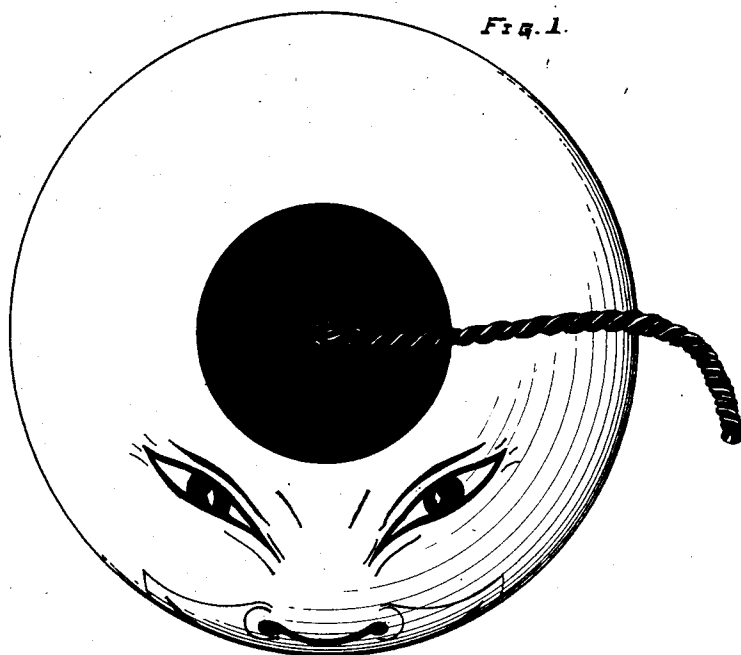
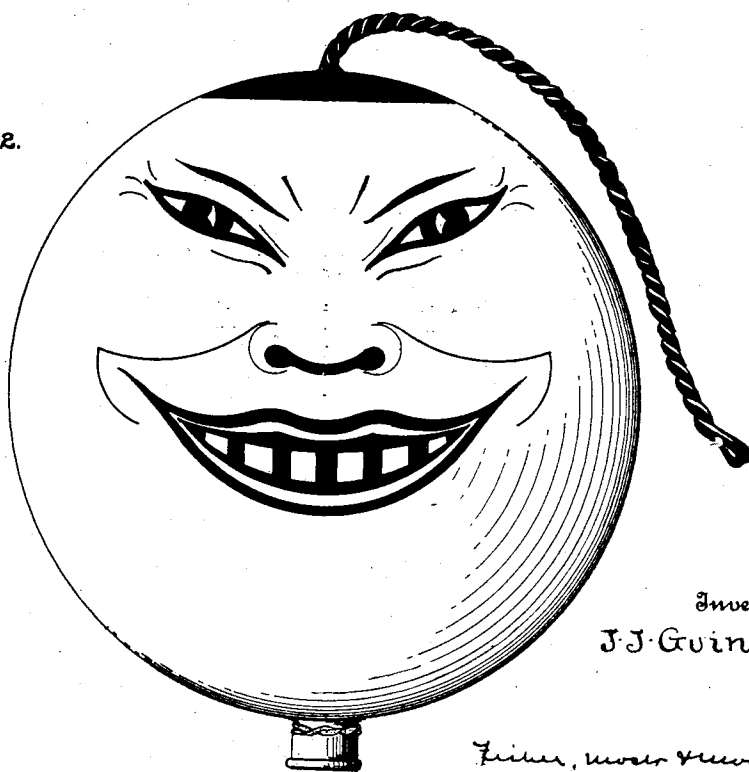

DESIGN FOR A TOY BALLOON.

Application filed March 24, 1922. Serial No. 1,375. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN J. GUNTER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Akron, in the county of Summit and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Balloon, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which—

Fig. 1 is a top plan view and Fig. 2 is a front elevation of an inflated rubber toy balloon, showing my new design.
