From 1932 to 1937, KISHI lists the positions he held in the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, which included his appointment in 1937 as Vice-Minister of the Department of Commerce and Industry, MANCHUKUO. In October 1941 he was appointed Minister of Commerce and Industry, in April 1942 elected member of the House of Representatives and in October 1943 became a state minister and Vice-Minister of Munitions.

Organizations of which KISHI admits to membership are Imperial Rule Assistance Association, Imperial Rule Assistance Political Society (after election to House of Representatives), Commercial Patriotic Society, Society for Study of National Policy, Commerce and Industry Society (President in 1943), and Righteous Salvation Society /GISAIKAI/ in 1944 (member of Analyst: ET GARDEN
