This abstract, showing the open seasons for 1935-36 for the trapping of fur animals, and the provisions of State laws regarding the possession, sale, and shipment of pelts, is prepared and issued primarily as an aid to Federal officials in conducting investigations under, and enforcing the provisions of, the Lacey Act (35 Stat. 1137, as amended June 15,.1935), governing the interstate shipment of wild animals and parts thereof. The information thus compiled is in demand also by members of State game departments, the fur trade, and others.

_ The trapping of fur animals and the possession and sale thereof, or of parts thereof, is controlled entirely by State laws, but the shipment of such animals or their pelts in interstate commerce is subject to the scrutiny of Federal officials charged with the enforcement of the Lacey Act above referred to. Though every effort has been made to have the following summaries substantially correct, the trapping seasons are subject to change by orders or regulations of State game authorities, and it is therefore well for trappers and others concerned to familiarize themselves with the provisions of State laws.

The provisions of the bounty laws of the various States and Provinces will be found in another leaflet in this series (ES--24), Summary of Bounty Laws.

The dates shown below are inclusive of both dates in all cases.

Possession and sale. - No restrictions on prime skins legally taken. Beaver and matten skins imported into the Territory must be presented to the Commission or its authorized agent, with affidavit showing lawful entry, for sealing, within 30 days after entry. Fur dealers must be licensed. Skins of blue fox taken from the wild must be tagged or branded before being sold.

Shipment and export. - No restrictions on skins legally taken, except as above indicated, but no person engaged in fur farming, or in the fur trade as a dealer or agent, shall possess or transport furs without a license. Packages containing furs must be marked to show contents, names and addresses of consignor and consignee. Blue fox skins (other than those raised on farms having a registered brand and branded with such brand) whether acquired in Territory or imported, must be tagged (fee \$1.50) by U.S.Commissioner.

Shipments must be accompanied by statement showing number and kinds of skins contained in shipment, and that no unprime skins are included, such statements to be taken up and mailed to Alaska Game Commission, Juncau, by collectors of customs, postmasters, or by the shipper, as the case may demand.

Possession and sale.--Bear (except white or Kernodei bear) may be sold in Eastern District Sept.1-June 30, and in Western District Sept.17-June 30. Unlawful to sell pelts of fur animals taken in close season, or to possess unprime skins. Possession of pelts permitted during open season and 2 nonths thereafter (3 months north of 52d parallel). Special permit required for possession at other times.

Shipment and export.--Shipment and export allowed only under permit, and royalties must be paid on all furs exported, or shipled to tanner within Province. Packages must be prepared so they may be easily opened for inspection, or labelled with full description of contents, names and addresses of consigner and consignee, and accompanied by export permit. Importation of live animals prohibited except under permit.

Possession and sale.--Possession of unprime skins prohibited. Unlawful to purchase or sell skins of muskrats that have been speared or shot. Person purchasing or acquiring pelts from trapper must have license or permit, and at the same time record his name and permit number. Unlawful to purchase or barter pelts of fur animals in close season (does not apply to imported skins). Unlawful to possess pelts in close season except under permit. No other restrictions on skins lawfully taken.

Shipment and export.--Export of unvrime skins, or skins on which royalty is payable, prohibited unless shipment is accompanied by permit and has attached a declaration of number and kinds of skins contained. Shipment or removal from Province prohibited except by express or mail. No other restrictions on skins legally taken.

NOTE: Trapping prohibited in Pell River, Yellowknife, Arctic . . Islands, and Slave River Preserves, which have been set aside as hunting and trapping grounds for native Indians, Eskimos, and halfbreeds.

Royal Canadian mounted police as game officers may issue permit to trap not more than 15 beavers to males over 18 years of age who, on June 30, 1932, had the status of residents, or to male holder of hunting and trapping licenses during year ending June 30, 1932, but pelts taken must be delivered to game officer for stamping and recording before exportation. No person other than a permittee may possess unstamped beaver pelts. Pelts may be sold under regulation to licensed trader.

Licensed trapper may sell or trade skins he has lawfully taken. Furs legally taken may be exported under pendit if stamped or sealed by permit officer, upon payment of export tax.
