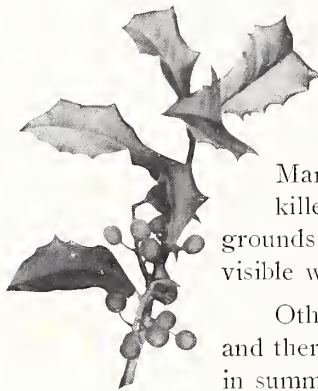

CEDARS

The Cedars we offer are nursery grown and have myriads of small fibrous roots in the ball as a result of the transplanting, root pruning, cultivating, manuring, irrigating. The tops have been sprayed and sheared. If you water and mulch you will have the most handsome Cedars.

The trees larger than 10 ft. do not usually keep their lower foliage. It is a better landscape design and better for the Cedars to plant low shrubs as Bayberry, Barberry and Rhododendrons at the base.

SERVICE AND LAUNDRY YARD SCREENS

You and your guests will not be reminded that the beautiful group is a screen, they might be if you had a single row of one species.

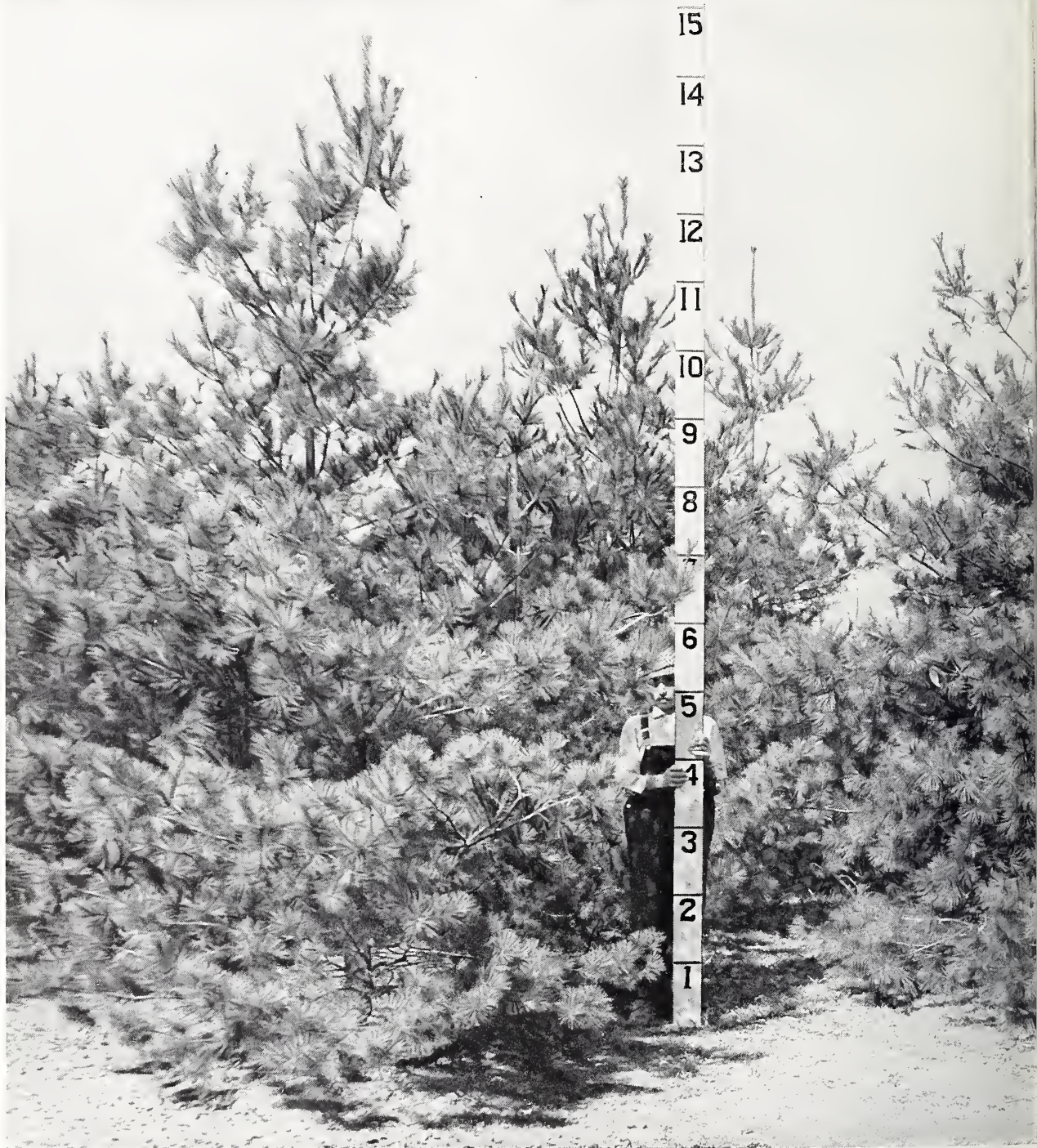
We will photograph or sketch your house and show just what the trees will do.

Spruces are particularly appropriate for evergreen gardens where the beauty of each species is brought out by appropriate surroundings, and the enjoyment consists in close study of the beauties of the individual trees. The outer wall of such gardens, or out-door rooms, can be made of the taller-growing and darker Pines, Firs and Hemlocks. In contrast against them, the various lighter-colored evergreens—Colorado, White and Douglas Spruces, and Concolor Fir can be used. We would be glad to show such gardens in this vicinity to those interested.

MULCHING

Cover the ground where you propose to plant your Christmas tree with 8 inches of manure, straw or leaves, to keep out frost.

MOVING LARGE TREES ALL WINTER

Large Evergreens from 6 to 50 ft. can be moved successfully all winter. We have moved many thousands of such trees and with as great economy as at any other season. A mulch placed on the ground in December will keep out frost and can be used to fertilize and hold moisture for the newly planted trees next summer.

Even when the ground is frozen the additional expense of digging through the frost is too trifling to consider.

The important thing is to get the work done when labor and teams are plentiful, and when your landscape needs the evergreens the most.

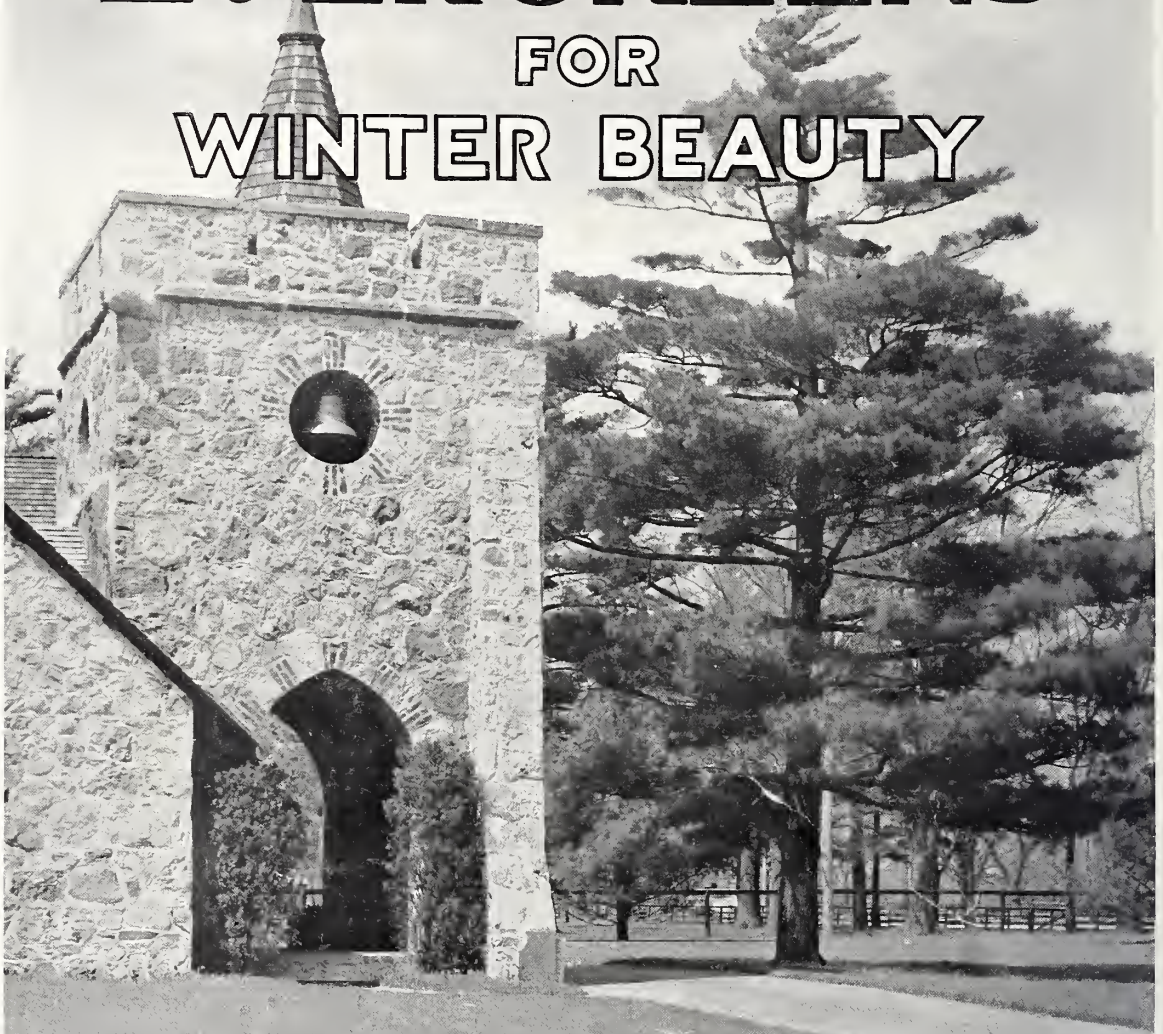
It is lots of fun to make your landscape from pines, cedars, etc., you discover in your vicinity.
