Lubricate points indicated by dotted arrow shaft on both sides of equipment.










Transmission-Torque Converter Oil Filter (Clean screen) (See note 4)

4. TRANSMISSION FILTER SCREEN. Remove and clean filter screen after initial 50 hours of operation, and every 500 hours thereafter.
