The idea behind

- An initiative for a thematic hub to support content partnerships
- Increase equity in decision making
- Support others on their journey towards successful partnerships absolutely
 not replace their work







One of several pillars of the hub

The Helpdesk complements the other pillars of the Hub initiative, including:

- Partnerships with IGOs
- Capacity Building
- Strategic data uploads







Follows a needs assessment

- There is currently a bottleneck in the movement
- Many have potential partners but little technical capacity and knowhow
- The Helpdesk answers to this need







This is what it is:

- A service for the global movement
- Supports with technical work around batch uploads
- Guides people to the right people in the movement
- Shares best practices
- Guided by an expert committee







This is how it works:

- Someone sends a request to the Helpdesk (<u>helpdesk@wikimedia.se</u>)
- The Expert Committee gives initial feedback and priority
- If positive, Helpdesk team works with requester to move in the right direction
- Expert Committee gives final go
- Helpdesk gives support








- Collaboration with Wiki Loves Earth international team
- Support to ~10 WLE organizers to add their data to Wikidata
- Similar line of work with Wikimedia Uganda







- Uganda reached out and wanted support to run their Wiki Loves Monuments via Wikidata
- They had data from National Museum of Uganda
- In the beginning, very few Ugandan monuments in Wikidata. Now +500, and more than 100 has coordinates.
