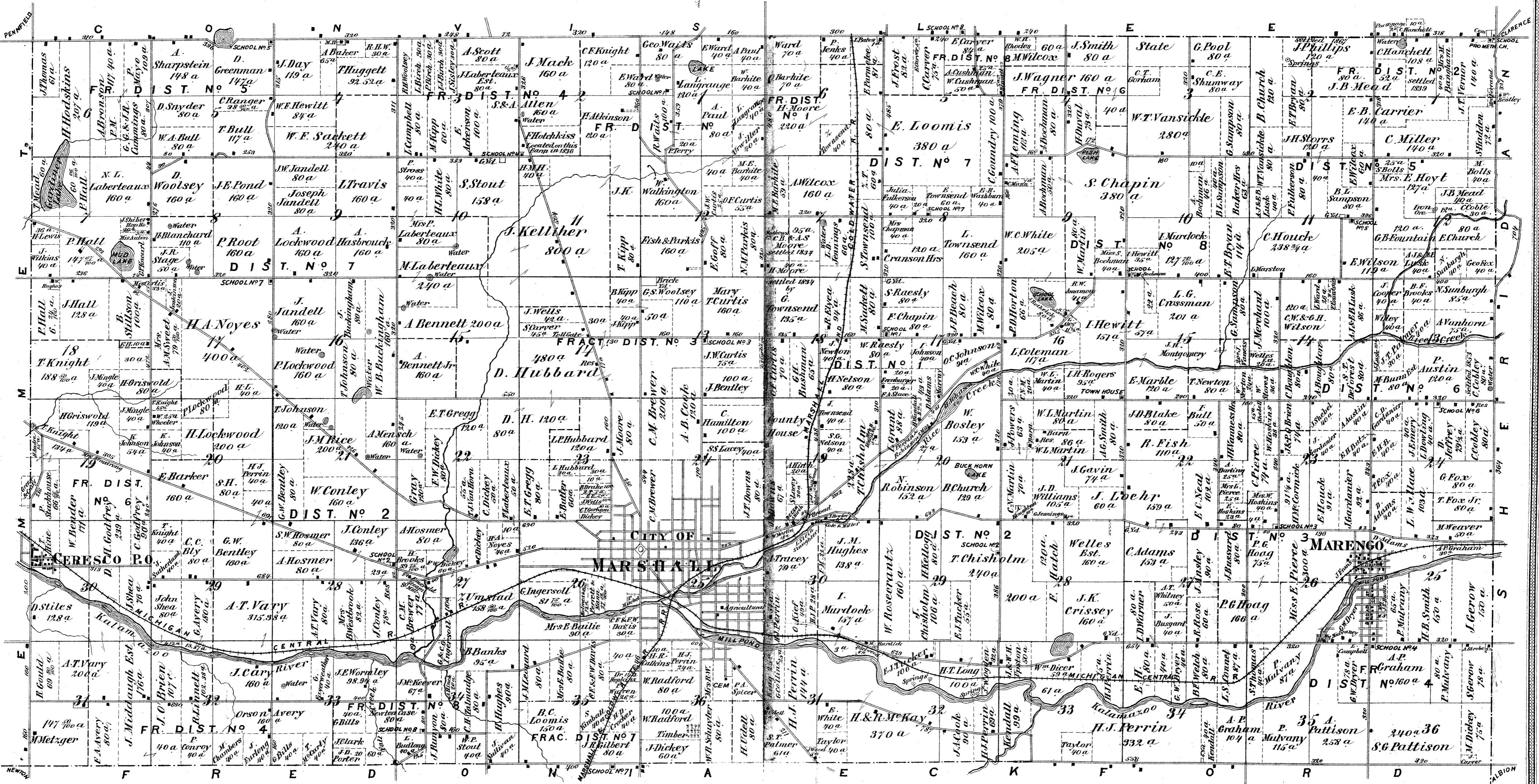


# Township II South MARSHALL Range VI West

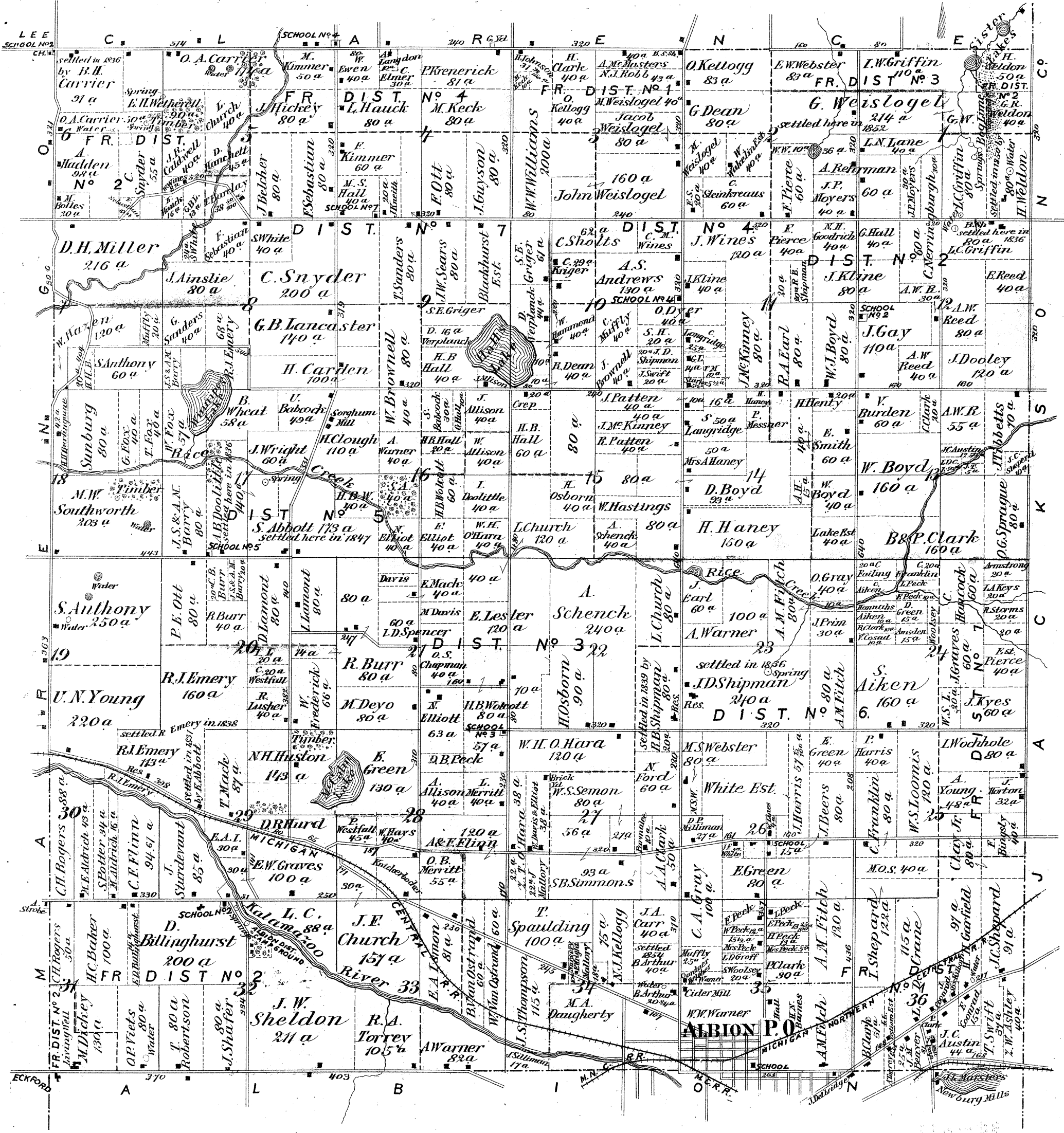

# Township II South SHERIDAN Range IV West

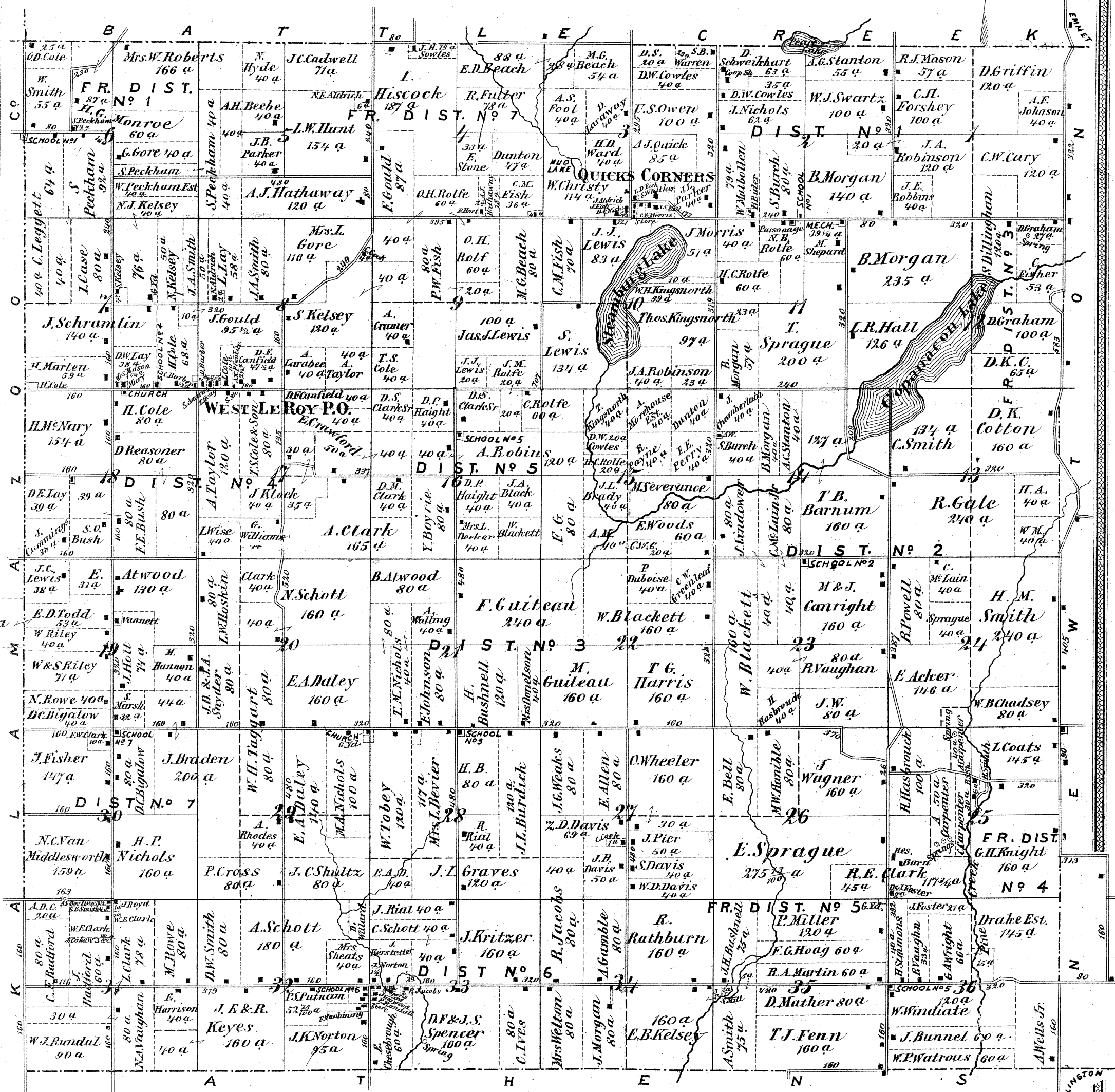

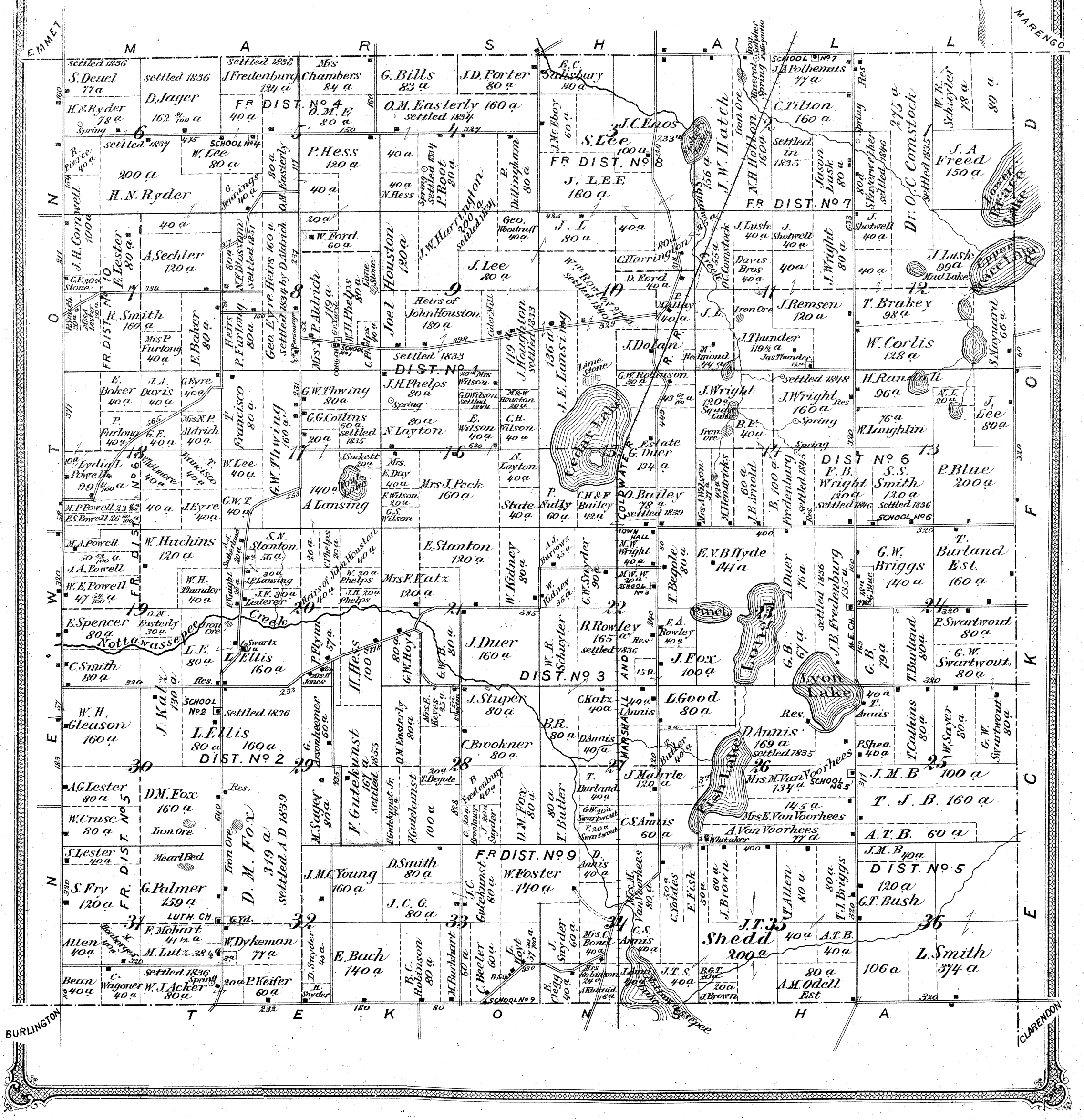
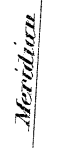






# Township III South FREDONIA Range VI West

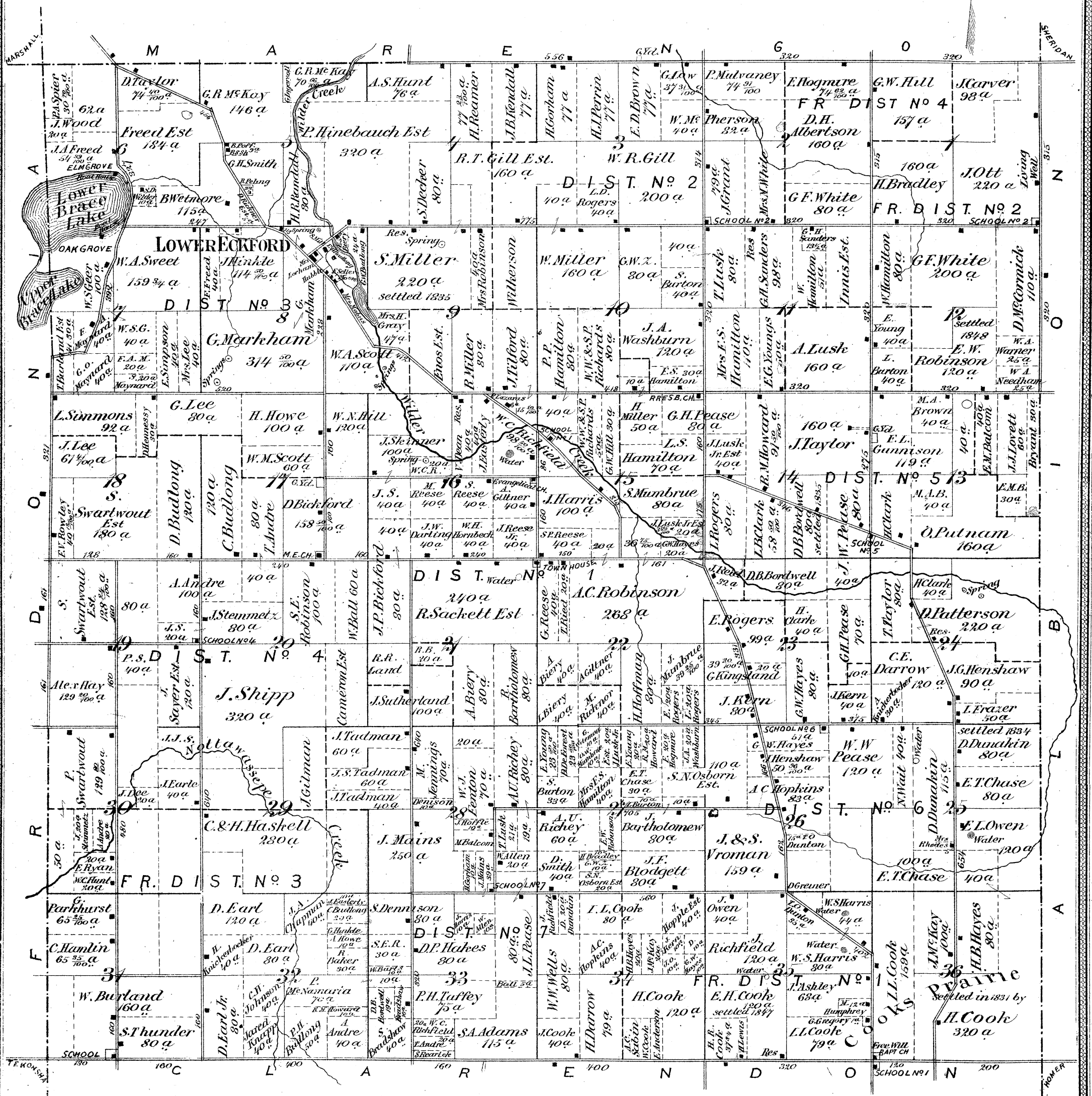

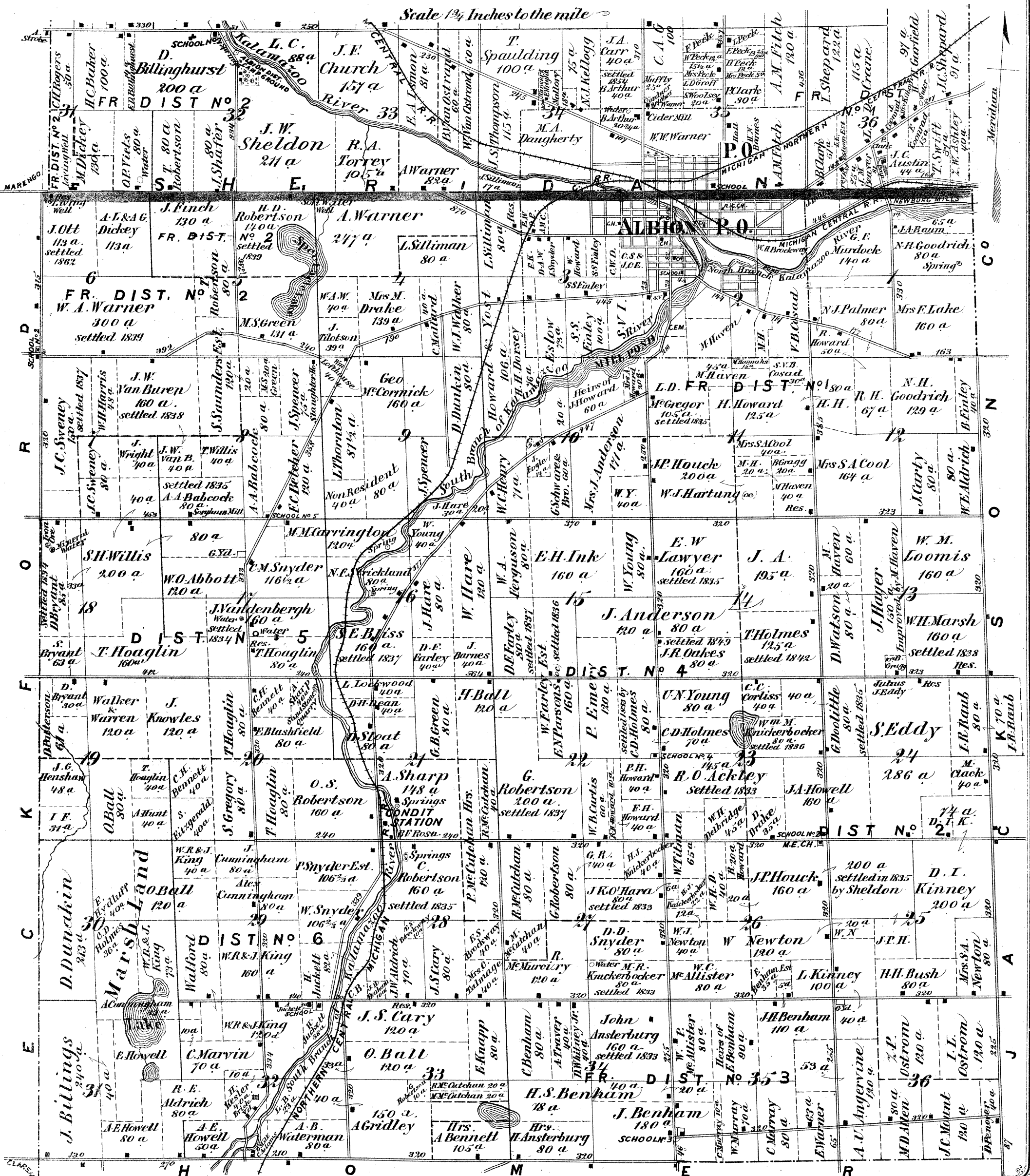

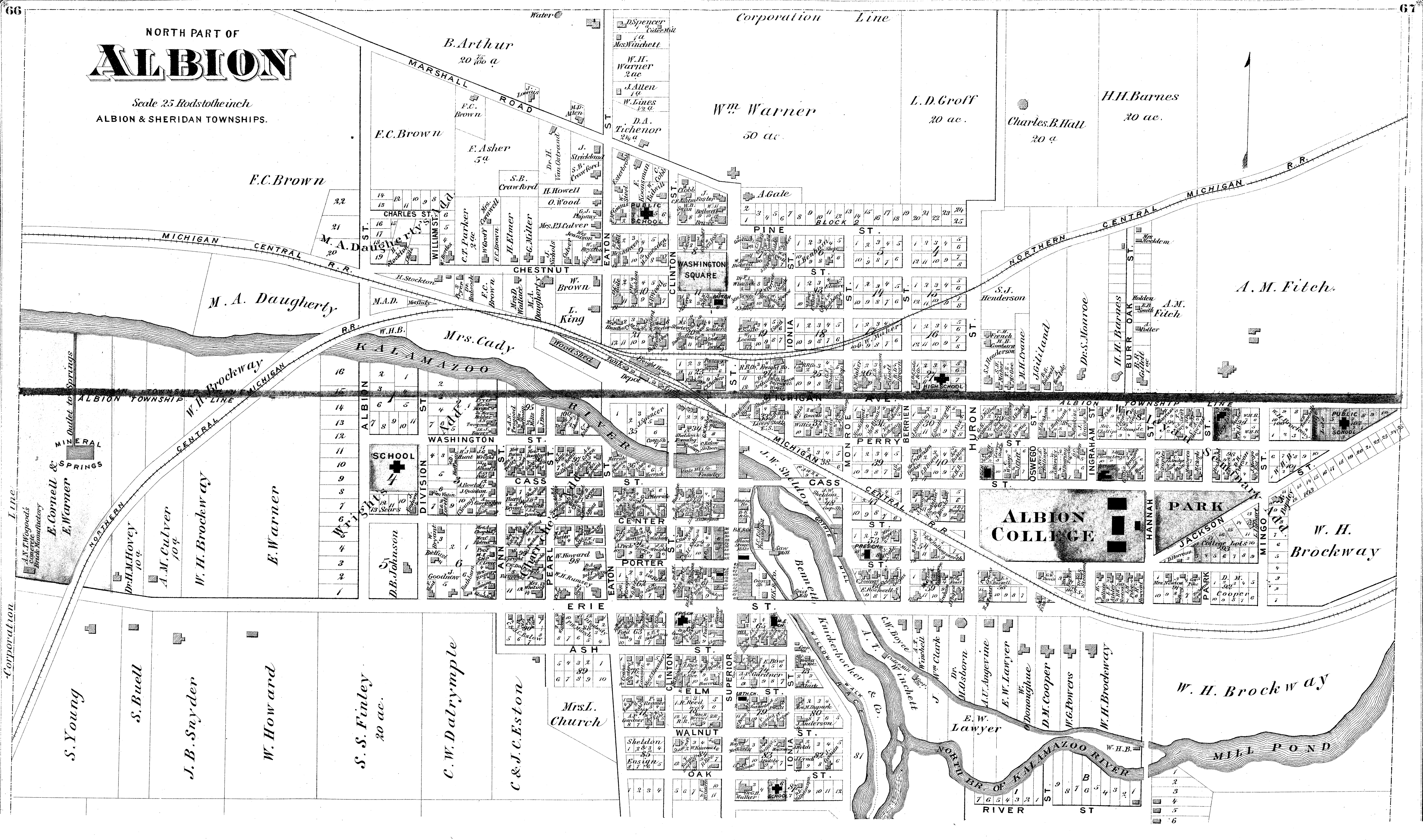






# NORTH PART OF ALBION

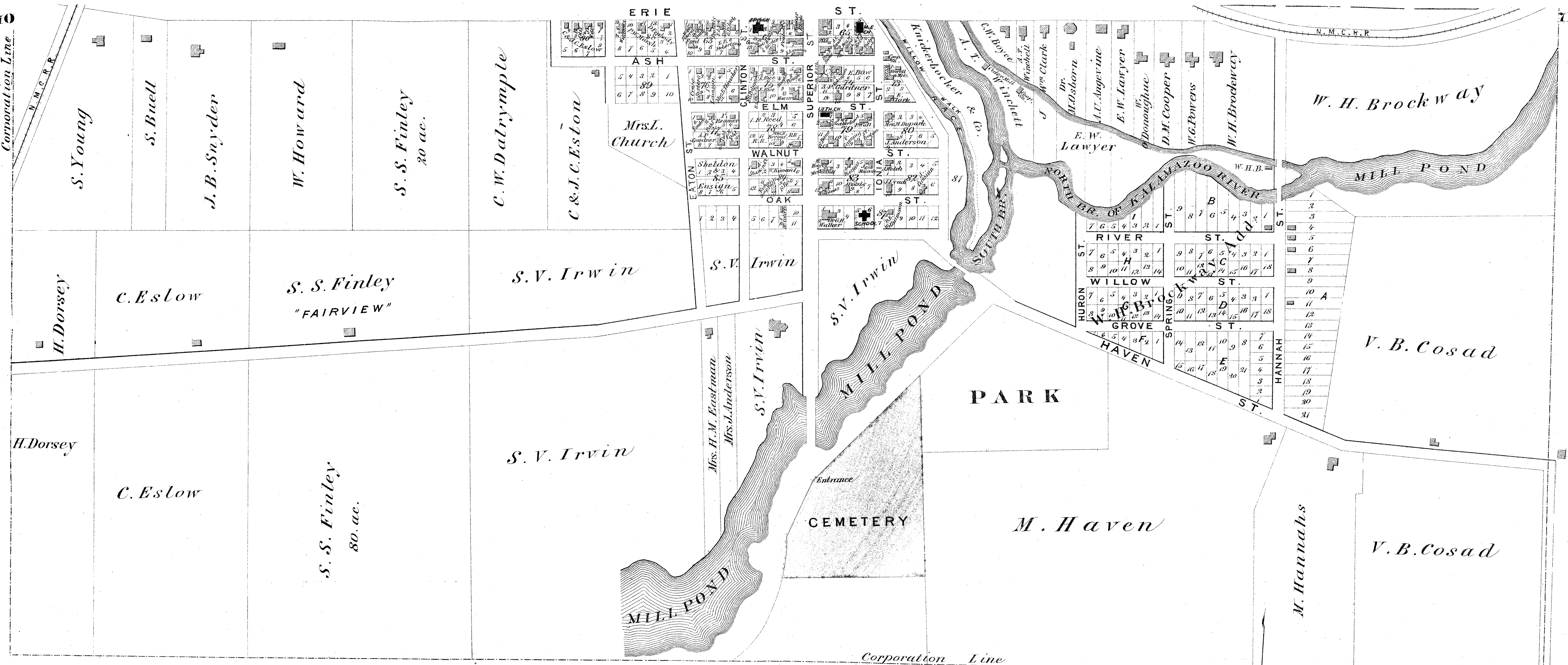

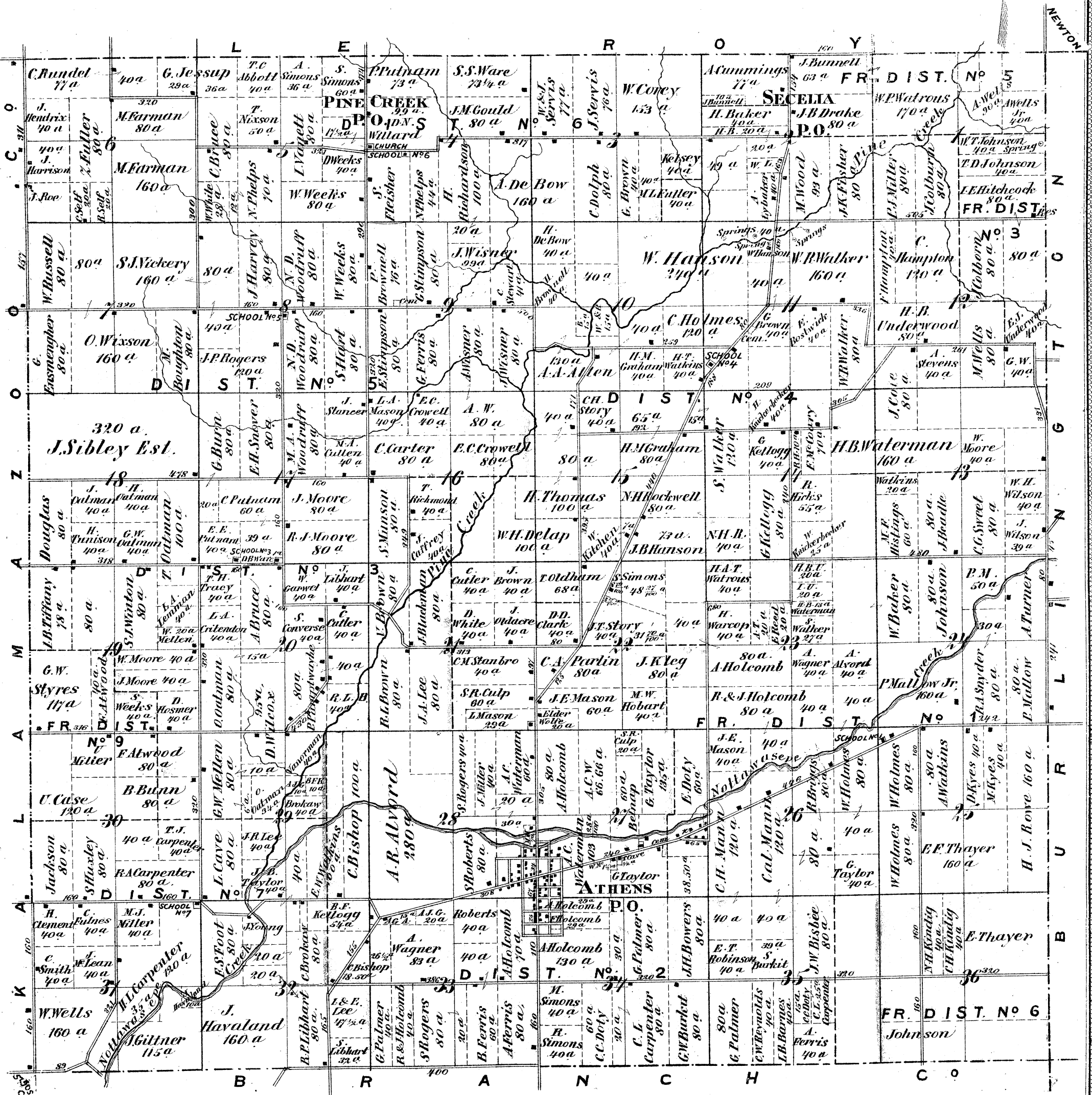
SOUTH PART OF

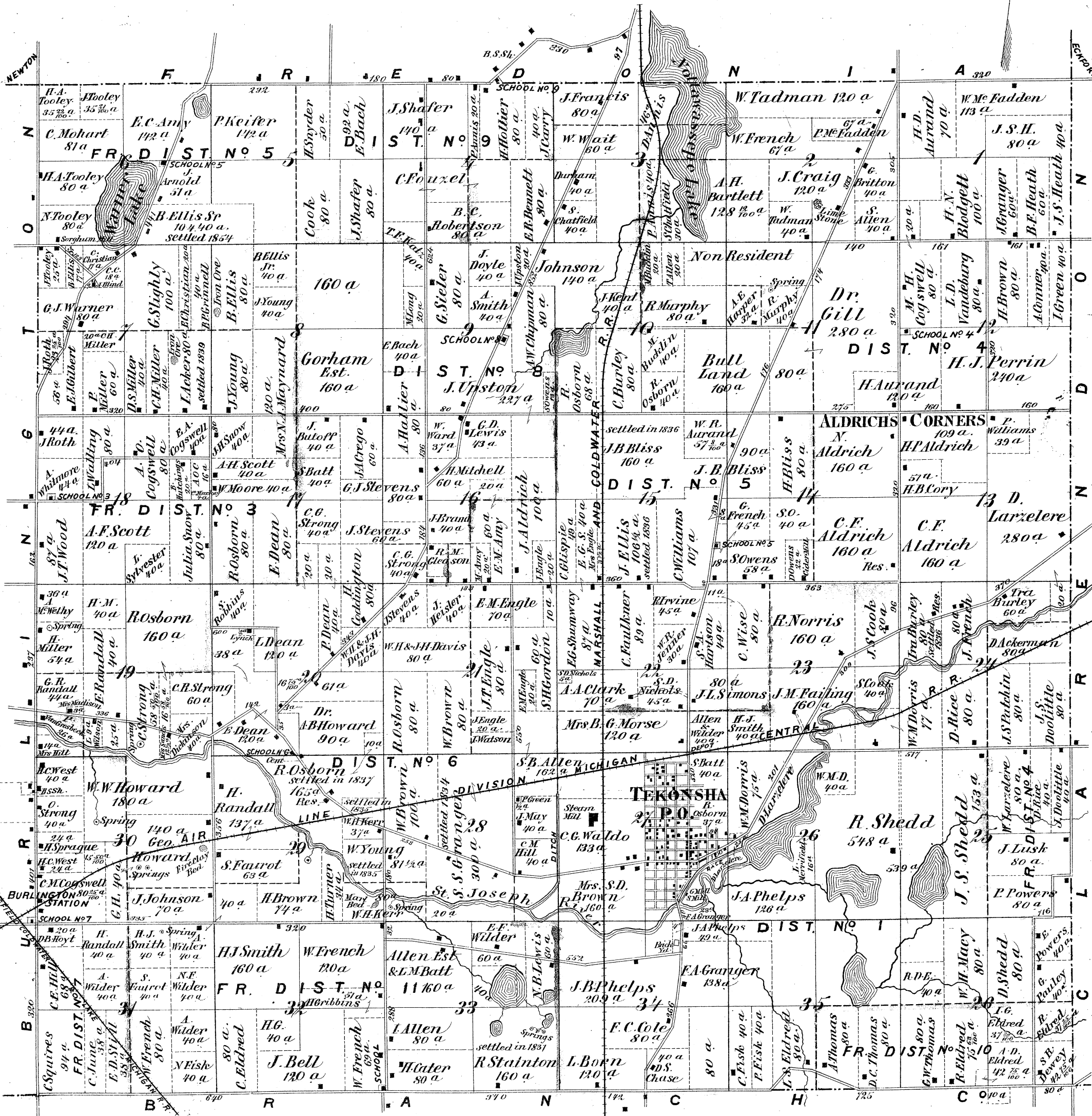

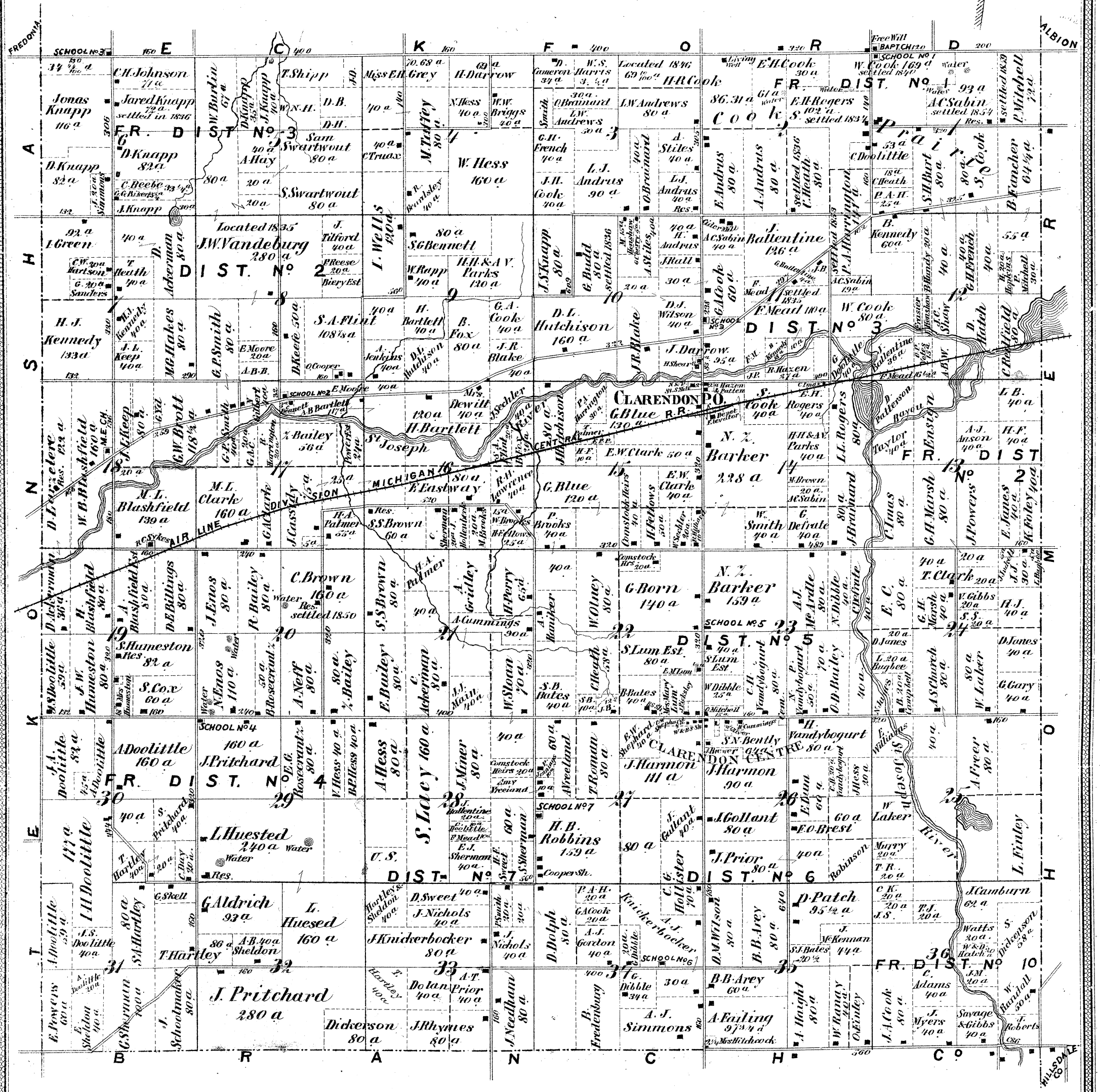






# Township IV South CLARENDON Range V West

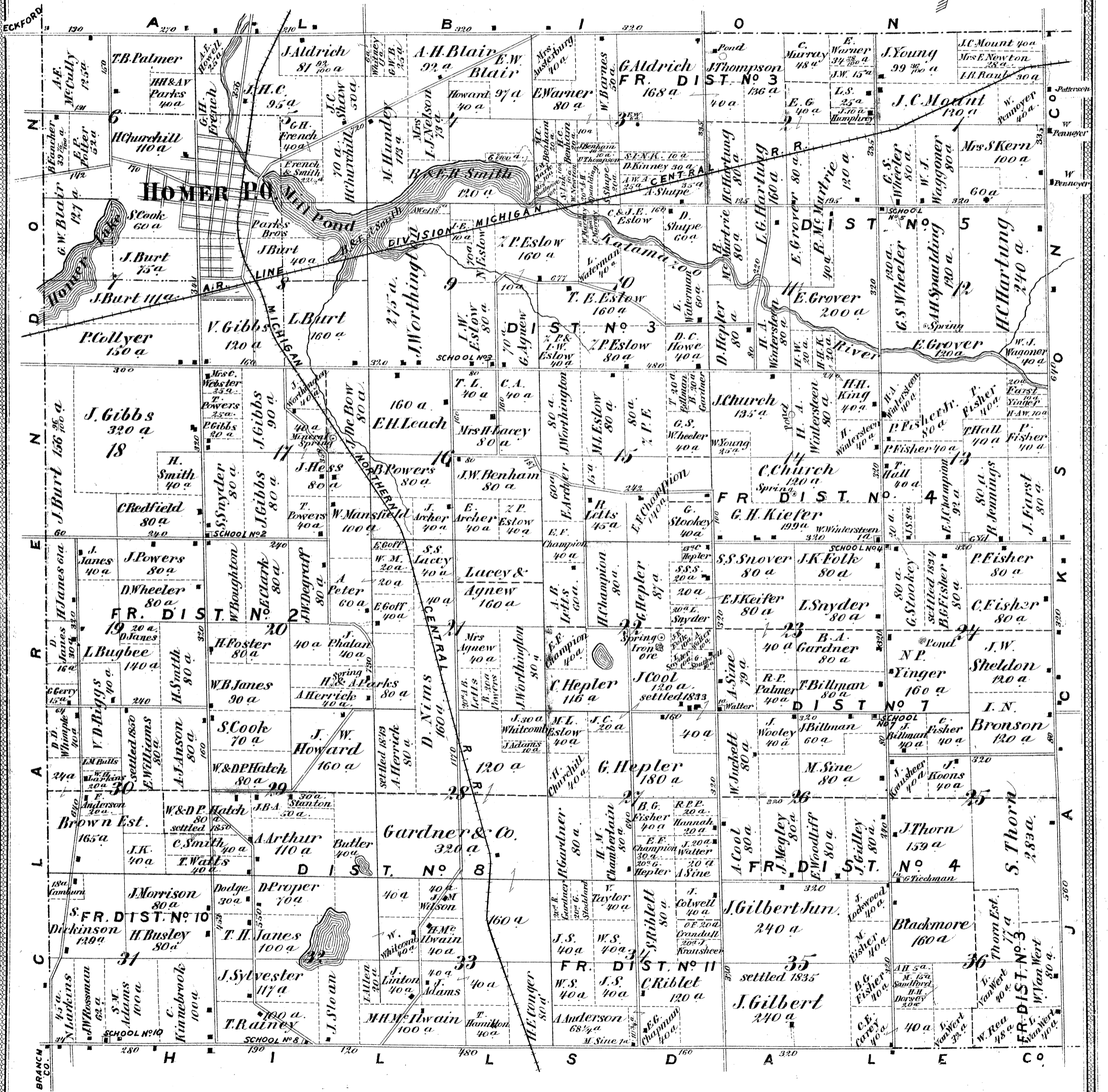

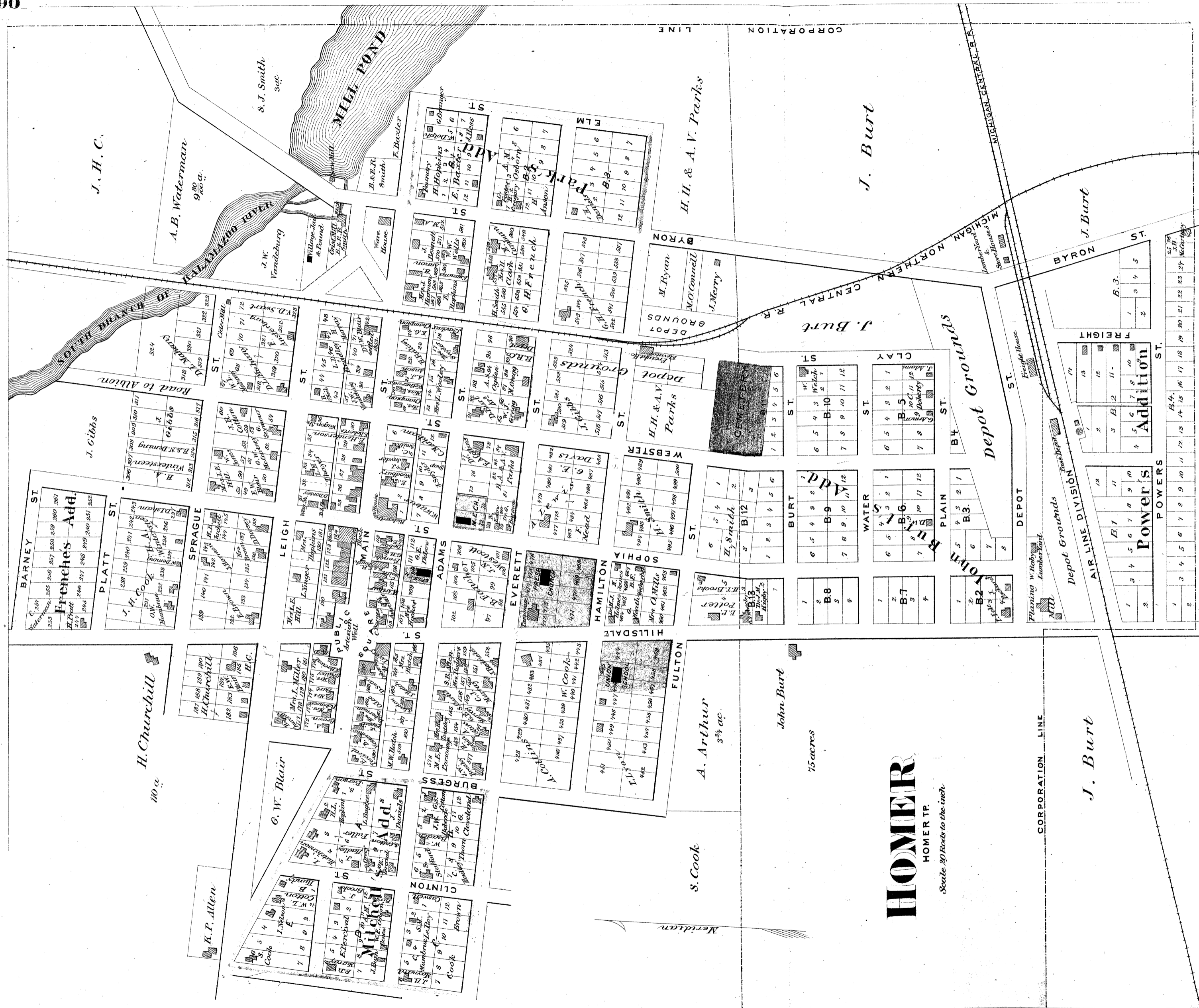
# Township IV South **HOMER** Range IV West
