- 1. In the course of our research of files pertaining to areas of the USSR in which Lee Harvey OSWALD allegedly resided, a photograph of an individual closely resembling OSWALD was uncovered.
- 2. For files indicate that this photograph (Attachment A) came from a color transparency takes in A dass, USOR, on or about 11 August 1961, by an American tourist, hers. Monica F. MRAN ER, whose address at the time was r. O. Box 985, Solvang, California.
- Aloshchad' (Central Square), which is located in the center of t lask.
 The building in the background has been identified as The Palace of Culture. The people are depicted in the photograph. The individual second from the right, appears to be Lee Harvey OSWALD. It should be noted that the shirt this individual is wearing appears to be identical to the shirt OSWALD is wearing in two photographs from the group of 47 photographs from the effects of OSWALD which were forwarded to this Agency in your communication of 3 beared 1964, file number (3) 165-82595, subject: Assassination of President John F. MINNEUT. Copies of these two photographs of CSWALD are forwarded with this report as Attachment B.
- 4. Source of the photograph identified one of the females in the picture, possibly the one on the left, as <u>Advetians (LNU)</u>, an interist guide. Source was accompanied by another American, Miss clim MALAN, 535 Attardex

the lost in the photograph. None of the other individuals can be specier identified.

- o. Now. The Rand Miss 10 10 10 10. Solid of whom are United Itales citizens, were contacted by this Agency on a one-time basis. Inlinking their return from their tups of the CORR. The report of this contact, CC-3-3, 212, 907, dated 21 March 1962, subjects healities/liter Parade/Interrogation in Mines Following the Civing Amp of a GS News Magazine, is forwarded as Attachment C.
- 5. hrs. KRAMER, who is described as "an older companion" in the source description of Attachment C, furnished this Agency with 150 color transparencies taken during the trip. Attachment A is only one of the five transparencies of which negative copies were made and retained by this Agency. All of the 150 original color transparencies were returned to here. KRAMER.
- 7. Miss NAMAN, referred to as 'a college graduate" in the source description of Attachment C. provided this Agency with one rest of Sman color movie film taken during the trip. The film was viewed by this Agency and was subsequently resurned to Miss NAMAN.
- is. This Agency has had no further contact with either Mrs. Hit Alikk or hits habial subsequent to the contact reflected in the report forwarded so Attachment C.
- 1. This office would be interested in any pertinent information which interviews of Mrs. KRAMER and Miss NAMAN by your office might possibly provide along the following lines:
 - a. A more positive identification of the individual in Attachment A tentatively identified as OSWALD.
 - b. The exact date and estimate of the time of day when the photograph (Attachment A) was taken.

/c. Any information

- c. Iny information which would aid in identifying other individuals in the photograph (Attachment A).
- d. The name, address, and any other identifying data on the traveling companion who accompanied Mrs. KRAMER and Miss MAMAN from Moscow to Warsaw via Minsk.
- 10. Dissemination of Attachment A and pertinent identifying information to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Lennedy is being delayed pending receipt of your Bureau's findings in this matter.
