Economic Stabilization Board Instructions No. 1

January 10, 1948

In accordance with the provisions of Article 15 of the Economic Stabilization Board Ordinance, Instructions for the measures concerning the adjustment and others of the telecommunication facilities shall be stipulated as follows:

Instructions for the Measures concerning the Adjustment and Others of the Telecommunication Facilities

Article 1. In the present Instructions, the telecommunication facilities shall mean the communication facilities and their collaterals to which the Telephone and Telegraph Act or the Radio Act are applicable, and the execution of the works of construction of the telecommunication facilities shall mean the execution of the works of every kind pertaining to the construction, installation and maintenance of the telecommunication facilities, and the telecommunications equipment shall mean those enumerated in Annexed Sheet No. 1.

In the present Instructions, "the Jurisdictional Ministry" shall mean the jurisdictional Ministry of major business of telecommunication operating agencies enumerated in Annexed Sheet No. 2. "The Competent Ministry" shall mean the competent Ministry of communications enumerated in Annexed Sheet No. 2 of the Designated Production Materials Allocation Regulations, and "the Production Jurisdictional Ministry" shall mean the competent Ministry of telecommunications equipment enumerated in the same sheet.

Article 2. In case the jurisdictional Ministry executes its own works of construction of telecommunication facilities or the operating agency of telecommunication facilities under the jurisdiction of the abovementioned Ministry shall execute the same works of construction on behalf of the Ministry, the construction project sheets of its quarter shall be presented to the Economic Stabilization Board for its approval by 70 days, prior to the quarter in which the materials necessary to the constructions are prepared; there is however an exception that when the permission or approval of an administrative Ministry is required in accordance with the laws such as Telephone and Telegraph Act, Radio Act, etc., the project sheets

are needed to go through the administrative Ministry.

Beside the matters prescribed above, the jurisdictional Ministry is also required to submit the yearly project to the Economic Stabilization Board by August 15 of the previous fiscal year.

Article 3. The Economic Stabilization Board, which shall inform to the competent Ministries the construction projects approved in accordance with Paragraph 1, foregoing Article and, on the other hand, inform the required amount according to kinds of equipment of telecommunications planned on the basis of the construction projects to the production jurisdictional Ministry, and shall, at the same time, according to the Procedure Regulations for Allocation of Designated Production Materials, allocate the designated production materials necessary to both telecommunication facilities constructions and production of telecommunications equipment.

Article 4. The competent Ministries shall, according to the notification provided for in the preceding Article and the construction projects for which the designated production materials have been allocated, allocate the designated production materials to each demandant in conformity to the Regulations regarding the Designated Production Materials Allocation Procedure.

The production jurisdictional Ministry shall, with respect to the telecommunications equipment enumerated in Annexed Sheet No. 3, prepare the production plans classified by the kind of equipment and the manufacturer, based on the notification provided for in the preceding Article and the required amount of each kind of the telecommunications equipment for which the designated production materials have been allocated,

and notify the Economic Stabilization Board such plans.

Article 5. The Economic Stabilization Board shall allocate the telecommunications equipment to

each jurisdictional Ministry in conformity to the construction projects approved in accordance with Article 2, Paragraph 1 of the present Instructions, provided, however, that with respect to the telecommunications equipment enumerated in Annexed Sheet No. 3, the allocation mentioned above shall be performed after the reference was made to the Telecommunications Coordinating Committee, in conformity to the production plans of the telecommunications equipment notified in accordance with Paragraph 2 of the preceding Article.

The jurisdictional Ministries shall, on receiving the allotment mentioned above, allocate the telecommunications equipment to each demandant,

in conformity to the construction projects approv-

ed under Article 2, Paragraph 1.

The production jurisdictional Ministry shall allocate the designated production materials for the production of the telecommunications equipment to each demandant in accordance with the Procedure Regulations for Allocation of Designated Production Materials, on applications made by the manufacturers who are given orders for the telecommunications equipment based on the allocation mentioned in preceding paragraph and in conformity to the production plans mentioned in Article 4, Paragraph 2.

- Article 6. The jurisdictional Ministries shall within one month after the present Instructions come into effect, make and submit to the Economic Stabilization Board the inventories of stocks of telecommunications equipment and of the designated production materials for telecommunication facilities in possession of themselves or the telecommunication agencies under their jurisdiction; at the same time, it is necessary that the following records concerning telecommunication facilities shall be prepared and presented to the Economic Stabilization Board in accordance with the forms fixed by the same Board.
 - 1. Line Map

2. Circuit Map

- 3. Document of telecommunication facilities classified by office
- 4. Office Building Map and Diagram of Apparatus Site
- 5. Radio Station Map and Radio Communication Map
- 6. Other miscellaneous documents necessary to coordination of projects.

In case any change in the inventories or/and the documents in the preceding paragraph and made due to ensuing the works of construction or other matters, the documents concerning the part which has been changed shall be forwarded to the Economic Stabilization Board within 3 months starting from the beginning of the next fiscal year.

The jurisdictional Ministries, any time when required by the Economic Stabilization Board, shall submit to the same Board, the records prescribed in each item of Paragraph 1 and the reports concerning other matters.

Article 7. The production jurisdictional Ministry shall, within 2 months after the present Instructions come into effect, make, in accordance with the forms fixed by the Economic Stabilization Board and submit to the same Board both the inventories of stocks of telecommunications equipment and the designated production materials for their manufacturing in possession of the manufacturers under its jurisdiction and documents which clearly show the state of business such as the outline of production capacity and facilities by the kind of article on the day when the present Instructions come into effect.

The inventories and documents mentioned above shall show the state of affairs on the last day of every fiscal year with the exception of prescribed otherwise in the preceding paragraph and shall be forwarded to the Economic Stabili-

zation Board within one month after the beginning of the following fiscal year.

- Article 8. The jurisdictional Ministries shall investigate in each quarter the completion or progress of the works of construction approved according to Article 2 and result of procurement and use of the designated production materials allocated according to Article 4, Paragraph 1 and telecommunications equipment allocated according to Article 5, Paragraph 2 and report to the Economic Stabilization Board in accordance with the forms fixed by the same Board within 2 months after the beginning of the following quarter.
- Article 9. The production jurisdictional Ministry shall investigate in each quarter the results of procurement and consumption of the designated production materials allocated according to Article 5, Paragraph 3 and the state of production and shipment of telecommunications equipment and report to the Economic Stabilization Board in accordance with the forms fixed by the same Board within 2 months after the beginning of the Experiment Experiment
- Article 10. The jurisdictional and production jurisdictional Ministry shall establish the following regulations according to the Law concerning the Temporary Adjustment of Supply and Demand of the Commodities or other ordinances and put them into force:
 - 1. No works of construction of telecommunication facilities shall be executed other than those authorized by the Economic Stabilization Board.
 - 2. Telecommunications equipment shall not be transfered to or from a third person without the allocation certificate or other official documents issued by jurisdictional Ministries.
 - 3, Agencies of telecommunication facilities shall submit to the jurisdictional Ministries the construction project sheets in Article 2 and the report pertaining to Article 6, Paragraph 3 and Article 8.

Supplementary Provisions:

The existing Ministerial Ordinance and other regulations which prove to be in conflict with the present Instructions shall be revised or abolished through formalities by the Ministries concerned.

The present Instructions shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

The Regulations of the Treatment of the Stateowned Precincts Disposition shall be provided as follows:

Regulations of the treatment of the Stateowned Precincts Disposition

Article 1. According to the provisions of the Law
No. 53 of 1947 (hereafter referred to as the Law),
the business of the management and disposition
of the State properties which are leased free of
charge to religious institutions shall be treated by
the Director of the Regional Financial Bureau
according to the provisions of the present regulations, while the business of the management and
disposition which are not referred to the Law
above shall be treated in accordance with the
provisions of the Regulations relating to the
Miscellaneous Property Disposition.

Article 2. On receiving the applications for the grant or sale of the State-owned precincts, the pro-

perties shall, except those of necessities to inquire to be granted by the Minister of Finance in regard of the present regulation be disposed of upon the approval of the Regional Precincts Disposition Committee.

Article 3. In case the applications for the grant or sale of the properties in accordance with the provisions of Article 1, Paragraph 1, or Article 2, Paragraph 1, of the Law, are submitted and fall under the following cases, the inquiry shall be made to the Minister of Finance to be granted:

1. The shrines which were Jingu, national or Government shrines.

2. The head temples and corresponding temples or the churches in the capacity.

3. Shrines or temples which have had the custodian forest held by the religious institutions.

4. The total sum of acreages of the land applied for the grant or sale is in excess of 5,000 tsubo.

- for the grant or sale is in excess of 5,000 tsubo.

 5. The evaluation of the property applied for the grant or sale exceeds the amount of 1,000,000
- 6. Those of special concern or specially appointed.
- Article 4. The following matters shall be stated in the inquiries above necessarily accompaning the application submitted; but in case for the grant, No. 7 is no necessity:
 - 1. The registered matters in the ledger.
 - 2. The name of the party to whom the contract of the grant or sale of the property to be made, and its denomination or religious body.
 - 3. The date that the party incorporated in accordance with the provisions of the Religious Corporation Ordinance.
 - 4. The itemized statements of volume, evaluation, or the expectation price for the sale of the State owned precincts subject to the grant or sale.
 - 5. The reason why the grant or sale of the property concerned is considered to be good.
 - 6. The conditions, if necessary, to be provided in case of the grant or sale of the property concerned.
 - 7. The arrangements and the term made on the payment.
 - 8. In case the grant or sale of the property concerned is considerd to be unreasonable, then that reason, volume of the property, and the possibilities in expectation of disposing the property concerned in the future.
 - 9. And the other reference materials.

On reporting the arrangement of evaluation price for the sale of the property provided in No. 4, above, the detailed list of evaluation of the property subject to the sale, in reference to the examples of the corresponding lands sold and to other materials or upon the recommendations by the experts, shall be accompanied with.

Article 5. When the applications for the negotiation of the credit referred to the provision of Article 4, Paragraph 1 of the Law, are submitted by the religious institutions, or imposing the financial obligations according to Paragraph 2 of same Article on the religious institutions to be borne, the provisions of Article 1, Paragraph 1, and Article 2, Paragraph 1, or Article 5, Paragraph 1, of the Law shall be applied to the disposition concerned.

Article 6. In case the clearing money or the credit of Compensation money, provided in the preceding Article, are to be transferred to the religious institutions, or imposing the clearing money or allotted money on the party, the case, with the statements attestating, shall be applied to the excutors of the readjustment of Arable land in accordance with the Regulations of Arable Land Law, or to the executors of the land planning in accordance with the City Planning Law and the Special City Planning Law (hereafter referred to as the Executors), and such proceedings shall be taken so as to be transferable of the credit or imposing financial obligations on referred above.

But in those cases the clearing money compensation money, or allotted money were already received by the State or paid to the executors, the foregoing formalities are excepted.

- Article 7. In case the applications for an exchange of land or the grant or sale of the State properties having submitted in accordance with the provision of Article 5, Paragraph 1 of the Law, fall under any one of the provisions in Article 3, the inquiries shall be made to the Minister of Finance. The following matters shall be stated in the inquiries above necessarily accompaning the application submitted; but in case for the grant, No. 8 is no necessity:
 - 1. The registered matters in the ledger.
 - 2. The name of the party to whom the contract of the grant or sale of the property to be made and its denomination or religious body.
 - 3. The date that the party incorporated in accordance with the provisions of the Religious Corporations Ordinance.
 - 4. The date officially announced of an exchange of the land.
 - 5. The itemized statements of volume, evaluation or the expectation price for the sale of the State owned precincts subject to the grant or sale.
 - 6. The reason why the grant or sale of the property concerned is considered to be good.
 - 7. The conditions, if necessary to be provided in case of the grant or sale of the property concerned.

 8. The arrangements and the term made on the
 - payment.

 9. In case grant or sale of the property concerned is considered to be unreasonable, then that reason,
 - is considered to be unreasonable, then that reason, volume of the property, and the possibilities in expectation of disposing the property concerned in the future.
 - 10. And the other reference materials.

On reporting the expectation price for the sale of the property provided in No. 5, above, the list of evaluation of the property subject to the sale according to the provision of Article 4, Paragraph 2, shall be accompanied with.

Article 8. When the petitions in accordance with the provision of Article 6 of the Law are instituted, the cases which referred to and settled upon the recommendation by the Regional Precincts Disposition Committee, with the written explanations and the progress of inquiries and judgings of the matter referred to the Precincts Disposition Committee, shall, without delay, be forwarded to the Minister of Finance.

Article 9. When the applications for the grant of the

properties in accordance with the provisions of Article 10 of the Law are submitted to and fall under any one of the provisions under Article 3, the inquiries shall be made to the Minister of Finance, the following matters shall be stated in the inquiries above necessarily accompaning the application submitted:

- 1. The matters registered in the ledger.
- 2. The name of the party to whom the contract of the grant of the property to be made, and its denomination or religious body.
- 3. The date that the party incorporated in accordance with the provisions of the Religious Corporations Ordinance.
- 4. The name of the shrine, temple or church effected a union, and the date notified of the union became effective of the religious institutions.
- 5. The itemized statements of volume and evaluation of the State properties subject to the grant.
- 6. The reason why the grant of the property concerned is considered to be good.
- 7. The conditions, if necessary, to be provided in case of the grant of the property concerned.
- 8. In case the grant of the property concerned is considered to be unreasonable, then that reason, volume of the property, and the possibilities in expectation of disposing the property concerned in the future.
- 9. And the other reference materials.
- Article 10. When the transference of the control of the State properties which are leased free of charge to the religious institutions brought into the considerations the inquiries shall, inspite of the provisions Ministry of Finance Instructions No. 6 of 1928 be made to the Minister of Finance.

The following matters shall be stated in the inquiries above, and the copies of the documents relative to the case shall be accompanied with:

1. The matters registered in the ledger.

- 2. The name of the religious institution to whom the property concerned leased, and its demonination or religious body.
- 3. The volume and evaluation of the properties subject to the transference of the control.
- 4. The reason why the transference of the control of the property concerned is considered to be good or to be unreasonable.
- 5. And the other reference materials.
- Article 11. When the contracts of the grant or sale or incidental conditions are subject to be canceled renewed, or altered respectively, the inquiries, with the reasons and the documents relative to the case accompanied, shall be made to the Minister of Finance.
- Article 12. The Director of the Regional Financial Bureau shall always be furnished with the ledger for annual instalment referred to the Annex Model Form No. 1.
- Article 13. In the following cases the annual instalment due to the payment of the sold properties with regard to the provisions of Article 7 of the Law is authorized, or the right of priority in accordance with the provision of Article 3, Paragraph 2 of the Imperial ordinance No. 190 of 1947 (here after referred to as Imperial Ordinance) is registered, or requested to be given national loan as

- security against the annual instalment, the Director of the Regional Financial Bureau shall, without delay, register the matter in the ledger to put the case in order.
- Article 14. When requested to be given national loan as Security against the annual instalment, the case shall be treated in accordance with the provisions Assumed under Imperial Ordinance No. 287 of 1908 and Article 6 or 8 of the Financial Ordinance No. 8 of 1922.
- Article 15. When, in accordance with the provision of Article 3, Paragraph 2, of Imperial Ordinance, the right of priority is to be registered, the removal registry of the proprietorship shall be entrusted as well as the registration in accordance with the provisions assumed under Article 340 of the Civil
- Article 16. When the application for the grant of the fungibles payment submitted in accordance with the provisions assumed under Article 4 of the Ministry of Finance Ordinance (hereafter referred to as the Ministry or Finance Ordinance) No. 46 of 1947, the inquiries shall be made to the Minister of Finance.

The following matters shall be stated in the application submitted:

- 1. The name of applicant and the denomination or religious body of which the applicant belongs to.
- 2. The location and acreages (tsubo) and the net proceeds of the precincts sold out, and the net proceeds of the disposition being subject to the grant of the fungibles payment.
- 3. The location, kind, volume, and evaluation of the land being subject to the grant of the fungibles payment.
- 4. The reason why the grant of fungibles payment is considered to be good or not reasonable.
- 5. And the other reference materials.

On reporting the evaluation provided in No. 3, above, the evaluation list of the property subject to the fungibles payment according to Article 4, Paragraph 2, shall be accompanied with.

Article 17. When the application in accordance with

the provisions assumed under Article 6 of Ministry of Finance Ordinance is granted, or the notification referred to Article 7 in the same Ordinance is reported, and if the case falls under the provisions of Article 3 or 7 requiring to make the inquiries, the grant of that application or the matters of that notification shall, without delay, be reported to the Head of the State Property Bureau.

- Article 18. The records of the State properties which are leased free of charge to religious institutions, and the properties of which the application for the grant or the transfer of the credit or the sale, in accordance with the Law, is made and the development of disposition of the properties concerned shall, with reference to the annex model form No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4, be reported every month to the Head of the State Property Bureau before 15th of the next month.
- Article 19. If the records of the total of the State owned precincts, of which the grant or the sale put under contract, and the acreages of the estate, which were the forests in the custody of religious institutions and are put under the contract of the grant to the same religious institutions, in accordance with the provisions of the Law, exceeds that of 1 chobu, then that records, with reference to the Annex Model Form No. 5, shall be reported every month to the Head of the State Property Bureau before 15th of the next month.
- Article 20. The provisions assumed under Article 2, Article 3, Article 26, Article 27, Article 37, from No. 2, to No. 5, Article 39, and Article 40, of the Regulations of the Treatment of Miscellaneous Property shall, in accordance with the Law, be applied to the cases of the management and disposition of the State properties which are leased free of charge to religious institutions.

Supplementary Provisions:

The present Instructions shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.

Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 1 (The Regulations of the Treatment of the State-owned precincts) shall hereby be abolished.

3. In the colum of Location, the name of Shi, Ku, Cho, or Son shall be stated; nevertheless, in case the location of the State property of which the grant or Sale are Contracted extends over more than two provinces, and then those of dotted estates belonging to shall be inserted; but as for the cases of the dottdd precincts, they are to be stated in the specially made column and the locations of that properties are included within the parentheses."

4. Of the kinds of the properties, the general classification shall be made between the State owned precincts and the forestries in custody, and under these classifications, the land, the standing trees and bamboos, and the other fixed structures, are to be sub classified in this statement.

5. When there are more than two same kind of the State-owned properties of which the grant or sale contracted to a religious institution, the figure of total shall be accounted reforred to cach ease of the religious institution.

6. Of the prices of the State properties which are put under the contraction, the price for the granted shall be that of estimated while the price of sale shall be that of disposing price a half of the current

7. Of the payment of the sale granted of annual payment, that reason and the term of the annual payment granted shall be stated in the remarks.

8. The total shall be classified into the grant and sale, and the numbers of religious institutions and the number and price of each kind of the property shall be stated.

In case of those for which higher rates of interest are adopted as compared with the rates of interest of bank deposits or savings and yields of instalment time deposit, the maximum rates will be determined by adding the annual interest of 1% or the interest of 1 rin per diem to the rates of interest mentioned in the preceding paragraph.

(2) The above rates of interest are not applicable to loans which already exceeded the abovementioned maximum limit before the rates of interest are

actually put into practice.

5. The maximum rates of interest on loans and the maximum discount rates, applicable to trust companies (designated monetary trust funds) and insurance companies (excluding loans to insured persons in accordance with insurance rules) shall be for the time being, fixed by adding 2 rin to the maximum limit of corresponding rates of bank interest, But the above mentioned institutions are expected to keep pace with the maximum rates of bank interest as much as possible.

6. The maximum rate of interest on call loans (day to day accommodation) is 9 rin per diem.

7. The maximum limit of brokerage of call loans (day to day accommodation) is 1 rin per diem.

In accordance with Art. 8 of the Petroleum Products Distribution Regulations, the General Plan for the Allocation of Petroleum Products to Shipping and Harbor Use shall be established as follows:

General Plan for the Allocation of Petroleum Products to Shipping and Harbor Use

- Article 1. Allocation of petroleum products for shipping and harbor use is made by Minister of Transportation for the undermentioned, based on the fundamental policy determined by President of the Economic Stabilization Board.
 - (A) Steel ships and motor sailing ships engaged in cargo transportation directed by the General Maritime Bureau. (Both including tankers; the same applying correspondingly to the following)
 - (B) Steel ships and motor sailing ships engaged in cargo transportation directed by the Local Maritime Bureau.
 - (C) Tugboats engaged in business designated by the Local Maritime Bureau.
 - (D) Ferry boats engaged in passenger transportation directed by the General Maritime Bureau or the Local Maritime Bureau.
 - (E) Small crafts for agricultutal purposes.
 - (F) Ships employed for salvage.
 - (G) Ships engaged in dismantling of ex-naval ships.
 - (H) Vessels employed for executing business of Government or public organization.
 - (I) Other ships, to which the Director-General of the General Maritime Bureau or Chief of the Local Maritime Bureau particularly deems it necessary to allocate the petroleum products.
 - (J) In addition to the vessels mentioned in the preceding items, machineries and apparatus employed in connection with the maritime transportation except automobiles and trucks.
- Article 2. One who desires to obtain distribution of petroleum products for the vessels mentioned in

the preceding Article excluding steel ships under operation of the Civilian Merchant Marine Committee (C.M.M.C.) shall submit to the Local Maritime Bureau, within which jurisdiction are located its principal business headquarters, the detailed report regarding the ship's name, port of registry, name and address of the shipowner and captain, gross tonnage, cargo capacity, horse-power, speed, basic oil consumption, etc.; he shall so register with the Local Maritime Bureau and obtain the oil supply book for each ship.

In case that a charter or one who has been commis:ioned to operate vessels desires to make registration, in the preceding paragraph, he shall register jointly with the shipowner.

- Article 3. One who is engaged in other enterprises than mentioned in Article 1, shall not make registration in the name of one who is engaged in the approved enterprises mentioned in Article 1.
- Article 4. Petroleum products shall not be supplied to one who has not made registration.
- Article 5. Each Local Maritime Bureau shall keep "Fuel Registration Book," stating name of vessel, port of registry names and addresses of the shipowner and captain, gross tonnage, cargo capacity, horse power, speed and basic oil consumption, thereby preventing and controlling any abuses of petroleum products.
- Article 6. The oil supply book shall be furnished to all Local Maritime Bureaux by the Ministry of Transportation and shall not be reproduced by or manufactured through any other source.
- Article 7. The matters enumerated in the Article 2 and the ships registered number shall be entered in the oil supply book in accordance with the applicant's report. In case of the report being insufficient to be approved, the Local Maritime Bureau shall check up the matters at the spot and make entry in the book.
- Article 8. The oil supply book shall be inspected and sealed every three months by the Local Maritime Bureau. The book which has no forgoing seal without any rightful reason shall become null and void henceforth.
- Article 9. The oil supply book shall be kept on board the ship while she is sailing. It shall not be transferred or loaned.
- Articie 10. The Local Maritime Bureau makes a transportation plan within the scope of the general allocating program of fuel oil, decided by the General Maritime Bureau and works out an oil allocation program after checking up the oil requirements in accordance with the application of each shipowner.
- Article 11. In making the application mentioned in the preceding article, each shipowner shall show the oil supply book and make report in detail regarding the area and distance of navigation, description and tonnage of cargo, the quantity of fuel oil remaining in the last voyage, and requirement for the forthcoming voyage, etc.
- Article 12. The Local Maritime Bureau examines the application mentioned in Article 10 and in case of being satisfactory, issues and delivers a petroleum purchase certificate and enters the quantity of fuel

oil to be supplied, the designated trade route and cargo, etc. in the oil supply book, and stamps the seal.

For the items of C to H both inclusive and J of Article 1 and those which the Local Maritime Bureau deems necessary, petroleum certificate may be delivered for the allocation of one month.

Out of those mentioned in the Article One, one who operates many registered vessels must obtain a petroleum purchase certificate for each vessels.

The petroleum purchase certificate shall be furnished to all Local Maritime Bureaux by the Ministry of Transportation and shall not be reproduced by or manufactured through any other sources:

- Article 13. When the Local Maritime Bureau has made registration and allocation, it shall submit a report on the number of registration and allocated quantity to the Minister of Transportation. In the event the decision or action of the Local Maritime Bureau is deemed improper, the Minister of Transportation may make it correct.
- Article 14. Any person or consumer who has applied for allocation of petroleum products and is dissatisfied with the action taken, or who has a grievance or protest may make an appeal to the local or district office of the Economic Stabilization Board. If the action taken on this appeal is not satisfactory, a further appeal may be made to the President of the Economic Stabilization Board.
- Article 15. Petroleum products for shipping use can not be purchased from the dealer, unless the oil supply book and purchase certificate are shown and the certificate is delivered to him in exchange for the fuel oil.

When the dealer makes sale in accordance with the preceding paragraph, he shall enter the quantity in the oil supply book and stamp his seal. At the same time, he shall set the certificate stamped with the captain's seal.

Article 16. Distributed petroleum products shall be used by the consumer with every device and expedient so as to increase the efficiency to a maximum.

The Local Maritime Bureau shall conduct an adequate guidance of and supervision upon users, through capable experts in order to augment efficiency of petroleum products.

The Minister of Transportation shall convene the officials of the Local Maritime Bureau in order to attain the aims mentioned in the preceding paragraph.

Article 17. The Local Maritime Bureau carrying out

supervision in order to give guidance concerning the preceding Article and also exercise control regarding the following points:

- 1. Whether or not the ship is sailing without the oil supply book or with other ship's book.
- 2. Whether or not the ship is engaged in the trade other than mentioned in the oil supply book. Whether or not the ship is carrying undesignated commodities.
- 3. Whether or not the ship is using the petroleum products which have not been supplied through right channel.
- 4. Whether or not the petroleum products are being wasted.
- Article 18. With regard to the steel ships under operation of the Civilian Merchant Marine Committee (C.M.M.C.), the General Maritime Bureau particularly determines the allocation of fuel oil and issues and delivers the certificate directly to it. However, concerning other respects, the regulations prescribed in the preceding Articles shall be applied mutatis mutandis.
- Article 19. All the regulations in this procedure except those exclusively concerning the ship's navigation shall be applied mutatis mutandis to the machineries and apparatuses, employed in connection with the maritime transportation. However, concerning the issue of the oil supply book prescribed in Article 2, one book may be issued to cover more than two machineries and apparatuses which are located at the same port and operated by the same administrator.
- Article 20. One who violates the regulations prescribed in this procedure shall have the registry repealed, oil supply suspended an remaining petroleum products confiscated.

The violator shall, be prosecuted and punished, as the case may be.

Article 21. The allocation business of the petroleum products of the Local Maritime Bureau, prescribed in this regulation will be conducted by the Transportation Section of Maritime Transport Dept. of the Local Maritime Bureau or the Branch Office thereof.
