

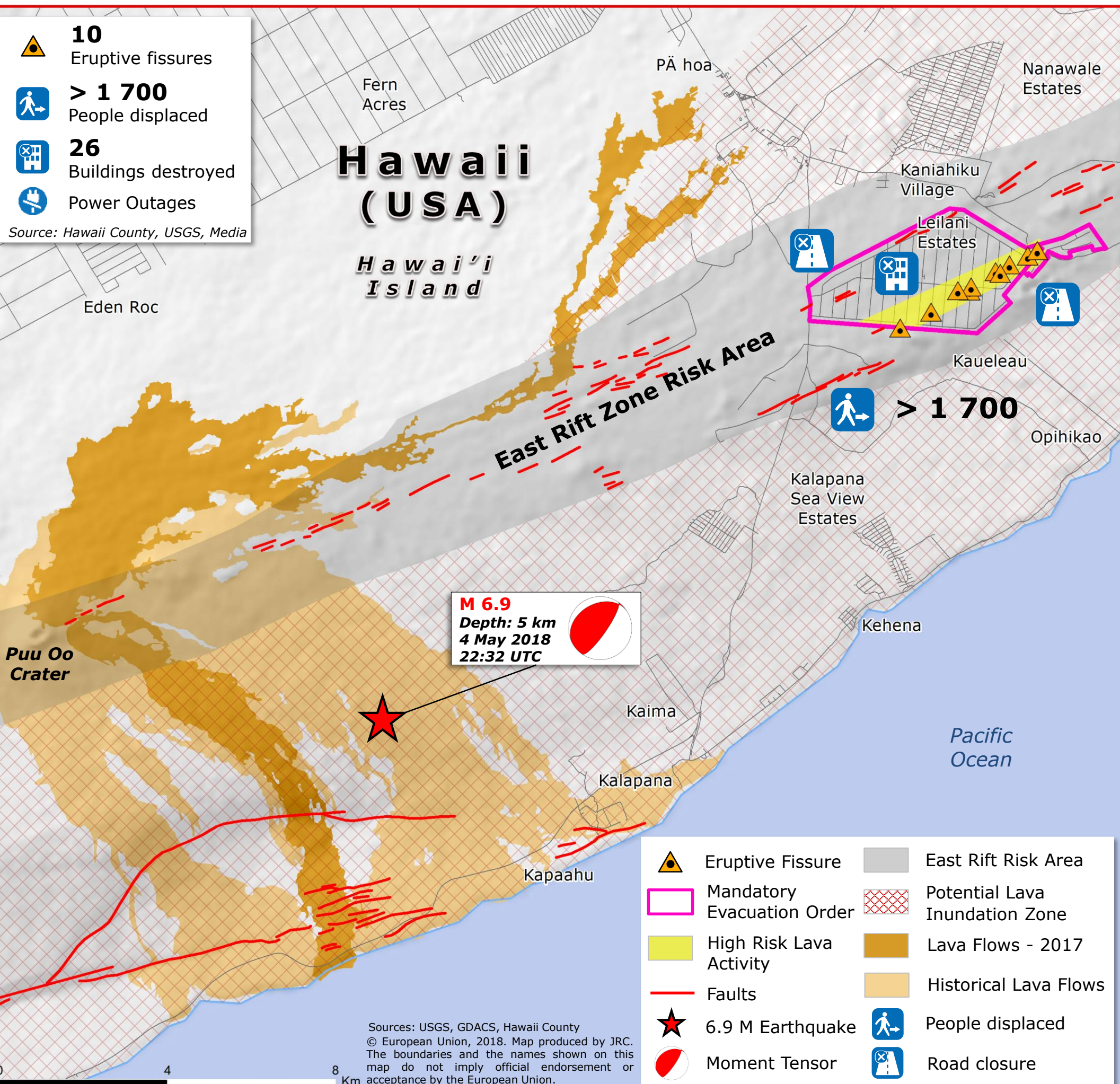

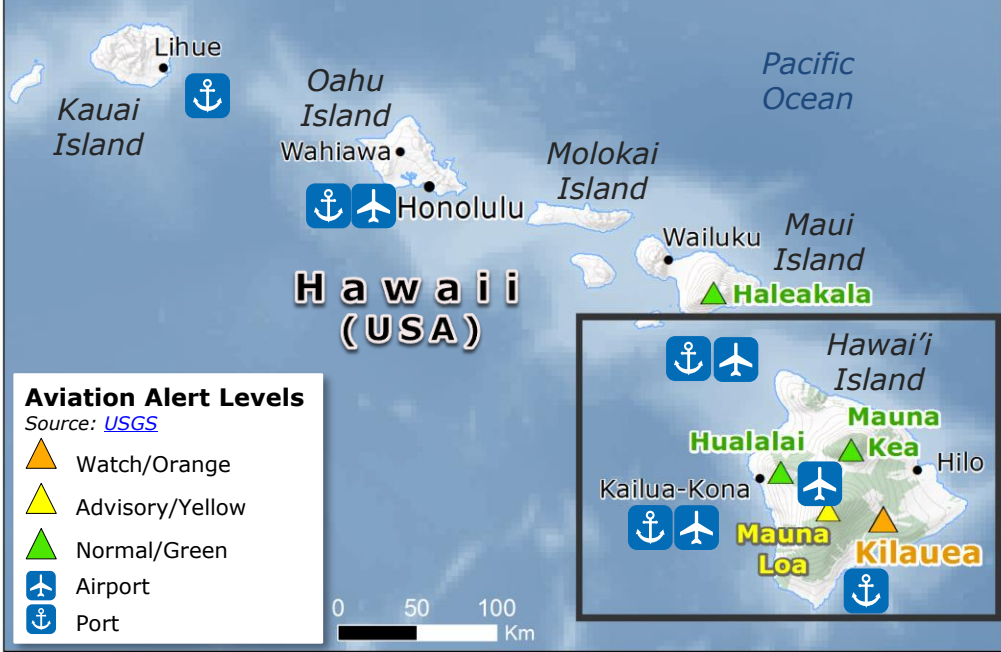

SITUATION OVERVIEW

- **Kilauea Volcano**, situated in Hawaii, has started erupting on 3 May 2018 in the **Leilani Estates**, a subdivision in the **lower East Rift Zone** of Kilauea Volcano, spewing lava and gas.
 - The eruption was associated with an **intense seismic activity**, including a **Mw 6.9 earthquake** on 4 May 2018 at a depth of 5 km.
