SUBJECT: Control of Occupation Force Requirements for
Indigenous Services, Supplies and Materials
in JFY 1949.

TO : Chief, Wakayama Civil Affairs Team

1. References:

- a. Letter, this headquarters, subject as above,
dated 3 August 1949.
- b. Letter, Headquarters Eighth Army, file AG 290,
13 July 49, subject as above, and 1st Ind. I Corps, 20 July
1949.

2. The manning table strength and yen limitations as
listed in paragraph 3a, b and c of reference 1a above are
rescinded and instead 8,000,000 will be fixed as the final
total yen limitation for your team for the period 1 July to
30 November 1949. Under no circumstances will this budget
amount be exceeded without prior approval in writing from
this headquarters.

3. Chiefs of Civil Affairs Teams are responsible for
carrying out immediately plans for necessary reduction in
their requisitioned personnel and for the proper wage
adjustment of those personnel improperly classified and
receiving a higher basic wage than entitled to. Moreover,
in deciding their monthly expenditures for the period covered
by the budget, due consideration should be given to include
such allowances as retirement and travel allowances.

4. It will be further noted that in every case where
personnel are being separated to conform with the budget a
30 days' notice will be given in lieu of discharge allowance.

Subject: Control of Occupation Force Requirements for Indigenous Services,
Supplies and Materials in JFY 1949.

To : Commanding Officer, Wakayama Civil Affairs Team

1. Reference: Letter, Headquarters Eighth Army, file AG 290, 13 July 1949, same subject as above, and 1st Ind. I Corps, 20 July 1949.

2. Previous allocations of indigenous labor authorized by this headquarters are rescinded.

3. Reference is made to paragraph 2d and e of above reference. Manning table strength and Yen limitations are herewith established for balance of Japanese fiscal year, July 1949 through March 1950 for your command.

- a. Number of employees, daily average: 145
- b. Yen limitations balance JFY: 11,171,250
- c. Yen limitations monthly average: 1,241,250

4. It will be noted that the figures shown in paragraph 3b above is the determining factor of yen limitations for the balance of JFY 1949. Under no circumstances will it be exceeded without prior approval of this headquarters. Figures shown in paragraph 3a and c above are guides only.

5. Reference paragraph 2f of above reference, authority has been delegated to commanders of Civil Affairs Regions to approve overtime in accordance with reference stated. Requests for overtime must be submitted in writing to this headquarters.

6. Until further notice, manning tables will not be forwarded to this headquarters.
