MEMORANDUM FOR: IMPERIAL JAPANESE GOVERNMENT

SUBJECT: Release of German-owned Dye-stuff

1. The Imperial Japanese Government is directed to release from the provisions of memorandum for the Imperial Japanese Government, file AG 091.112(13 Sep 45)MG, SCAFIN 26, 13 September 1945, subject "Protection of Allied and Axis Property," from General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, the following dye-stuff belonging to Doitsu Senryo Gomei Kaisha at the locations indicated:

The above-mentioned goods will be relinquished to the Textile Bureau of the Japanese Ministry of Commerce and Industry which will contact General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, Economic and Scientific Section, Industry Division, for instructions regarding their disposition.

3. These goods will be distributed in accordance with allocations made per instructions in paragraph 2 above and will be sold at prices established by the Japanese Price Board.

4. All funds derived from the sale of these goods will be deposited in the Bank of Japan in the "Custody Account for the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers," and a complete report thereon will be submitted to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.
