3 SEC. 3. PROPOSAL RELATED TO SHARED SERVICES.

- 4 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
- 5 ment of this Act, the Federal Chief Information Officer
- 6 shall submit to Congress a proposal for consolidating in-
- 7 formation technology across the Federal Government, es-
- 8 pecially among Federal agencies not referred to under sec-
- 9 tion 901(b) of title 31, United States Code, and increasing
- 10 the use of shared services, including any recommendations
- 11 for legislative changes that may be necessary to effect the
- 12 proposal.

13 SEC. 4. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.

- No additional funds are authorized to be appro-
- 15 priated to carry out this Act and the amendments made
- 16 by this Act. This Act and the amendments made by this
- 17 Act shall be carried out using amounts otherwise author-
- 18 ized.
