

- 1) Stub:
 - Summary of the topic
 - Statement telling why the topic is important
 - Source outside Wikipedia confirming its existence and importance
- 2) More detailed article that captures various perspectives (historical and global)
- 3) Well-written, sourced and comprehensive







Signing a comment on a discussion/talk page








