1. Reference is made to:

a. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (26 Dec 46)GC, (SCAPIN 1421), dated 26 December 1946, subject: Repatriation of Japanese Nationals from Soviet and Soviet-Controlled Territories, and of Koreans from Japan to Korea North of 380 North Latitude.

b. Memorandum from the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, file AG 014.33 (15 May 47)GC-0, (SCAPIN 1680), dated 15 May 1947, subject as above.

2. The ship Shinyo Maru has been designated to lift the Koreans mentioned in reference paragraph 1 b above. The ship will follow the schedule given below:

25 June 1947 - Sail from Sasebo to Moji with Korean repatriates.

26 June 1947 - Load baggage and personal possessions of abovementioned repatriates, and sail for Konan, Korea.

3. Japanese repatriates may be carried on the Shinyo Maru on the return trip to Japan.

4. The Jamenese Government will:

a. Concerning the Koreans mentioned in paragraph 2 above, comply with the provisions of reference paragraph 1 b above.
