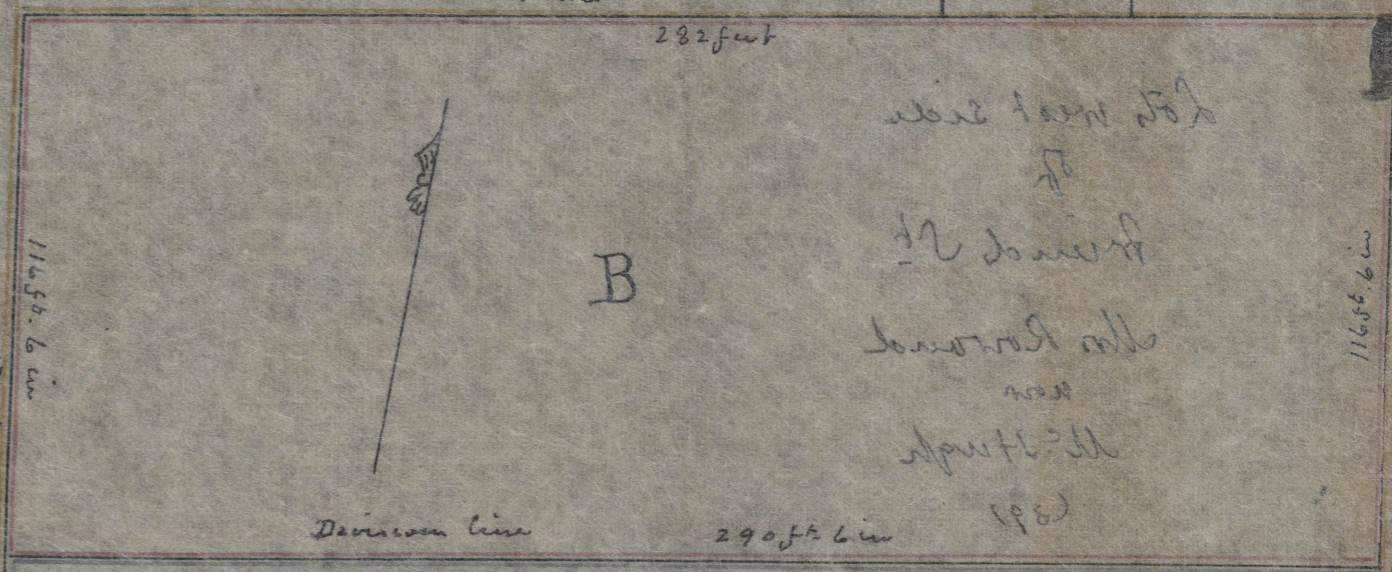


Lot belonging to George Chesholme Esq^r

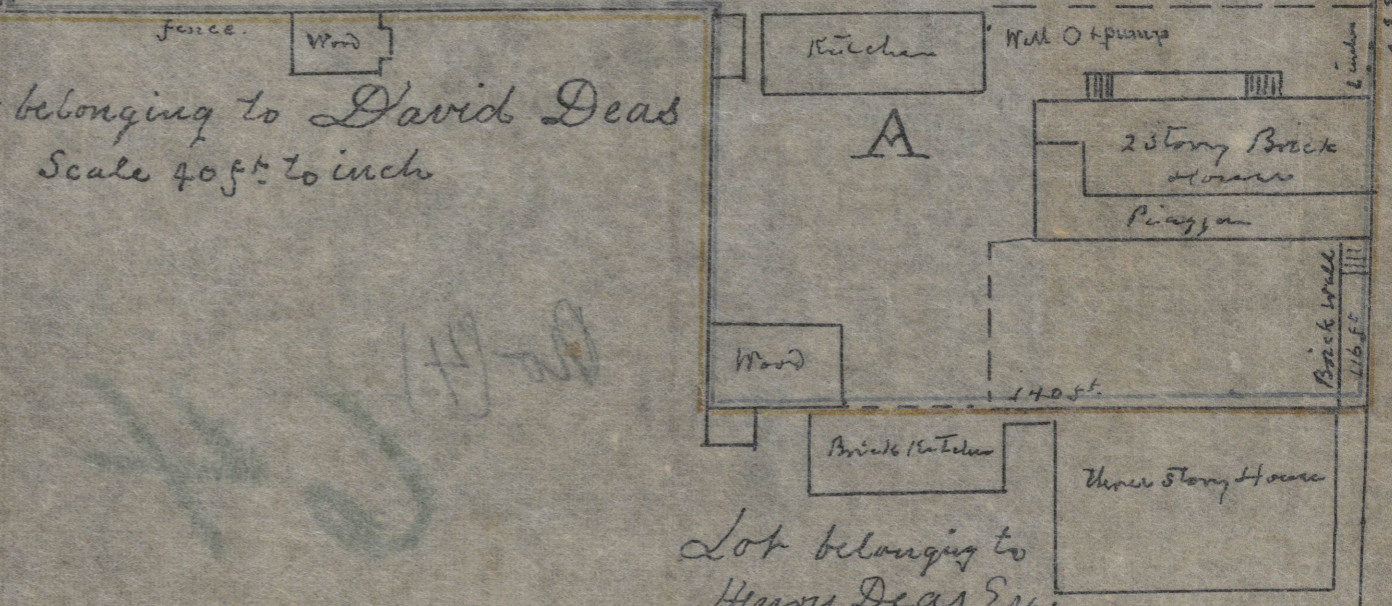
