CITY ORDINANCES

Of the City of Grand Rapids—1888.

[**CONDENSED.**]

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AUCTIONEERS—Page 6.

SEC. 5. Goods received for sale by auctioneers from minors or apprentices, or using deception, fraud, or deliver inferior quality; penalty, not less than \$5 nor more than \$50, and cost of prosecution.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BREACHES OF THE PEACE—Page 12.

SEC. 1. All persons willfully assaulting another, or be engaged, aid, or abet, in any fight, quarrel, or other disturbance, shall be *deemed a breach of the peace.*

SEC. 2. No person shall permit indecent, loud, boisterous noise, fighting, quarreling or disturbance, about their residence, saloon, shop, office, or place of business, nor permit persons to congregate therein to the annoyance or disturbance of others, or permit drunkards, persons intoxicated, tipplers, gamblers, prostitutes or other disorderly persons, to assemble, visit or remain therein.

SEC. 3. Penalty, not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50, or by imprisonment.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PRESERVATION OF THE PEACE—Page 24.

SEC. 1. Persons shall not collect, stand in crowds, loiter about, or obstruct free passageway, sidewalks, halls, stairways, vestibules, leading to any store, office, court room, common council chamber, churches or public halls.

SEC. 2. Persons not to collect or stand in crowds on the sidewalks, steps, doorways, lobby or waiting room of the United States postoffice (except on business).

SEC. 3. Persons not to collect or stand in crowds in front of any church, or other place of worship, during services or the gathering or departing of congregations.

SEC. 4. Persons shall not make any indecent exposure of his or her person in the streets, lanes, alleys or elsewhere in the city.

SEC. 5. Persons shall not show, sell, offer for sale or exhibit indecent or obscene pictures, drawings, engravings, books or pamphlets. Penalty, not less than \$2 nor more than \$25, and cost of prosecution.

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO BATHING—Page 17.

SEC. 2. Not to bathe in Grand River or other body of water in a nude state, except in places designated by the common council. Penalty, not less than \$10 nor more than \$100, or by imprisonment not exceeding 60 days.

*AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO HOUSES OF ILL-FAME—
Page 19.*

SEC. 1. Occupants or owners not to lease buildings or parts thereof to be used as a house or place of ill-fame.

SEC. 2. Persons not to maintain, keep, aid, or abet in maintaining, any house or places of ill-fame, knowing them to be such.

SEC. 3. Persons not to reside or visit therein. Penalty and fine, not less than \$5, nor more than \$100; on default of payment, not less than 5 nor more than 90 days' imprisonment.

AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPRESS GAMBLING—Page 21.

SEC. 1. Persons not to keep rooms or places for gambling or gaming.

SEC. 2. Owners not to lease any building, garden, arbor, booth, shed, tenement, water craft or float for the purposes of gambling or gaming.

SEC. 3. Persons not to resort to any places whatsoever for the purpose of gambling or gaming, or aiding, abetting, advising, assisting or buying any check, slip, card or ticket to represent money, to be used in betting on the result of any game.

SEC. 5. Person giving information, or shall procure the arrest and conviction of persons gambling or gaming, shall receive one-half of the cost assessed in such cases, when paid into the city treasury. Penalty, not less than \$5 nor more than \$100, or not less than 10 nor more than 90 days' imprisonment.

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO LOITERING FOR FRAUDULENT PURPOSES—Page 24.

SEC. 1. Persons shall not stand, loiter or stroll, awaiting or seeking to obtain money or valuable things from others by any tricks, fraudulent devices or practices, or aid or assist therein, on any street, lane, avenue, alley or other public places or border of the city limits.

SEC. 3. Persons known as "Ropers," "Steerers" or "Cappers," for any gambling house or room, or for any gambling game, trick or device, such persons shall not be permitted to stand or loiter about the streets in the city.

SEC. 4. Persons associating with thieves, pickpockets, gamblers, bawds, prostitutes or lewd women, for the purpose and with the intent to agree, conspire, combine or confederate against any of the laws of this State. Penalty, not less than \$2 nor more than \$50, and cost of prosecution.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS—Page 27.

SEC. 1. All dwellings and business houses now or hereafter erected shall be numbered.

SEC. 3. The common council may designate and appoint competent persons to affix numbers.

NOTE—Persons pretending to affix numbers, unless duly appointed by the common council, are frauds.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO VEHICLES—Page 33.

SEC. 5. No person shall use any vehicle as a public cart or vehicle without having painted thereon, in plain Roman letters, the name of owner and number of the license.

SEC. 8. Rates of fare of cartmen and draymen for conveying household goods and other goods, wares or merchandise, distance one-half mile, 30 cents; one and one-half miles, 75 cents. Loading, conveying and unloading each hogshead of sugar, molasses, liquors, earthenware or crockery, or cask of oil, weighing 1000 pounds or more, one-half mile, 50 cents; one mile, 75 cents. For time spent in loading and housing household goods, 50 cents per hour. Demanding or receiving a greater compensation, in addition to the penalty, shall be liable to the party in damages, and all costs and expenses.

SEC. 9. Rates and charges for the conveyance of persons and their baggage. Carrying each passenger ^{ONE &} one-half mile or under, to or from any railroad depot, hotel or steamboat landing, 25 cents; and not to any of the above named places, 25 cents; and over the distance aforesaid, and not to or from any railroad depot, hotel or steamboat landing, not exceeding 50 cents; children under four years of age, free; between four and ten years, half price; each trunk or piece of baggage less than 100 pounds, in charge of passengers, the same prices as passengers; over 100 pounds, or parts thereof, 10 cents additional; handboxes, satchels, carpet bags and valises, in charge of passengers, free; for attending and returning from funerals, \$3; during the days of holding fairs, 25 cents each way; in the night time, between the hours of 10 p. m., and 6 a. m., in said city, except to and from hotels, railroad depots or steamboat landings, double the sum above specified.

SEC. 11. Speed at street crossings, not faster than a walk.

SEC. 14. On vehicles designed to carry 2500 pounds or more, the tire shall not be less than three inches in width.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE OF FIREWOOD
—Page 89. Verbatim. Amended Sept. 16, 1878.

SEC. 1. No person shall sell, or offer for sale, in this city, any firewood, by the load or otherwise than by the cord, and at a specified price per cord, whether the quantity be great or small.

SEC. 2. No person shall sell, or offer for sale, any firewood, except upon the conditions and with the understanding that he will unload the same and cord or pile it in a suitable form for correct measurement. Penalty, shall be punished by fine of not exceeding \$5, and cost of prosecution.

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO BUTCHERS, MARKETS
AND MARKET MEN—Page 209.

SEC. 5. No person shall expose for sale in any market house or elsewhere in the city, any unwholesome, stale, emaciated, bran-stuffed, tainted, putrid or measly meat, poultry undrawn, undressed or imperfectly cleaned, or other unwholesome provisions, under a penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than \$50, for each offence.

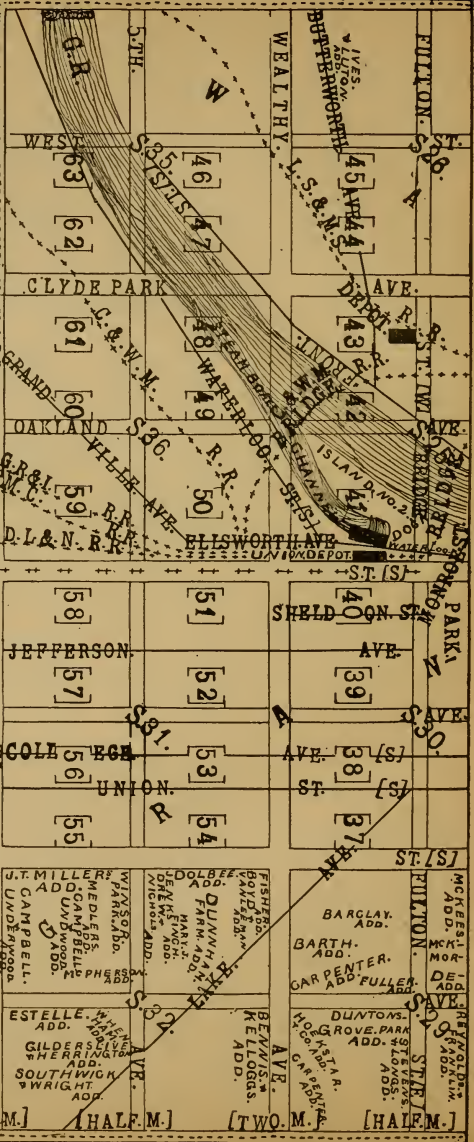
