


SUBJECT: Inventory Program of Reparation Plants

TO: See Distribution

1. Information received at this headquarters indicates that completion of the inventory program of all installations designated for reparation on Inclosure 1 of Operational Directive No. 5/2, Headquarters Eighth Army, 7 June 1946, must be accomplished by 10 October 1946. It is directed that your headquarters take necessary measures to complete this work in your area of responsibility, as rapidly as possible. In the event your headquarters finds it impossible to meet the above schedule, it is directed that you notify this headquarters immediately as to the reason for the delay.

2. Failure to receive an adequate number of inventory sheets has been largely responsible for the delay in execution of the reparation program to date. Assurances have been received from higher headquarters that an increased supply of these forms will shortly be made available. Immediately on receipt by this headquarters, the inventory sheets will be forwarded to the various Military Government Teams. It is understood by this headquarters that completion of the inventory program on the above date will be dependent on your headquarters receiving an adequate supply of inventory sheets.

SUBJECT: Inventory of Reparations Machinery.

TO: See Distribution.

1. Reference is made to paragraph 5 of Operational Directive No. 5/3, Headquarters Eighth Army, 15 June 46. The following change in inventory procedure is forwarded for your information.

2. All capital equipment owned by plants listed for reparations will be inventoried as directed. When machinery and equipment have been purchased subsequent to the occupation of Japan for peace-time production and not from another plant now under custody and control, inventory sheets of such machinery will be marked "FX" following machine number in item "B" of the inventory sheet, and the same symbol painted on the machine. It will be the responsibility of the Japanese to establish purchase date and source of purchase of this exempted machinery.
