Note.—The titles of all periodicals of which no part has been indexed in general indexes are in lower case. All which have been indexed in Poole's Index or (Wilson's) Readers' Guide are in **black face** type; those elsewhere indexed are in "Italics." Where periodicals have various series these are indicated by Roman figures. In indexing it has been the usual, but not invariable, custom to designate volumes by the numbering from the beginning. This in some cases is purely fictitious and such volume numbers are here shown in brackets. **Black face** figures are used to make clearer how volumes are indexed in "Poole" and "Wilson" and their supplements.

Each title has a running number given at right for convenience of reference, and periodicals which are all or in part indexed have a letter following the entry designating where indexed. See opposite page for key to abbreviations.

The + sign means periodical is now current; all titles without this sign are no longer published.

The volume number given in all current titles is that of the last volume fully completed in 1907.

There are also included (printed in ordinary type) many other sets, not in any of the above indexes, but in demand by libraries.

The **check-list** gives dates of first and last issue of each set. This causes in some instances a variation of one year from the dates given in "Poole's Index Conspectus," and on the title page of the first volume of sets.

In entries of current periodicals (marked +) the end volume is the last which is fully completed in 1907, no account being taken of volumes ending in January, 1908, or after.

Following each title is a series of abbreviations showing in which of the various indexes it is indexed.

When sets have several series, the dates, volumes and changes of title of each series are specified. Volume numbers which are in brackets [] do not appear upon the volumes. This will be of great service where "Poole's Index" and "Readers' Guide" use a running number from beginning, as both the series volume and the full volume are indicated, the one indexed being in black type.
