# PART II NARRATIVE SUMMARY

Liasion was made with Headquarters Company, 7th Marines on 1 September 1970. Through this liasion, coordination and prior planning the movement of Headquarters Company, 5th Marines was made with little loss to the effectiveness of administration and mission of the Company. Movement began on 17 September 1970 of supplies and equipment and the Administrative Sections moved on the 19th and 21st of September 1970. The relocation and turnover of the area was completed on 21 September. Headquarters Company, 7th Marines was relieved and relocated.
