SWORN DEPOSITION (Translation)

Deponent: MAKATA, Hidehiko

Having duly sworn an oath as on attached sheet and in accordance with the procedure followed in my country I hereby depose as follows.

I, MAKATA, Hidehiko, reside at No. 423, 2 chome, Nishidamachi, Suginami-ku, Tokyo, and work at present at the Business Sec. Buildings & Equipment Branch, Central Affairs Bureau of the Post-war Liaison Office.

1. From September, 1941 to May, 1945, I served in the Japanese Embassy in Germany in the capacity of a foreign affairs commissioner, and, as chief of Telegraph Section, was charged with the custody of secret documents.

2. Air-raids on Berlin became intensified from about November 1944 so that by the order of my superiors I destroyed from time to time our important documents and telegrams by fire.

When Berlin faced a catastrophe toward the end of April 1945,  
all our secret documents left were also consigned to fire.
