MEMORANDUM FOR: JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

THROUGH: Central Liaison Office, Tokyo

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Koreans from Japan to Korea North of
38° North Latitude

1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (26 Dec 46)GC, (SCAPIN 1421), dated 26 December 1946, subject: Repatriation of Japanese Nationals from Soviet and Soviet-Controlled Territories, and of Koreans from Japan to Korea North of 38° North Latitude.

b. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (15 May 47)GC-0, (SCAPIN 1680), dated 15 May 1947, subject as above.

2. The ship Shinyo Maru has been designated to lift the Koreans mentioned in reference paragraph 1 b above. The ship will follow the schedule given below:

25 June 1947 - Sail from Sasebo to Moji with Korean repatriates.

26 June 1947 - Load baggage and personal possessions of above-mentioned repatriates, and sail for Konan, Korea.

3. Japanese repatriates may be carried on the Shinyo Maru on the return trip to Japan.

4. The Japanese Government will:

a. Concerning the Koreans mentioned in paragraph 2 above, comply with the provisions of reference paragraph 1 b above.

b. Insure expeditious loading at Sasebo and Moji to allow ship to keep to the above schedule.


