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PREFATORY NOTE

The remarkable development of irrigation in the arid regions, and the no less remarkable development of water power applied to electric current generators, has aroused a very keen interest in sources of water supply. The use of water for these two important industrial purposes frequently interferes seriously with its natural flow and causes great loss to property largely dependent for its value upon the continuance of this natural flow. The discussion of the various claims put forth by these conflicting interests has produced an extensive literature. It is the purpose of this list to bring together the more important of these discussions, and to point out, by means of a comprehensive analytical index, where information on any phase of the subject, even the minutest, may be found.

A subject of such widespread interest lends itself readily to cooperative treatment. A preliminary list was sent to all the state and legislative reference librarians throughout the country and the list here printed includes contributions received from the following states:

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
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


