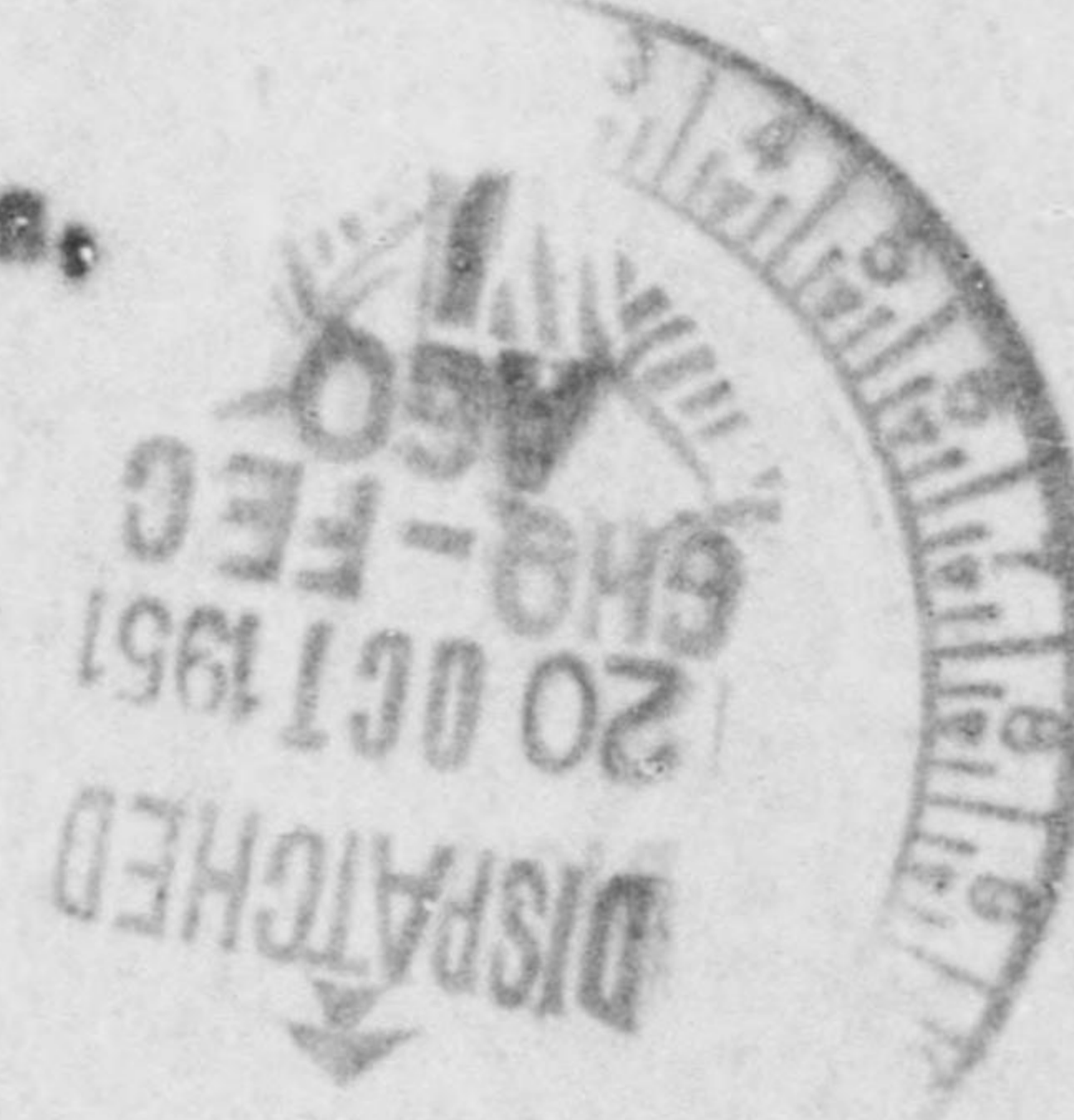
Dear Father Gabriel:

Dear Mr. Ogawa:

Your letter of 22 August 1951 requesting permission to sell non-alcoholic beverages and snack items at scheduled baseball games between the Red Socks and the Big Six University, has been referred to me for reply.

This letter will constitute a one-time authority for the Big Six University Committee to purchase and resell for yen, non-alcoholic beverages and such snack items as available at two baseball games (dates undetermined due to inclement weather) between the Red Sox Baseball Team and the Big Six University Teams. It must be understood that purchase of non-alcoholic beverages and snack items will be made at stipulated price set forth by Exchange Officer, Headquarters and Service Command and that payment for above cited items will be made within twenty four hours from time of purchase by your organization. Further, that all proceeds will be used to aid students to further their education. Proceeds will be put in a "special scholarship fund".

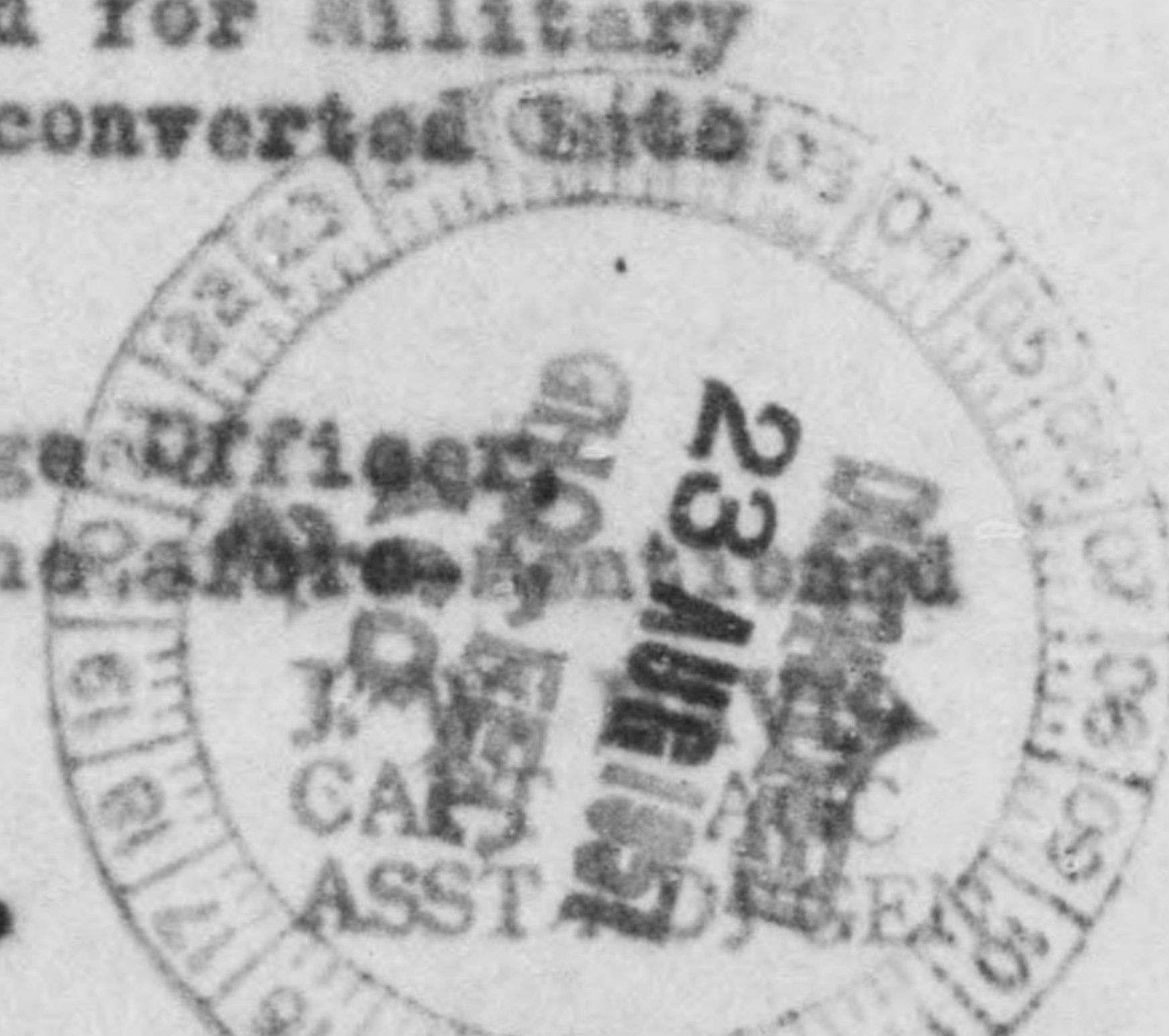
The beverages and snack items will not be sold for Military Payment Certificates nor will the yen receipts be converted into dollars or dollar instruments.

1. References are:

a. Hq & Svc Comd letter, file HC 300.8 (COM-B), subject: "Occupation Forces Procurement Regulation", dated 9 April 1951, which is partially quoted herewith:

"3. ... Receiving officers will prepare and process a Procurement Order prior to any action taken by the contractor to deliver supplies or render services.

"4. ... In no case will a confirming procurement order be utilized".

b. Hq & Svc Comd letter, file HC 300.8 (COM-B), subject: "Failure to Comply with Procurement Directives", dated 28 June 1951.

2. ATIS Production Section has been unable to furnish procurement orders for printing to AG, HSC by the 20th day of the month preceding the month of publication (required by HSC) because necessary data was not furnished in time.

3. In order to comply with above HSC requirements for submission of procurement demands, it will be necessary for PSD to furnish its printing requirements to ATIS Production Section by the 15th day of the month preceding the month of publication. This must be done in order that ATIS may prepare and submit a procurement order for approval before the printing plant may start to work. Unless material to be printed or an estimate of requirements is submitted by the above date, ATIS will be unable to obtain any indigenous printed material for inclusion in the CIC District Field Reports publication.

Request for Cosmoline and Sealing Compound

1. Request Tokyo Ordnance Depot be authorized to issue to the Japanese Police, through G2/Public Safety Division, GHQ, 2000 lbs compound, rust preventative heavy, and 2000 lbs sealing compound.

2. These materials are to be used by the National Rural Police Reloading Plant for .45 and .38 cal projectile base lubrication necessary for proper sealing of the projectile in the brass casing. The indigenous compound now being used is of such a coarse and porous quality that much of the ammunition thus reloaded is faulty.

3. The National Rural Police Reloading Plant reloads ammunition for all Japanese Government and municipal law enforcement agencies. This ammunition is used for practice in order to save for emergency use the ammunition obtained from the U. S. under authorization of CINCPAC Project.

4. Major M. L. Tippet and Mr. W. A. Garrett both of 610th Ord have inspected the NRP Reloading Plant and agree that procurement of cosmoline and sealing compound for the purpose stated above will eliminate the trouble now being experienced.

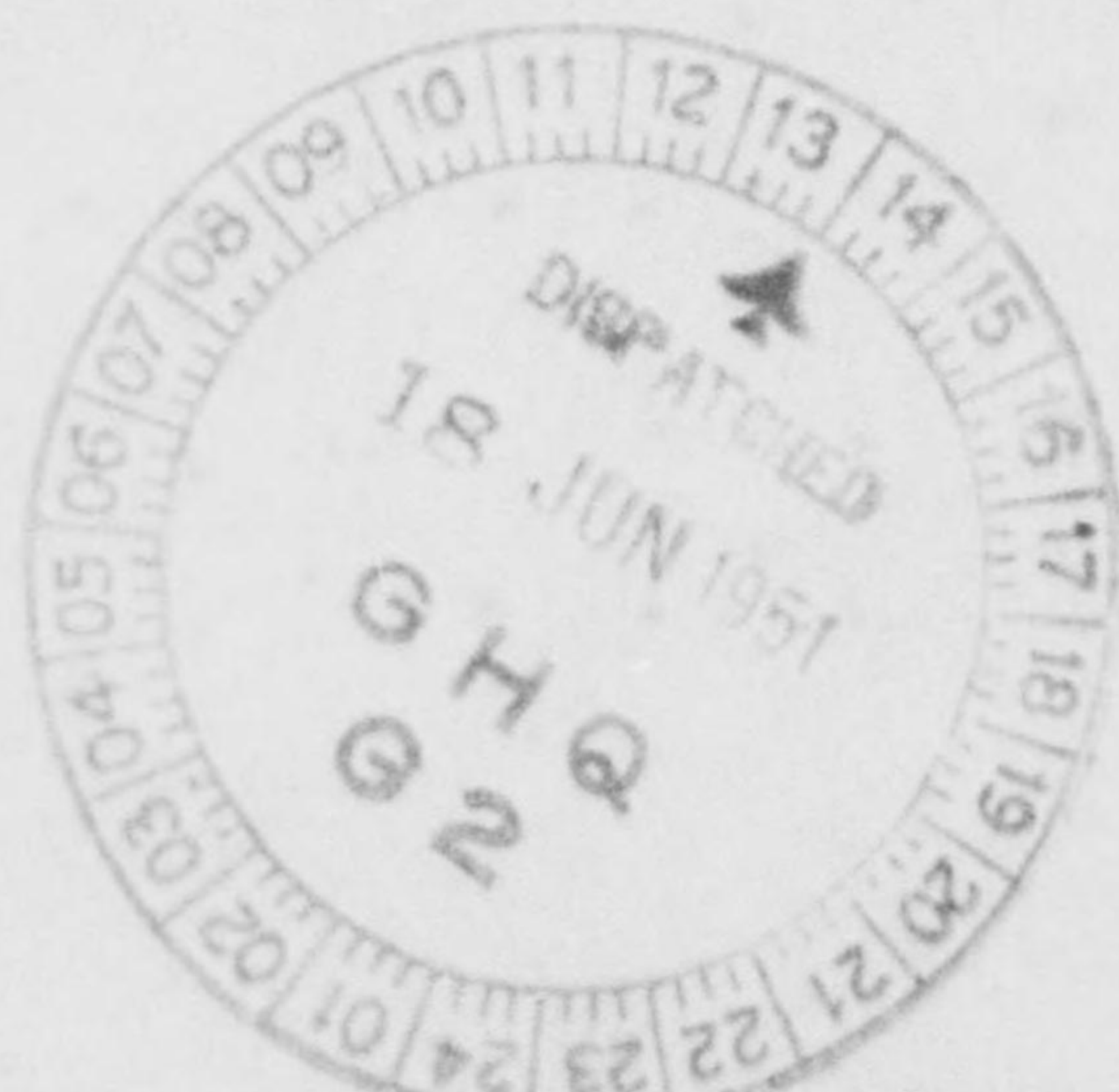

This C/N requests TOD be authorized to issue cosmoline and sealing compound to Japanese Police for use in reloading ammunition. TOD has indicated that they have a surplus of these materials on hand and that it will solve the difficulties being experienced by the NRP. However, an approved requisition is necessary before they can issue these materials. G4, Major Kreutzer in conversation with Capt. Russell suggested this C/N be initiated as a basis for authorizing this request.

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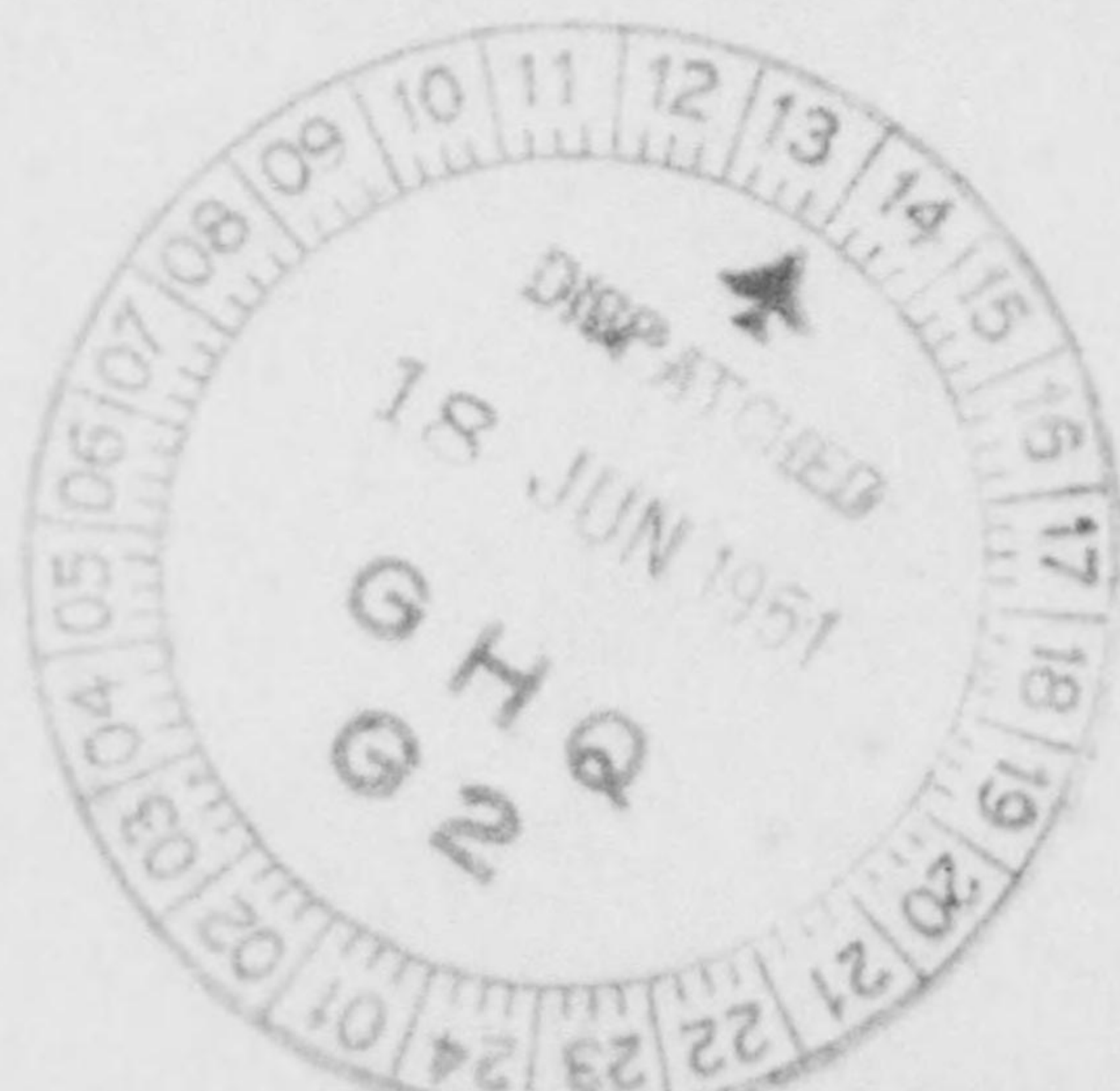
