SITUATION OVERVIEW as of 20 Dec.

- **Diphtheria cases** tot. number: **1 841** (8 Nov.-20 Dec., reported in the camps for forcibly displaced Myanmar nationals south of Cox's Bazar)
- **22 confirmed deaths among Rohingya**
- Overall living conditions in camps are poor and with extreme overcrowded situation, with lack of medical/health facilities and 40% water wells contaminated (*E.coli*)

EU CIVIL PROTECTION MECHANISM (EUCPM)

- UK: WHO-classified Emergency Medical Team (EMT) with 40 personnel and medical equipment is being deployed in two phases, on 23 and 28 December, to Kutupalong.
