- Korean-specific profit wikiwiki
- It have copyright policy, but not have mandatory or punish clause
- No one obey copyright licence (abuse of Fair use)

Education

South Korea's education system is based on competition and memorization.

- Grades are the main determinant of outcomes.
- Lack of education of distinguish the literacy, how to properly cite the article.
- Lack of flexible thinking It is very difficult to target students in higher education in Korea.
- After school, supplemental education at tutoring centers, problem solving.
- Outcome -> Teachers and students don't recognize and use knowledge base.



Copyrights

"Do Not use my photo! Do not copy my post"

- Weird enemy obsession with nonprofits in Korean community.
- Korean specific image rights, "초상권"(means "Personality sign image rights)
- Fundamental lack of awareness of free and non-free copyright work.
- Prefer to keep their work to themself.
- Hardline stance to free use in Korean Copyrights Act.
- Outcome → very narrow conditions for free use in South Korea



공공누리 (Korea Open Government License)

It is used only in the works of the government of the Republic of Korea, has no international application, and is not well known.

No Freedom of Panorama (FOP) in South Korea

- Article 35 of the Copyright Act of the Republic of Korea allows the reproduction and
 use of "artistic works, architectural works, or photographic works that are displayed at
 all times in streets, parks, buildings, and other places open to the public," but prohibits
 reproduction for the purpose of sale, which limits our use.
- There's been no attempt to repeal.

However,

Due to lack of awareness of this issue, it is perceived as an unofficial provision.

Namuwiki

Korean-specific wikiwiki

- Korean web hits Top 5 web site
- 1,418,059 articles, 3,970,836 files (2024-04)
- It have copyright policy, but not have mandatory or punish clause
- Licence and work information are need in upload file, but neither any confirm process or report abusing fair use
- Namuwiki's policy similar to common Korean awarness of copyright





Wikimedia

- CC-BY-SA 4.0
- Using MediaWiki engine
- Strict copyright / fair use policy
- Restrict in uploading File
- "Hardliner" Wiki to Korean

Namuwiki

- CC-BY-NC-SA 2.0
- Using "Namubase" engine
- loose copyright policy
- No Restrict in uploading File
- "Tabloid" Wiki to Korean



Summary

Some problem to copyright in Korea

- Incorrect awareness of copyright caused lack of education
- Also, non-profit sentiment outcome "works only use non-profit situation"
- Korean copyright act is affected by Korean awareness
- Very rare "free use work" can used in South Korea



Strategy - Wikimedia Korea

- Targeting age groups that have relatively free time or need volunteer hours, such as middle school and college students.
- Activities targeting undergraduate students and professionals in various fields
- Need to cooperate with lawmakers, campaigning the importance of free knowledge and open-source. (and wikimedia movement)
