Gist of the Economic Control Policies in East Asia

The First Policy

In view of ^{the} transition of the world's trend, we wish to accelerate independent expansion of the Empire's power, establish the self-sufficient economic policy in East Asia, by which to enforce the defensive power of the Empire and establish the foundation of economic development in East Asia.

In order to carry out this policy, we set up an

economic control policies in East Asia, for 1941 as under: -

1. For economic development, we lay emphasis on the present demand for requirements concerning national defense.
2. The plan of setting up plants in economic sites will be effected chiefly in the control part of a sphere covering Japan, Manchuria, and Northern China. It will, however, be extended to all parts of East Asia in order to secure important materials.
3. The basic idea of relations between Japan, Manchuria and China regarding the economic development

is to have Japan in the center, and enforce a
inseparable relations between Japan and Manchukuo.

We must promote a still tighter organic connection
of economy between Japan, Manchukuo and China.

4. We must reform our idea of "profit first
principle", and replace it by "the public interest
first principle".
