HOUSE OF COUNCILLORS Visitors' Regulations

On August 29, 1948, upon consultation with the House Management Committee, the President instituted the Visitors' Regulations as follows:

Visitors' Regulations

The House of Councillors instituted the Visitors' Regulations as stated below and put them in force on August 29, 1947:

Article 1. The visitors shall follow the provisions of this Article as stated below:

1. The visitors shall possess either the admission tickets introduced by the Members, or the admission tickets for the general public issued by the order of their arrivals.

2. The visitors shall enter their names, ages and addresses on their tickets.

2. The visitors, when entering the House, shall be subject to the examination of their bodies by the guards or the police officers and shall obtain approval stamps by the guards on their tickets.

4. When the visitors enter the gallery they shall show their tickets to the guards.

5. When the visitors leave the House they shall return their admission tickets.

Article 2. Children shall not be admitted to the visitors' gallery except on special permission

Article 3. Those who carry firearms or other dangerous weapons, those who are under the influence of alcohol and those who are considered undesirable for the sale of main-

taining order may be forbidden to enter the visitors' gallery.

Article 4. When the number of the visitors is limited or when there is no further room in the visitors' gallery, even the holders of admission tickets may be refused admission into the gallery.

Article 5. The visitors shall under no circumstances enter the floor of the House.

Article 6. The visitors shall observe the following while in the gallery:

1. They shall not wear shabby or strange dresses.

2. They shall not carry or wear hats, overcoats, umbrellas, canes, satchels, wrappers and the like.

3. They shall neither eat nor smoke.

4. They shall not express their approval or disapproval, or clap their hands to the utterances on the floor of the House.

5. They shall not read newspapers, books or the like during the meeting is held.

6. They shall keep quiet and not interfere with the proceedings of the House.

7. They shall do nothing that may annoy the other visitors or shall not behave improperly.

Article 7. When it is decided to have a secret meeting, the visitors shall get out of the gallery immediately following the indication of the guards.

Article 8. The visitors shall not refuse to show their admission tickets to the guards, when

Article 9. The visitors who violate these regulations may be expelled from the gallery.

THE NATIONAL DIET LIBRARY

The Regulation concerning the Personnel of the National Diet Library

Article 1. There shall be in the National Diet Library the following staff:

1. Chief Librarian

2. Chief Assistant Librarian

3. Librarian

4. Senior Specialist

5. Referencer

6. Secretary

7. Clerk

There shall be in the National Diet Library one Chief Librarian and one Chief Assistant Librarian, and the full number of Librarians and other staff shall, with the approval of the Library Management Committee of both Houses, be fixed by the Chief Librarian.

Article 2. There may, as occasion demands, be created in the National Diet Library the

Department, Division and Section, etc. in order that the affairs may be allotted.

The affairs under the charge of each Department, Division and Section, the allotment of duties of respective Department and Division, and the disposition of the staff shall be determinated by the Chief Librarian.

Article 3. There may be in each Department the Assistant Director in addition to the Director of the Department. The Director of the Department or the Assistant-Director shall be appointed by the Chief Librarian from among the Librarians, the Senior Specialists, the Referencers and the Secretaries.

The Director of the Department shall under the direction of the Chief Librarian have the charge of the affairs of the Department. Article 5. There shall be in each Section the Chief of the Section and he shall be appointed by the Chief Librarian from among the Librarians, the Senior Specialists, the Referencers and the Secretaries.

The Chief of the Section shall under the direction of the authorities have the charge of the affairs of the Section.

Article 6. The Librarians and the Secretaries shall under the direction and supervision of the authorities have the charge of the affairs or the technique.

Article 7. The Senior Specialists and the Referencers shall under the direction of the authorities have the charge of the research and the presentation of the data.

Article 8. The Clerk shall under the direction and supervision of the authorities be engaged in the affairs or the technique.

Supplementary Provision:

The present Regulation shall come into force as from the date of the promulgation of the National Diet Library Law.

- 1. (a) The controlled selling prices of producer shall be the controlled prices ex-mill of producer.
 - (b) The controlled selling prices of the Oilstaff Distribution Kodan shall be the controlled prices f. o. r. at stations of government railway or connected private railway nearest to purchaser or ex quay of harbor or river bank nearest to purchaser.

However, if the purchaser takes delivery directly from the Oilstuff Distribution Kodan's storage place, \(\forall 3.00\) per 5-gallon can or \(\forall 33.00\) per 200-liter drum shall be deducted respectively from the controlled selling prices in the present list.

- (c) The controlled selling prices of dealers shall be the controlled prices ex store of the seller.
- 2. (a) The controlled selling prices in the present list shall be the controlled prices only for content.
