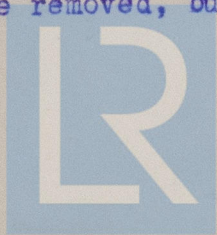
With reference to your assignment letter of the 25th April in the case of the s.s. "KINNAIRD HEAD", we enclose herewith the freeboard verification form, and we beg to inform you that the subject clauses on your letter have been carried out as follows:-

- (1) Lifelines have now been fitted in the well forward.
- (2) The freeing port area in the bulwark on the raised quarter deck has been increased to 17.2 square feet.

There are now four ports, port and starboard 34 1/2" X 18" spaced 15', 33', 47', and 57' from the bridge bulkhead.

Kindly let us have the Convention freeboard certificates by return.

With reference to Leith report No. 18170 on the freeboard of the above vessel, two scuppers which lead from the raised quarter deck overboard below freeboard deck, no valve at shell, were not mentioned on the report, as it has been arranged for them to be removed, but the Owners' Representative/
