1. For your information, this Headquarters intends to approve applications for conversion or operation of aircraft and munitions plants only when:

- a. The proposed production is essential.
- b. No other suitable facilities are available or not in use.
- c. Production is in accordance with the general policies of the occupation.
- d. The plant by operating will not become part of a chain of production.

2. Plants listed on reparations at the present time are considered in excess of the requirements of the Japanese economy, and, therefore, the Japanese Government must plan to shift production from these plants to idle plants.





1. Following is a copy from letter received from I Corps by this headquarters. Forwarding for your information.

"1. Reference is made to letter from your headquarters (then the 107th Military Government Group), dated 1 Feb 46, same as above.

2. From information now received both from GHQ SCAP and from Headquarters Eighth Army, it appears that the following interpretation can now be placed upon requests to reconvert or to continue the production of synthetic rubber:

a. If the applicant establishment is already fully equipped to manufacture synthetic rubber, and does not need to reconvert any of its facilities in order to accomplish such production, it may be permitted to continue or resume synthetic rubber manufacture.

b. If the plant is not fully equipped to manufacture synthetic rubber, and must convert a portion or all of its facilities before manufacture is possible, it shall not be permitted to convert.

3. Any change in this interpretation which may occur will be brought to your attention immediately."

Furnish to reach this office not later than, 5 January, 1946, a report in quadruplicate, which will outline such publicity. This report will include coverage of newspaper articles and radio broadcasts issued in the Japanese language.



1. Paragraph 3(d), Annex 8 to Adm O 19, Military Government, Headquarters 6th Army, 1200I 11 September 1945, states that "the production of foodstuffs, medical, dental and sanitary supplies..... and other items which will reduce requirements for imports, will be encouraged". No specific official instructions, however, have been received as to proper ways in which to give such encouragement. After conversations of the Military Government Economics and Industry Officer of this Headquarters with the corresponding officer of the 6th Army and the head of the Economic and Scientific Section, General Headquarters, SCAP, the following procedure is suggested for your use in respect to applications to begin or resume manufacturing and other industrial or commercial operations consonant with our policies concerning the Japanese Economy. No official statement has been made to this effect, but apparently operations over a wide range of economic activity will be permitted as long as the products or services produced are for the benefit of an entirely civilian economy.

2. When applicants come to you with proposals and these proposals have not previously been submitted to offices of the Japanese Government, direct these applicants to submit their proposals to the Japanese Government. If their proposals have been submitted to the Japanese Government and no answer is given within a reasonable time, you may then forward, through regular channels, the proposal of the applicant together with your endorsement and recommendation. This office will forward your recommendation together with any comments. In this way we may expedite decisions at the respective top levels of SCAP and of the Japanese Government during the period in which we have no specific written instructions to operate in our respective areas of responsibility.

2. This permit grants authority only to operate. The acquisition of materials, parts, and sub-assemblies, as well as the disposition of finished products and establishment of sales prices, will be in accord with the regulations of the Imperial Japanese Government.

3. At the end of the first month of operation, and at the end of each three-month period thereafter, until notified to the contrary by this Headquarters a report will be made to the Commanding General _____ Corps, Headquarters _____, Attention: Military Government Section. This report will be written in English and will list each item, by name, type, and quantity produced by each factory, subsidiary, or sub-contractor operating under the provisions of this permit. This report will be delivered to Corps Headquarters not later than fifteen (15) days after the conclusion of the period to which the report pertains.

mittee in the Ministry of Com-
munications, established for that
purpose, in accordance with
(SCAPIN 1762A).

b. Maintain proper supervi-

ment manufacturers through the
Japan Communication Equipment
Manufacturers Association.

c. Render such necessary as-

The Ordinance and Instructions of the Japanese Government Concerning the Reconversion of Plant.

B-13

1. In compliance with the paragraph 3 of the Directive No. 3 issued from the office of the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers under date of 22 September 1945, Inter-departmental Ordinance No. 1 (Department of Commerce, Agriculture, Transportation, Home Affairs) was issued on 10 October 1945 with regard to the regulation of the production of arms, ammunition, aircraft, or implements of war, the gist of which is as follows:
 - Article 1. (Prohibited items enumerated)
 - Article 2. No plant heretofore engaged in the production of items enumerated in Article 1 will be allowed to resume operation for the production of other items unless permission is granted by the governor of the prefecture concerned (or the minister of the department concerned, as the case may be).
 - Article 3. (Form of application of reconversion)
 - Article 4. (Production of powder for industrial use)
 - Article 5. (Prohibition of Experiment of Uranium 235)
 - Article 6. (Penal regulations)
 - Article 7. (Penal regulations)
2. An Instruction was issued on 15 October 1945 from the Commerce Department concerning the details of the prohibited items.

3. Further instruction was issued on 24 October 1945 from the Commerce Department as to the procedure to be followed in connection with the permission of reconversion of plants, the gist of which is as follows:
- a. The Japanese Government Was informed from the General Headquarters of the Allied Powers in Tokyo that it is now being considered by the GHQ to send some special officer to each prefecture concerned in order to take care of the problem of reconversion of plant. For the temporary measure until such special officer is stationed, however, it is understood that with respect to the problem of reconversion of plant the Governor of the prefecture concerned will get in touch with the U.S. Forces stationed in such district and receive the necessary direction from the responsible officer of the U.S. Forces.
- In such places as there is no U.S. Forces stationed, and in case the problem of reconversion of plant is to be solved without delay, the governor of the prefecture concerned will secure the approval of the Eighth Army, U.S. Forces, through the Japanese Liaison Office, Yokohama, if the prefecture concerned is situated in the eastern part of Japan, and the approval of the Sixth Army, U.S. Forces, through the Japanese Liaison Office, Kyoto, if the prefecture concerned is situated in the western part of Japan.

- b. The governor is requested to make report as of end of every month until 10 of the following month to the Commerce Department of the plant which was given the permission of reconversion from the governor in accordance with the proper procedure together with the copy of application of reconversion ~~is~~ filed with the préfectoral government.

Recommendation regarding the
Continuance of Operation of New OD-5 Plants.

AISAN KOGYO K.K.

The items of the Products of the above factory are carbulator, piston, oil-brake, oil pump, vacuum controller, etc.

The Toyoda Jidoshokki Seisakusho had formerly manufactured the above items for Toyoda Jidosha Kogyo K.K. But due to the conversion of the former factory to the production of spinning and weaving machines, the subject factory took its place to manufacture the parts of automobile. Almost all the demand of carbulator of Toyoda's truck are filled by the products of the said factory. It is, therefore, considered necessary to continue its work.

ASAHINA TEKKOJO, OKOSHI FACTORY

The main products of this factory are thrashing machines and straw rope making machines.

As the electrization of the agricultural implements is seemed to be one of the urgent plans to be effected immediately, the prefectural Government is trying to encourage the farmers to utilize the motive power and to improve the implements.

In view of the above situation, the Prefectural Government wishes to let the said factory produce continuously the thrashing machines by motive power with their skilled technique and also manufacture the straw rope making machines in order to meet the increasing demand.

OBU SANGYO K.K.

The items of the products; Spinning and weaving machines including repairs, refrigerators, electric irons, etc.

There are two main factories in Aichi Prefecture such as the Howa Jukogyo and Toyoda Jidoshokki Seisakusho which are exclusively manufacturing the spinning and weaving machines. In view of the fact that the textile industry has to be reconstructed urgently for the stabilization of people's livelihood as well as securing collateral for import. It is considered necessary to continue the operation of this factory. In addition to the above, as there are very few makers of refrigerators in the Prefecture, which are urgently needed to meet the demand for food storage and the order of the U. S. Army, it is also considered necessary to continue the operation.

CHUKYO KIKAI SEISAKUSHO, KOMAKI FACTORY

As the increase of rolling stocks is urgently needed for the stabilization of people's livelihood, the Government is encouraging the production as one of the most important plans of the reconstruction of Japan.

The factory produces the parts of the rolling stock such as electric valve and grease cup as, so to say, the sub-contractor of Mitsubishi Electric K.K. Itami Factory.

It is, therefore, considered necessary to continue the operation.

GUNZE KOGYO K.K., TOYOHASHI FACTORY

The items of the products of this factory are parts of piston, spindles, and beams.

This factory had been engaged in the raw silk manufacturing before the war. By many year's experience and the study in this work, the new type of raw silk manufacturing machine was invented in this factory, contributing to the improvement of the silk manufacturing industry.

It is, therefore, considered necessary to continue the operation in order to contribute for the reconstruction of raw silk manufacture in Japan.

ARAI SEISAKUSHO, SAYA FACTORY.

The items of product : Parts of bicycle (handle, brake, fly-wheel, etc.)

This factory had the good reputation in this district for the production of the parts of bicycle of steady and excellent quality, what was called "Arai's handle".

It is considered by the Prefectural Government to encourage the continuation of operation of the above factory.

KOBAYASHI SEISAKUSHO, MOMONOKI FACTORY.

The items of Product: Parts of Gas and Electric appliances.
Parts of automobile.

This company has engaged in making the parts of gas appliances since its establishment.

The gas manufacturing companies can't dispense with the said factory as the main gas appliances manufacturing factory in this district.

NISSHIN BOSEKI K.K. MIAI FACTORY

The items of the product: Raw silk manufacturing machines.
Cotton bleaching and dying work.

Raw silk manufacturing is one of the main industry of Japan and it is expected that the number of factories may increase in the future, Cotton bleaching and dying works are also considered important for the civilian livelihood. It goes without saying that the increase of the products of raw silk is urgently needed for the export purpose in order to import the foodstuffs which are critically short in this country.

As this factory has the excellent skill and technique of its own, it is desired that the operation of this factory be continued.

KINJO SAKUGANKI SEIZO

The items of the products of the Kinjo Sakuganki K.K. are rock drill, sharpner, compressor, concrete breaker, oil furnace, small internal combustion engine, etc.

There are only two other factories such as Taisei K.K. and Teikoku Sakuganki K.K. in this area which produce these machines indispensable for the mining, civil engineering work and the chemical fertilizer manufacturing.

This company has continued its work to produce these machines since pre-war time, and has many experience and skill. Therefor, the Prefectural Government wishes to continu its operation so that it may meet the increasing demand.

OKAMOTO KOGYO K.K., ICHINOMIYA, KASADERA, AND BISAI FACTORIES.

These three factories are now being engaged in producing the parts of bicycle, namely pedal and brake at Ichinomiya, gear-crank and handle at Kasadera, tools necessary for production of bicycle at Bisai factory.

The overall manufacturing capacity of Okamoto Kogyo K.K. is approximately 20,000 per month, but owing to the difficulty of getting materials, the present capacity is no less than 5,000. The Japan bicycle control association has allocated this company to produce 4,500 bicycles of 18,000 which are intended to be exported as collateral goods.

Furthermore, from the point of view of the difficult condition of transportation caused by the lack of various transportation facilities, the increase of the bicycle is seemed to be the important problem.

It is, therefore, considered necessary to continue the operation of these factories.

DAIDO SEIKO K.K., HOSHIZAKI FACTORY.

The above factory is the important manufacturing factory of the special steel for civilian commodities in this district and is considered indispensable for the reconstruction of the domestic industry. The Prefectural Government needs the continuation of operation of this factory.

SUMITOMO KINZOKU KOGYO K.K., NAGOYA FACTORY.

The item of Product: Sheets, pipes, bars, wires of copper, copper alloy, light metals alloy. Forging.

This factory is the sole factory in this district which is engaging in pressing work of copper, copper alloy and light metals alloy. The Prefectural Government has the intention to assist the reconstruction work of the factory and let them supply those materials for the restoration of the industry. Therefore, it is needed to continue the operation.

SUMITOMO KINZOKU K.K., NARUMI FACTORY.

The items of the products of the above factory are china-ware and porcelain, chiefly the table-wares for domestic use and export purpose.

This district is noted as the producing center of porcelain and china-ware in Japan.

The Narumi factory which was originally established by the Nagoya Seito K.K. has the modern equipment and skilled workers, and the reconversion of this factory is progressing satisfactorily. In order to meet the requirement of porcelain and china-ware which are urgently needed due to the extreme shortage, it is considered necessary to continue the operation of this factory.

TOYODA JIDOSHA K.K., KOROMO FACTORY

The products of this factory are motor-trucks. This factory was engaged exclusively in manufacturing the automobiles before and during the war and continues the operation. To increase the motor-trucks is one of the urgent problem in Japan in view of the present insufficiency of transportation facilities. Therefore, the stimulation of production of cars is earnestly called for from the various parts of the country.

Fortunately, as this factory has the best facilities and accumulates the abundant technical knowledge for the production of motor-truck it is earnestly desired that this factory be allowed to continue its operation.

TOYODA JIDOSHA KOGYO K.K., KARIYA (NORTH) FACTORY

The items of the products of the above factory are parts of automobile and repairs and rehabilitation of the disabled cars. Among the current number of automobiles in Japn, 23 % are of Toyoda's automobiles. Owing to the extreme shortage of auto-parts, there are a good number of cars that cannot be repaired and rehabilitated. In order to supply these auto-parts for repairs and rehabilitation the operation of this factory seems to be necessary.

TOYODA JIDOSHA KOGYO K.K., KARIYA (SOUTH) FACTORY

Items of the products: Electric apparatus for automobile, Radio sets, small generator etc.

This factory has the close connection with the Koromo factory in the production of automobile, chiefly in manufacturing the electric apparatus such as generator, starter, electric alarm etc.

The factories engaging in the production of the above-mentioned items are very few in Japan. Consequently, it is necessary to continue the operation of this factory.
